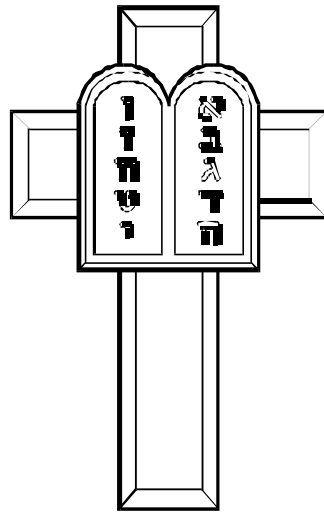

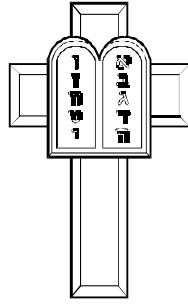

Yehovaw the Son

Yehovaw the Father sent Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1) to Earth, to become through the virgin Mary both "the Son of God" (Luke 1:35) and "the Son of Man" (Mark 2:10), in that Yehovaw gave, to Him, the second Person of the Godhead (Matthew 28:19), the same physical body that He had given to Adam and Eve and all their children on Earth! He wrote, through His prophet:

The Lord Himself shall give you a sign! Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall call His name Immanuel! (Isaiah 7:14)

"Immanuel" means "With us is God" (Strong: Hebrew: 6005), which is exactly what Yeshuaw was, when He walked among the children of Israel two thousand years ago!

That walk was not to be a pleasant one, at times; although it began and ended joyously enough.

When Mary gave birth to Yeshuaw, as the child Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or "Christ" (Matthew 16:20), shepherds saw

¹³a multitude of the heavenly host praising God and saying, ¹⁴Glory to God in the highest! And on Earth peace, good will toward men! (Luke 2:13 and 14)

In the administration of Yehovaw's "covenant with the house of Israel" (Jeremiah 31:31), Yeshuaw, as Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1), was always Yehovaw the Father's spokesman to them, Yehovaw having written, through His apostle Paul:

¹All our fathers were under the cloud; and all passed through the sea ²and were all baptized, unto Moses, in the cloud and in the sea ³and did all eat the same spiritual meat ⁴and did all drink the same spiritual drink! For they drank of that spiritual Rock Who followed them: and that Rock was Christ! (1st Corinthians 10:1 to 4)

I take issue with the apostle Paul's claim that Yeshuaw "followed" the Children of Israel; I believe it was certainly He Who led them!

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In anticipation of the day when He would send Yeshuaw to Earth, to become one of the children of Israel, Yehovaw told Moses:

¹⁸I will raise them up a Prophet, from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak, unto them, all that I shall command Him. ¹⁹And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto My words, which He shall speak in My name, I will require it of him.
(Deuteronomy 18:18 and 19)

What Yehovaw would require of any one not hearing, believing and acting upon His words through Yeshuaw would be their privilege of being taken to "Paradise" (Luke 23:43) upon dying; and there was only one other place for the dead at that time, which was "Hell" (Psalm 88; Luke 16:23) in "the heart of the Earth"! (Matthew 12:40)

The English-speaking Christians call their Lord and Master "Jesus" (Matthew 1:21) "the Christ" (Matthew 16:20) from out of the King James bible! But in the Hebrew He is actually Yeshuaw (Strong: Hebrew: 3091, 3444) ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899) or the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25), Whom Yehovaw identified through His apostle John as "the Word" (John 1:1), by Whom "all things were made" (Verse 3) and Who "was made flesh and dwelt among us". (Verse 14) To that astounding truth Yehovaw's faithful apostle John added, with great awe and admiration:

and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth! (John 1:14)

Four thousand years into His children's life on Earth was Yehovaw's choice of time to have Yeshuaw bring, as a brother to them (Romans 8:29), the righteous dead among them from "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40) to "Paradise" (Luke 23:43), which is why the first thing He preached through Yeshuaw was:

Repent! For the kingdom of Heaven is at hand! (Matthew 4:17)

The word "repent" is a King James translation of a word meaning to "think differently"! (Strong: Greek 3340) What one does is the result of what he or she thinks! And, if he or she has not been doing right, it is high time for him or her to "think differently" about his or her actions (Number 3340), particularly if "the kingdom of Heaven is at hand"! (Matthew 4:17)

"the Kingdom of Heaven" has been "at hand" (Matthew 4:17), ever since Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, to the repentant thief hanging on a cross to one side of Yeshuaw, as He was dying on His cross:

Today shalt thou be with Me in Paradise! (Luke 23:43)

