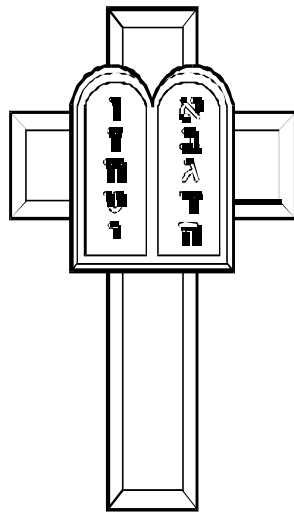

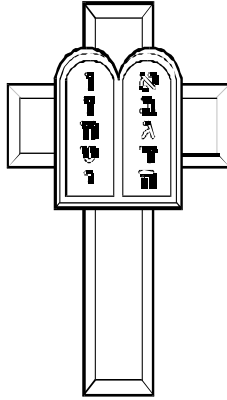

Introduction

Yeshuaw's Birth

Most of us know “the Christmas story”, which was written about Yeshuaw's birth into the world, through Mary, His earthly mother! (Matthew 1:18; Luke 2:1) But, actually, that story began before the world was! Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John,

of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world! (Revelation 13:8)

How can that be?

We know, both by Yehovaw's Holy Bible and by world historians, that Yeshuaw was born near the beginning of our present Gregorian calendar! And by biblical chronology that was approximately four thousand years into mankind's existence on Earth!

Yeshuaw's death occurred three years into His ministry (Daniel 9:26 and 27), which began at His age of thirty! (Luke 3:23) So that would have placed that earthly event at around 33 A.D.!

Key to the Riddle

The key to the riddle lies in the fact that Yehovaw is the Lord God of Faith! He commanded, through Yeshuaw:

Have faith in God! (Mark 11:22)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author:

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things that do appear! (Hebrews 11:3)

Had to Believe

When as Yehovaw “the Word” (John 1:1) Yeshuaw said, “Let there be light”, He had to believe that the creation of light was Yehovaw’s will and that His Spirit of power would cause that manifestation to take place, so that Yehovaw could write, through His recorder:

And there was light. (Genesis 1:3)

That being true, when Yehovaw asked Yeshuaw to be His Lamb, to be sacrificed for the salvation and redemption of their children, Yeshuaw said, “Thy will be done!” (Matthew 26:42) And, right then and there, before “the foundation of the world” (Revelation 13:8), Yehovaw willed that event, Yeshuaw, as Yehovaw “the Word” (John 1:1), spoke it; and ha Kodesh Ruakh, as Yehovaw's Spirit of truth, recorded it (John 16:13), to take place by His power at the exact time it did, sixty-nine and one half prophetic “weeks” of seven years each

from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem (Ezra 1:1 to 4) unto the Messiah the Prince! (Daniel 9:25 to 26)

Prophet of Prophets

Twenty-five centuries after that amazing agreement in Heaven Yehovaw said, through Moses:

The LORD thy God will raise up, unto thee, a Prophet, from the midst of thee, of thy brethren, like unto Me! Unto Him ye shall hearken! (Deuteronomy 18:15)

18I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak, unto them, all that I shall command Him; 19And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto My words, which He shall speak in My name, I will require it of him. (Deuteronomy 18:18 and 19)

The word, image or vision Yeshuaw spoke of that event concerning Him was so clearly, dramatically and vividly recorded by ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, that three millennia later, around 1,000 B.C., He wrote, through His psalmist, of that event, as though it were happening to the psalmist:

I am poured out like water! And all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax! It is melted in the midst of my bowels! (Psalm 22:14)

The Dust of Death

My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and Thou hast brought me into the dust of death! (Psalm 22:15)

Dogs have compassed me: the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me: they pierced my hands and my feet! (Psalm 22:16)

The word, image or vision Yeshuaw spoke of that event concerning Him was so clearly, dramatically and vividly recorded by ha Kodesh Ruakh that three hundred years after that amazing prophecy, around 700 B.C., Yehovaw specifically wrote additional things about it, through His prophet:

He was numbered with the transgressors; He bare the sin of many and made intercession for the transgressors. (Isaiah 53:12)

Yeshuaw was crucified between two thieves! He had said, to His disciples, of wine that He had poured for them to drink:

This is My blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins! (Matthew 26:28)

Yehovaw's Hope

Yehovaw bore, through Yeshuaw, the pain of the entire event, to show His suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another, His hope being that anyone seeing or hearing of it might be made “perfect as pertaining to the conscience” (Hebrews 9:9), that “the blood of Christ, Who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God”! (Verse 14) Yeshuaw said:

I am not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance! (Matthew 9:13)

That declaration of Yeshuaw's mission on Earth tells us that in Yehovaw's sight there were children of His who had already received the truth concerning His suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another, even through the sacrifice of a lamb, having brought one to a priest, for “a sin offering” (Numbers 15:27), to

make an atonement for the soul who sinneth ignorantly! (Numbers 15:28)

When a repentant sinner had watched his lamb bleed and die because of his sin or that of his family, Yehovaw was willing to forgive him and his family of their sins! (Numbers 15:28)

Restored to the Kingdom

By having obediently performed that saving ritual, the repentant Israelite and His family were restored to their place in Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom on Earth (Matthew 6:10), from which flows His life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Deuteronomy 30:19) He wrote, through His Author:

By faith Abel offered, unto God, a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous! (Hebrews 11:4)

“Righteousness” is the condition that is obtained by one's observing to do the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law! Yehovaw said, through Moses:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Repentance for having sinned by breaking some commandment of Yehovaw was expressed in the Israelite's bringing his lamb for a “sin offering”; and, with the lamb having bled and died before the Israelite because of his sin or that of his family, Yehovaw was satisfied and forgave the repentant Israelite and his family!