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To help His children "think differently" (Strong: Greek 3340), Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw into the world, through the virgin Mary, to become one of His people, the children of Israel, so that Yeshuaw could walk among them and teach them Yehovaw's truth! Yeshuaw told Pilate, the Roman governor who was about to give the order to crucify Him:

To this end was I born and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth! (John 18:37)

Yeshuaw prayed, to the Father,

I have given, unto them, the words that Thou gavest Me! (John 17:8)

Thy word is truth! (John 17:17)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Psalmist:

Thy law is the truth (Psalm 119:142); and

all Thy commandments are truth. (Psalm 119:151)

Indeed, the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law are the expression of His will, without the doing of which no child of the living and eternal Lord God can enter into His kingdom! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Not everyone who saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of Heaven but he who doeth the will of My Father Who is in Heaven! (Matthew 7:21)

Yehovaw's people, the children of Israel, were supposed to know that: for He had said, through Moses:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Confirming the importance of His righteousness, Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness! And all these things shall be added unto you. (Matthew 6:33)

To illustrate what He meant, Yeshuaw miraculously fed a multitude with no more than a boy's lunch to work with (Matthew 14:19 to 21; Mark 6:41 to 43; Luke 9:16 and 17; John 6:11); He calmed winds and stilled waves (Matthew 8:26; Mark 4:39; Luke 8:24);

they brought, unto Him, many who were possessed with devils: and He cast out the spirits, with His word, and healed all who were sick! (Matthew 8:16)

Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw to the children of Israel! Yeshuaw said:

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I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel! (Matthew 15:24)

Yeshuaw forgave the children of Israel; "He said, unto the sick of the palsy" (Mark 2:5):

Son, thy Sins be forgiven thee. (Mark 2:5)

Yeshuaw saved the children of Israel; He said, to a woman :

Thy faith hath saved thee; go in peace! (Luke 7:50)

And Yeshuaw healed the children of Israel, He said, to a blind man:

Receive thy sight! Thy faith hath saved thee. (Luke 18:42)

But those amazing demonstrations of Yehovaw's love for His people, the children of Israel, were to be violently cut short! And He foretold that amazing event, through His psalmist:

I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels! (Psalm 22:14)

My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and Thou hast brought me into the dust of death! (Psalm 22:15)

For dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet! (Psalm 22:16)

Well before the event, Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet:

⁸He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of My people was He stricken! ⁹He made his grave with the wicked and with the rich, in His death; because He had done no violence, neither *was* any deceit in His mouth! (Isaiah 53:8 and 9)

In His own prayer to Yehovaw the Father the night He knew wicked men were coming to kill Him, Yeshuaw told the reason that He would be allowing that to happen:

For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth! (John 17:19)

Yehovaw's truth is that He suffers and dies each time one of His children sins; because His Spirit is in both the sinner and his or her victim, communicating to Him the suffering of the victim and the spiritual death of the sinner, in Yehovaw's having to remove him or her from His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Deuteronomy 30:19; Matthew 19:17) He wrote, through His prophet:

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He was wounded for our transgressions! He was bruised for our iniquities! The chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed! (Isaiah 53:5)

Scholars of the bible believe that the above prophecy relates to what Yeshuaw would suffer on the cross, which is true; but that is not the complete picture! Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw to Earth as His "express image"! (Hebrews 1:3) And Yeshuaw said:

The Son can do nothing of Himself but what He seeth the Father do: for what things soever He doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise! For the Father loveth the Son and showeth Him all things that Himself doeth! And He will show Him greater works than these, that ye may marvel! (John 5:19 and 20)

The "greater works than these" (John 5:20) to which Yeshuaw was referring would be when

He was wounded for our transgressions! He was bruised for our iniquities! The chastisement of our peace was upon Him! (Isaiah 53:5)

All of that unthinkable suffering and death would powerfully show, to Yehovaw's children, how Yehovaw

was wounded for our transgressions! He was bruised for our iniquities! The chastisement of our peace was upon Him (Isaiah 53:5),

each time His children had sinned against another and against Him, Whose Spirit was in the other.

Yehovaw prophesied that "with His stripes we are healed" (Isaiah 53:5); because Yeshuaw lay down His life (John 10:17 and 18), in order that, when "His stripes" (Isaiah 53:5) powerfully showed Yehovaw's truth (John 17:19; 18:37), Yehovaw's sinning children would repent of their sins (Matthew 9:13), confess them (1st John 1:9), be forgiven of them (Verse 9), be cleansed "from all unrighteousness" (Verse 9) and be restored to their place in Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Matthew 5:20)

One of the blessings of being in Yehovaw's kingdom is His healing! He said, through Moses:

If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God and wilt do that which is right in His sight and wilt give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases upon thee that I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the Lord who healeth thee. (Exodus 15:26)

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To appreciate how free of disease Yehovaw's kingdom is, one only needs to read Yehovaw's description of the cursing that awaits those who "wilt not hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all His commandments"! (Deuteronomy 28:15) He said, through Moses:

All these curses shall come upon thee and overtake thee. (Deuteronomy 28:15)

⁵⁸If thou wilt not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that thou mayest fear this glorious and fearful name, THE LORD THY GOD, ⁵⁹then the Lord will make thy plagues wonderful and the plagues of thy seed, even great plagues and of long continuance and sore sicknesses and of long continuance! (Deuteronomy 28:58 and 59)

⁶⁰Moreover he will bring upon thee all the diseases of Egypt, which thou wast afraid of; and they shall cleave unto thee. ⁶¹Also every sickness and every plague that is not written in the book of this law, them will the Lord bring, upon thee, until thou be destroyed! (Deuteronomy 28:60 and 61)

When Yeshuaw prayed on the cross that Yehovaw forgive His enemies; He transformed the worst injustice that had ever been committed on Earth into His fulfillment (Matthew 5:17) of the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law! (Leviticus 17:11) Yehovaw wrote, through His author:

Almost all things are by the law purged with blood! And without shedding of blood is no remission! (Hebrews 9:22)

The night Yeshuaw knew His killers were coming for Him, He offered His disciples a cup of wine, saying,

This is My blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins! (Matthew 26:28)

Leading up to that amazing event for fifteen centuries had been an agreement between Yehovaw and the children of Israel, which He described through His prophet:

The covenant that I made with their Fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt! (Jeremiah 31:32)

During that covenant Yehovaw had allowed the sacrifice of a lamb to represent His suffering and death in the sinning of His children; He said, through Moses:

²⁷If any soul sin through ignorance, then he shall bring a she goat of the first year for a sin offering! ²⁸And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul who sinneth ignorantly ... and it shall be forgiven him. (Numbers 15:27 and 28)

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I would have to add that it was also forgiven the women and children of the repentant man's family, since only Yehovaw's sons were required to suffer watching the lamb bleed and die!

In Yehovaw's Old Testament the word "lamb" is a King James translation of a word meaning "a member of a flock, that is, a sheep or goat"! (Strong: Hebrew: 7716) So, although Yehovaw required "a she goat of the first year for a sin offering" (Numbers 15:27), the lamb became associated with the priest's making "an atonement for the soul who sinneth ignorantly"! (Numbers 15:28) When John the Baptist saw Yeshuaw; He said:

Behold the Lamb of God, Who taketh away the sin of the world! (John 1:29)

But Yehovaw wisely knew that the suffering and death of a lamb had only a limited effect upon the conscience of His sinning children! He wrote, through His author, that His animal sacrifices were

a figure for the time then present ... that could not make him who did the service perfect as pertaining to the conscience! (Hebrews 9:9)

So Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw into the world to make the atonement of His toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11) with His own body and blood! (Matthew 26:26 to 28) And, when He had fulfilled that part of Yehovaw's law (Matthew 5:17), Yehovaw wrote, through His author:

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Hebrews 9:14)

The person whose conscience has been purged of Satan's lies excusing his or her sinning will repent of his or her sins; Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

I am not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance! (Matthew 9:13)

For those among His children who have repented, Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle:

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness! (1st John 1:9)

The person who has been cleansed "from all unrighteousness" (1st John 1:9) is being regarded by Yehovaw as righteous! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

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So Yeshuaw's making the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) on the cross (Matthew 26:28) leads to repentance! (Matthew 9:13) And Repentance encourages confession! (1st John 1:9) And confession obtains righteousness! (Verse 9) And righteousness is Yehovaw's requirement for restoring His sinning children to their places in His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Matthew 5:20)

But Yehovaw has two requirements for restoring His sinning children to their places in His kingdom, exactly as safety deposit boxes in banks need two keys! Yeshuaw said:

If ye forgive Men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you! But, if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. (Matthew 6:14 and 15)

I will give, unto thee, the keys of the kingdom of Heaven! Whatsoever thou shalt bind on Earth shall be bound in Heaven! And whatsoever thou shalt loose on Earth shall be loosed in Heaven! (Matthew 16:19)

Knowing those keys Himself, Yeshuaw prayed, from His Cross:

Father, forgive them: for they know not what they do! (Luke 23:34)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow Me! (Luke 9:23)

When Yeshuaw rose from the dead a gloriously resurrected man, He appeared to His disciples behind locked doors, saying,

Peace be unto you: as My Father hath sent Me, even so send I you! (John 20:21)

Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained! (John 20:21)

When Yeshuaw made the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) on the cross (Matthew 26:28), He did so as Yehovaw's High Priest! Yehovaw wrote, through His author, of Yeshuaw:

In all things it behoved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people! (Hebrews 2:17)

When a person prays that Yehovaw forgive an enemy his or her trespass, as Yeshuaw prayed that Yehovaw forgive His enemies, that person is making an atonement for that enemy, exactly as Yeshuaw made "an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel"!

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(Leviticus 16:17) And Yehovaw's priest is always the one who makes any atonement for the forgiving of a sinner! (Leviticus 16:30; Numbers 15:28) Anticipating that function on the part of His children, Yehovaw said, through Moses:

⁵If ye will obey My voice indeed and keep My covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people: for all the Earth is Mine! ⁶And ye shall be, unto Me, a kingdom of priests and an holy nation! (Exodus 19:5 and 6)

Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet:

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to Me. (Hosea 4:6)

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

⁹They sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book and to open the seals thereof: for Thou wast slain and hast redeemed us, to God, by Thy blood, out of every kindred, tongue, people and nation ¹⁰and hast made us, unto our God, kings and priests! And we shall reign on the Earth! (Revelation 5:9 and 10)

Both requirements of Yehovaw for restoring His sinning children to their place in His glorious and eternal kingdom of life and blessing (Deuteronomy 30:19; Matthew 19:17) were expressed in an important prophecy! Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet, of Yeshuaw:

⁶I, the Lord, have called thee in righteousness and will hold Thine hand and will keep Thee and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles, ⁷to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. (Isaiah 42:6 and 7)

The angel Gabriel told Mary's husband Joseph:

She shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call His name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins! (Matthew 1:21)

In Hebrew, the name "Yeshuaw", from which "Jesus" was, indirectly, a King James translation (Strong: Hebrew: 3091; Greek: 2424), means "salvation"! (Strong: Hebrew: 3444)

For that word of Yehovaw through Gabriel to be fulfilled, Yehovaw would be giving Yeshuaw both "for a covenant of the people" and "for a light of the Gentiles"! (Isaiah 42:6) When Yeshuaw made the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) on the cross (Matthew 26:28), He fulfilled Yehovaw's giving Him "for a covenant of the people"! (Isaiah 42:6) Yeshuaw said, of the wine He offered His disciples:

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This is My Blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins! (Matthew 26:28)

The word "testament" is a King James translation of a word meaning "a disposition, that is, (specifically) a contract (especially a devisory will)", which is translated elsewhere "covenant"! (Strong: Greek: 1242) Yeshuaw was declaring that His shed blood would establish Yehovaw's "new covenant with the house of Israel"! (Jeremiah 31:31)

Yehovaw's giving Yeshuaw "for a light of the Gentiles" (Isaiah 42:6) waited upon His disciples' obedience to the last commandment He would give before Yehovaw brought Him home, to Heaven, to sit on "the right hand of Power"! (Matthew 26:64) He said, to the disciples:

Go ... and teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

That commandment was in fulfillment of Yehovaw's promise to Abraham:

In thy seed shall all the nations of the Earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed My voice! (Genesis 22:18)

To "teach All Nations" (Matthew 28:19) would require that Yehovaw's disciples forgive them (Matthew 6:14 and 15): for "all nations" (Verse 19) were the Gentiles (Strong: Greek: 1484), who included the Romans, who had crucified thousands of Jews, not to mention other heathen nations that had been enemies of the children of Israel for centuries!

To prepare His disciples for their ministry to "all nations" (Matthew 28:19), Yeshuaw had commanded them:

⁴⁴Love your enemies; bless them who curse you; do good to them who hate you; and pray for them who despitefully use you and persecute you, ⁴⁵that ye may be the children of your Father Who is in Heaven! For He maketh His sun to rise on the good and on the evil and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust! (Matthew 5:44 and 45)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow His steps! (1st Peter 2:21)

Yehovaw's teaching through Yeshuaw was fulfilled by Yeshuaw's making the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) on the cross (Matthew 26:28), which powerfully showed Yehovaw's truth about suffering and dying each time one of His children sinned against Him (John 17:19; 18:37), as well as His willingness to

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forgive even His enemies (Luke 23:34), if they have repented of their sins! (Matthew 4:17; Luke 17:3)

Yehovaw's disciples would fulfill their teaching of "all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19 and 20), when they prayed that Yehovaw forgive their enemies for their trespass against them (Matthew 6:14), which would powerfully show their enemies the same truth (Isaiah 53:5), in the hope that their enemies throughout "all nations" (Matthew 28:19) would repent of their sins (Matthew 9:13), confess them (1st John 1:9), be forgiven (Verse 9), be cleansed "from all unrighteousness" (Verse 9) and be restored to their places in Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Deuteronomy 30:19; Matthew 19:17)

To be cleansed "from all unrighteousness" (1st John 1:9) is to be regarded by Yehovaw as righteous! And the one place in His entire Holy Bible where He gives His definition of righteousness is where He said through Moses:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

With fascination the keen student of the bible can see that Yehovaw's requirement for righteousness is the same as His requirement for being given the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! Yeshuaw said,

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father; and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of Truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

It is by the supernatural power of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, that His kingdom provides His life and blessing to all His righteous children! Yeshuaw said:

If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. (Matthew 12:28)

Most people think of "the kingdom of God" (Matthew 12:28) as the place where Yehovaw's throne is in the midst of His "Holy City New Jerusalem"! (Revelation 21:2) But actually Yehovaw's kingdom encompasses His entire universe! It is the spiritual ocean in the midst of which His awesome physical creations float!

So, when Yehovaw removes a sinner from His kingdom it is like a citizen who has been convicted of breaking a statute in the law of his or her state! Immediately he or she loses the rights and privileges of citizenship; but he or she is still physically in the state.

When a lost child of Israel has been saved, Yehovaw considers him or her worthy to be restored as a citizen in His kingdom, the first stage of which is a gloriously blessed life

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here on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21), which, when the saint dies, is followed by an amazing and beautiful time spent "in Paradise" (Luke 23:43), to be followed by Yehovaw's "Resurrection of Life" (John 5:29) and a thousand more years on Earth, when He will have transformed it into another Garden of Eden! (Genesis 2:8; Revelation 21:1, 23 and 24)

As glorious as that picture is, one is sobered by the disheartening fact that all Yeshuaw suffered on the cross was only partly effective in bringing the salvation and redemption that Yehovaw desired for His children: He wrote, through His author:

²⁶If we sin willfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins ²⁷but a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries! (Hebrews 10:26 and 27)

Yehovaw's apostles in Jerusalem did "sin willfully" after having "received the knowledge of the truth" (Hebrews 10:26): for they deliberately defied Yehovaw's commandment through Yeshuaw to

go ... and teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

The apostles in Jerusalem succumbed to Satan's strong temptation to hate rather than love their enemies! And to love their enemies was another critical commandment of Yehovaw through Yeshuaw (Matthew 5:44 and 45), which they foolishly ignored! Yeshuaw said:

¹⁷Think not that I am come to destroy the law or the prophets: I am not come to destroy but to fulfill! ¹⁸For verily I say, unto you, Till Heaven and Earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled! (Matthew 5:17 and 18)

Yeshuaw fulfilled the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) and certain of Yehovaw's words through prophets (Isaiah 53:5), when He suffered and died on the cross (Matthew 26:28) and when He prayed that Yehovaw forgive His enemies! (Luke 23:34)

But it had remained for Yehovaw's disciples to go forth and make that same atonement for the Gentiles of "all nations" (Genesis 22:18; Isaiah 42:6; Matthew 28:19) by praying that Yehovaw forgive their enemies (Matthew 6:14); so there was indeed much yet to be fulfilled in relation to the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law! (Leviticus 17:11; Matthew 5:18) Yeshuaw commanded His disciples:

If thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments! (Matthew 19:17)

Yeshuaw was talking there about "eternal life" (Matthew 19:16); and "the commandments" (Verse 17) to which He was referring were the commandments of

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Yehovaw's toraw or law through Moses! (Verses 18 and 19) He commanded, furthermore:

The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat; all therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do! (Matthew 23:2 and 3)

Yehovaw said, to Moses:

Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear, when I speak with thee, and believe thee for ever! (Exodus 19:9)

In fact Yeshuaw made believing Moses a requirement for believing Yeshuaw! Yeshuaw said:

Had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed Me! For he wrote of Me! But, if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe My words? (John 5:46 and 47)

So One's teaching "all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19 and 20) would emphatically be to teach them Yehovaw's toraw or law through Moses as well as all the other things Yehovaw commanded the children of Israel through Yeshuaw while He was walking among them; so Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke, how in the Spirit of Yehovaw's commandment to "teach all nations" (Matthew 28:19):

Certain men who came down from Judæa taught the brethren, and said, Except ye be circumcised after the manner of Moses, ye cannot be saved! (Acts 15:1) And there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees who believed, saying that it was needful to circumcise them and to command them to keep the law of Moses! (Acts 15:5)

When therefore Paul and Barnabas had no small dissension and disputation with them, they determined that Paul and Barnabas and certain other of them should go, up to Jerusalem, unto the apostles and elders, about this question! (Acts 15:2)

The result of that infamous conference in Jerusalem was that the apostle Paul persuaded the apostles in Jerusalem to write a letter "unto the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23), saying,

We have heard that certain who went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment! (Acts 15:24)

Several years later, the apostle James said, to the apostle Paul:

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²⁰Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are who believe; and they are all zealous of the law! ²¹And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise their children, neither to walk after the customs! (Acts 21:20 and 21)

From that revealing report one learns that in the hearts of the apostles and many thousands of Jews there was no contradiction whatsoever between keeping Yehovaw's toraw or law and Yeshuaw's teachings about it, during which He fulfilled Yehovaw's words through His prophet:

The Lord is well pleased for His righteousness' sake; He will magnify the law and make it honorable! (Isaiah 42:21)

Furthermore, one learns from James' report how far the apostle Paul had wandered from the mainstream of sound doctrine known and understood by the apostles who had actually walked with Yeshuaw and received directly from Him Yehovaw's truth! He wrote, through His psalmist:

Thy law is the truth (Psalm 119:141); and

all Thy commandments are truth. (Psalm 119:151)

Still, the abominable policy of barring "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) from keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law was still in place! For James also said:

As touching the Gentiles who believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing! (Acts 21:25)

So the apostles in Jerusalem, yielding to Satan's temptation to defy Yeshuaw's commandment to "go ... and teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:19 and 20), seriously interfered with the fulfillment of both Yehovaw's promise to Abraham and His prophecy through Isaiah!

In thy seed shall all the nations of the Earth be blessed! (Genesis 22:18) And

I, the Lord ... will ... give Thee ... for a light of the Gentiles! (Isaiah 42:6) aaa

Yehovaw wrote, through His psalmist, of His toraw or law:

Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path! (Psalm 119:105)

The apostles in Jerusalem denied "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) that light! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

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⁴⁶Set your hearts unto all the words that I testify among you this day, which ye shall command your children to observe to do, all the words of this law! ⁴⁷For it is not a vain thing for you; because it is your life! (Deuteronomy 32:46 and 47)

The apostles in Jerusalem denied "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) that life! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father; and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of Truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

The apostles in Jerusalem denied "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, without Whom one "cannot enter into the kingdom of God"! (John 3:5)

Likewise, the apostles in Jerusalem denied "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) Yehovaw's kingdom!

The Gentiles being thus denied the fullness of Yehovaw's heart for His children were "the Gentiles who believe"! (Acts 21:25) So how is it that children of Yehovaw who have believed "the gospel of the kingdom of God" (Mark 1:14), which is "the power of God unto salvation to every one who believeth" (Romans 1:16) could have been denied the knowledge of Yehovaw's truth, of which that gospel consists?

Anticipating that exact difficulty, born of Satan's furious battle to keep Yehovaw's children from having the knowledge of Yehovaw's toraw or law, which is so critical to one's spiritual welfare (Hosea 4:6), Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of Heaven! But whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of Heaven.
(Matthew 5:19)

But there is a fine line between one's heart being right toward Yehovaw, wanting to please Him in every way possible even while being ignorant of what He wants, and being cynically indifferent to what He wants and deliberately ignoring the commandments of His law; so He added, to the above merciful concession this ominous warning:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

Yehovaw severely condemned "the scribes and Pharisees" (Matthew 23:2), calling them "hypocrites" (Verse 13) on their way to "Hell" (Verse 15), in line to "receive the greater damnation" (Verse 14); because they taught Yehovaw's toraw or law through Moses (Verse 2) yet ignored His commandments in their daily affairs! (Verse 3)

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Barred by Yehovaw's apostles in Jerusalem from keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's law (Acts 15:24; 21:25), "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) formed their own lawless, lifeless and spiritless church, which Yehovaw called "the Great Whore"! (Revelation 17:1) Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

Upon her forehead *was* a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH!
(Revelation 17:5)

¹I saw another angel come down, from Heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory! ²And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils and the hold of every foul spirit and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird! (Revelation 18:1 and 2)

For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication! The kings of the Earth have committed fornication with her; and the merchants of the Earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies! (Revelation 18:3)

I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins and that ye receive not of her plagues! (Revelation 18:4)

And in her was found the blood of prophets and of saints and of all who were slain upon the Earth! (Revelation 18:24)

History has shown that during the Middle Ages the Roman Catholic Church killed millions of Christians and Jews!

Priests having defected from the Jesuit Order of that abominable church have claimed that the Roman Catholic Church sponsored communism through the Jesuit Order, by which Stalin slaughtered millions of Christian peasants in Russia!

The defecting priests claimed that the Jesuit Order of that abominable church sponsored Hitler in the Holocaust of six million Jews in Germany!

The defecting priests also claimed that various orders of that abominable Church, laboring under the stressful and self-deprecating rule of celibacy, created and systematically slaughtered untold thousands of babies, burying them underground in mass graves off of numerous tunnels, by priests cohabiting with nuns, for their natural fulfillment!

It is now a matter of public record that numerous priests in that abominable church sexually assaulted thousands of young boys, the priests suffering no more than mere

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shifting of placements, while the boys grew to manhood plagued with guilt and all manner of emotional complications born of being so devilishly violated!

Finally, it was claimed that the Jesuit Order of that abominable church sponsored the false prophet Mohammad, having written his Quran, out of which he taught his false doctrine and out of which the Islamic Jihadists of today attempt to justify killing thousands of innocent people in their holy war against all who do not worship and serve the false god Allah!

So Yeshuaw's amazing sacrifice of Himself to make the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) on the cross (Matthew 26:28) was no guarantee of success for the salvation of Yehovaw's children! It was, simply, His giving "**all that He hath**" (Matthew 13:44) for the treasure in the field or for "**one pearl of great price**" (Verse 46), His going after the one sheep that has "**gone astray**"! (Matthew 18:12)

So it is not surprising that Yehovaw asked, through Yeshuaw, the same sacrifice of self (Matthew 13:44 to 46; Luke 9:23) from those among His children who want to be restored to their places in His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Deuteronomy 30:19; Matthew 19:17)

Yeshuaw's amazing sacrifice of Himself to make the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; Romans 5:11) on the cross (Matthew 26:28) was Yehovaw the Father and Yehovaw the Son working together with the supernatural assistance of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, simply to do the best they could to stem the appalling tide of children determined to raise their foolishness above the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw, exactly as Satan, their adopted father, did in Heaven, before Yehovaw necessarily cast him down to Earth (Ezekiel 28:16), destined for "Hell" (Isaiah 14:15) and "the Lake of Fire"! (Revelation 20:1 to 3)

When Yehovaw finally comes to establish through Yeshuaw His reign over the nations of the world, He will preside over a judgment of those among them who have survived His horrendous destruction of that day! (Revelation 16) And to those among the survivors who have failed to feed, house, clothe, heal and comfort (Matthew 25:42 and 43) "**one of the least of these My brethren**" (Verse 40), Yeshuaw will say:

Depart, from Me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the Devil and his angels! (Matthew 25:41)

When Yehovaw finally comes to establish His kingdom through Yeshuaw for the sake of those who did feed, house, clothe, heal and comfort (Matthew 25:35 and 36) "**one of the least of these My brethren**" (Verse 40), Yeshuaw will say:

Come, ye blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world! (Matthew 25:34)

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Yehovaw told, through Yeshuaw, a beautiful parable foretelling that judgment; His disciples called it "the parable of the tares of the field"! (Matthew 13:36) To explain it to them, He said, through Yeshuaw:

He who soweth the good seed is the Son of Man! The field is the world! The good seed are the children of the kingdom! But the tares are the children of the wicked one. The enemy that sowed them is the Devil! (Matthew 13:37 to 39)

The harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels! As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world! (Matthew 13:39 and 40)

The Son of Man shall send forth His angels; and they shall gather, out of His kingdom, all things that offend and them who do Iniquity and shall cast them into a furnace of fire! There shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth! (Matthew 13:41 and 42)

Then shall the righteous shine forth as the sun, in the kingdom of their Father! Who hath ears to hear, let him hear! (Matthew 13:37)

Yehovaw's government through Yeshuaw upon Earth will gloriously reflect the peace and prosperity that have always prevailed in His kingdom of Heaven! And again, as with all other of His major events planned for them, He has told His people about that amazing government to come, which will be administered by Yeshuaw with the assistance of His resurrected saints! (Revelation 19:11 to 16) Yehovaw said, through His prophet:

Unto us a Child is born; unto us a Son is given! And the government shall be upon His shoulder! And His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace! (Isaiah 9:6)

Of the increase of His government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David and upon his kingdom, to order it and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever! The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this. (Isaiah 9:7)

John the Baptist recognized Yeshuaw and declared,

Behold, the Lamb of God, Who taketh away the sin of the world! (John 1:29)

Then, in His Book of the Revelation, Yehovaw identified Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John, as "the Lamb"! (Revelation 5:8, 12 and 13) That name is used in that amazing vision so many times that one is left with no doubt concerning another important name for Yeshuaw!

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Indeed, by Yehovaw's constant use of the name "the Lamb" and the supreme and final place He has given it in His Holy Bible, one can well surmise that The Lamb is the name of the second Person of the Godhead, of which Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

⁹God also hath highly exalted Him and given Him a name that is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in Heaven and things in Earth, and things under the Earth. (Philippians 2:9 and 10)

Indeed, the "name that is above every name ... the name of Jesus" (Philippians 2:10) is "The Lamb"! (Revelation 5:8, 12 and 13)

In the tremendous vision that Yehovaw gave His faithful apostle John through Yeshuaw, John saw the image of a lamb gloriously representing Yeshuaw:

⁸When He had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down, before the Lamb, having every one of them harps and golden vials full of odors, which are the prayers of saints! ⁹And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book and to open the seals thereof: for Thou wast slain and hast redeemed us, to God, by Thy blood, out of every kindred, tongue, people and nation ¹⁰and hast made us, unto our God, kings and priests! And we shall reign on the Earth! (Revelation 5:8 to 10)

Let us see, through certain of Yehovaw's Holy Scriptures, how Yeshuaw's part in all of Yehovaw's actions has indeed played out:

Psalm 89:19 to 37 Yehovaw's Words to Yeshuaw

¹⁹Thou spakest, in vision, to Thy Holy One, and saidst, I have laid help upon One Who is mighty! I have exalted One chosen out of the people! ²⁰I have found David, My servant! With My holy oil have I anointed Him, ²¹with Whom My hand shall be established! Mine arm also shall strengthen Him. ²²The enemy shall not exact upon Him; nor the son of wickedness afflict Him; ²³And I will beat down His foes, before His face, and plague them who hate Him. (Psalm 89:19 to 23)

²⁴My faithfulness and My mercy shall be with Him: and in My name shall His horn be exalted! ²⁵I will set His hand also in the sea and His right hand in the rivers!

²⁶He shall cry, unto Me, Thou art My Father, My God and the rock of My Salvation! ²⁷Also I will make Him My firstborn, higher than the kings of the Earth! (Psalm 89:24 to 27)

²⁸My mercy will I keep, for Him, for evermore! And My covenant shall stand fast, with Him. ²⁹His seed, also, will I make to endure for ever and His throne as the days of Heaven! ³⁰If His children forsake My law and walk not in My judgments, ³¹if they break My statutes and keep not My commandments, ³²then will I visit their transgression with the rod and their iniquity with stripes! ³³Nevertheless My

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lovingkindness will I not utterly take from Him nor suffer My faithfulness to fail!
(Psalm 89:28 to 33)

³⁴My covenant will I not break nor alter the thing that is gone out of My lips!

³⁵Once have I sworn, by My holiness, that I will not lie, unto David; ³⁶His seed shall endure for ever and His throne as the sun before Me. ³⁷It shall be established for ever, as the moon, and as a faithful witness in Heaven! (Psalm 89:34 to 37)

John 3:34 The Lamb Speaking Yehovaw's Words

He Whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God! For God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto Him! (John 3:34)

John 15:10 The Lamb Promising that You shall Abide in His Love, His Keeping His Father's Commandments and Abiding in His Love

Ye shall abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love (John 15:10),

if ye keep My commandments! (John 15:10)

John 15:13 and 14 The Lamb Laying Down His Life for His Friends

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends! Ye are My friends (John 15:13 and 14),

if ye do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:14)

John 20:30 and 31 The Lamb Being Ha Mawshiyakh, the Son of God

That ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that, believing, ye might have life through His name (John 20:31),

³⁰many other signs truly did Jesus, in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book! ³¹But these are written. (John 20:30 and 31)

1st Peter 2:4 The Lamb Being a Living Stone

To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men but chosen of God and precious (1st Peter 2:4),

as newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word! (1st Peter 2:2)

Revelation 3:20 The Lamb Promising to Come In and Eat with Whomever will Open the Door to Him

I will come in, to him, and will sup, with him (Revelation 3:20),

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if any man hear My voice and open the door! (Revelation 3:20)

Revelation 3:21 The Lamb Granting the Overcomer to Sit with Him in His Throne, His Overcoming and Being Set Down with His Father in His Throne

To him who overcometh will I grant to sit with Me in My throne, even as I also overcame and am set down with My Father in His throne. (Revelation 3:21)

Revelation 22:18 and 19 The Lamb Testifying

¹⁸I testify, unto every man who heareth the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add, unto him, the plagues that are written in this book; ¹⁹and, if any man shall take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part out of the Book of Life and out of the Holy City and from the things that are written in this book. (Revelation 22:18 and 19)

Amen! Alleluia!