Exceeding Righteousness

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

From that important declaration by Yehovaw through Yeshuaw we learn that the righteousness obtained by observing or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Deuteronomy 6:25), which is confirmed in performing His ritual of the atonement (Hebrews 11:4), is Yehovaw's requirement for restoring a child to his or her place in His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, the child having lost his or her place in that kingdom when he or she had sinned! Yehovaw said, to Adam:

Of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die! (Genesis 2:17)

Yehovaw's record of generations tells us that Adam lived to be nine hundred and thirty years old before he died (Genesis 5:5); so the death of which Yehovaw warned Adam had to be that of separation from His kingdom on Earth (Matthew 6:10), which resulted in Yehovaw's cursing Adam. (Genesis 3:17 to 19)

Forgiving the Soldiers

Yehovaw was willing to forgive even the Roman soldiers who had nailed Yeshuaw to the cross! Yeshuaw prayed, from the cross:

Father, forgive them: for they know not what they do! (Luke 23:34)

Yehovaw's plan relating to Yeshuaw's life, death and resurrection on Earth required that He be born into the world as a man! And, that being accomplished, along with Yeshuaw's death and resurrection, it would lead to even greater events, of which Yehovaw wrote earlier through His prophet:

Unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given: and the government shall be upon His shoulder! And His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The Mighty God, The Everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace! (Isaiah 9:6)

Yeshuaw was a Child born unto us as a Son! (Luke 1:35) We have not yet seen the world's government “**be upon His shoulder**” (Isaiah 9:6); but, actually, it has never been off of it (Exodus 19:5); He was and is, indeed, “**Wonderful**”! (Isaiah 9:6) Being the words of Yehovaw, Yeshuaw's counsel was and is infinitely wise!

One of the Almighty

Yeshuaw was and is one of the Persons comprising “**The Mighty God**”! (Isaiah 9:6) Being Yehovaw's “**express image**” (Hebrews 1:3), Yeshuaw's appearance, words and deeds were those of “**The Everlasting Father**”! (Isaiah 9:6; John 14:9) And, being “**The Prince**” of all the universe (Isaiah 9:6), He said, to His disciples:

Go in peace! (Luke 7:50)

My peace I give unto you. (John 14:27)

Peace be unto you. (John 20:19, 21 and 26)

All of that peacefulness was spoken, by the will of Yehovaw the Father (Hebrews 11:3), by the voice of Yehovaw “**the Word**” (John 1:1), into existence in Yehovaw “**the Spirit**” (John 16:13) and declared, through His prophets, to the children of Israel, before the earthly fact of it - indeed, “**from the foundation of the world**”! (Revelation 13:8)

Go with me, now, as I look into the facts of Yeshuaw's earthly life, particularly as He magnified His Father's toraw or law and made it “**honorable**”! (Isaiah 42:21)

Chapter 1 - His Person

The Godhead

Yehovaw Elohiym is the holy, almighty, eternal and self-existent Creator and Lord God over all the universe! Being “the Godhead” (Acts 17:29), He is comprised of three Persons, “the Father”, “the Son” and “the Holy Ghost”! (Matthew 28:19)

The word “Godhead” is the King James translation of a Greek word used by Yehovaw through His apostle Paul (Acts 17:29), meaning “divinity” (Strong: Greek: 2304), while “the Holy Trinity” is a traditional name used by the Christian church over the centuries, which cannot be found in Yehovaw’s Holy Bible!

Yehovaw made reference, through Yeshuaw, to the three Persons of the Godhead, in His final commandment to His disciples before bringing Yeshuaw back to Heaven, which has been called His “Great Commission”:

Go ... and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost! (Matthew 28:19)

Only One Name

Notice, please, that, whatever name the disciples were to use in their baptism, it was to be the name of all three of the Persons of the Godhead! There can be only one name that qualifies to be such, as it has been continually used throughout Yehovaw's Old Testament! It is “Yehovaw”, which the King James scholars continually translated “Lord”! (Genesis 2:4; Strong: Hebrew: 3068)

If we believe that our thinking, speaking and acting are important, Yehovaw is the Source of that importance: for each of those three essential functions is so important that He divided them among the three separate Persons of Whom He is comprised, each having a will of His own yet doing primarily the one thing intended for Him, in Yehovaw's plan for the Godhead and for all of His creation!

Chapter 1 - His Person (continued)

Speaking Creation

Whatever is made throughout the universe is made by Yehovaw the Father having thought it, Yehovaw the Word then speaking it into existence, Yehovaw the Spirit then applying the power by which the spoken word of Yehovaw is realized or manifested to Yehovaw's children! (John 14:21)

From reading Yehovaw's book, the Holy Bible, One can know of various names He used: for He revealed Himself to His people in various ways over the many centuries during which He was developing the children of Israel; but this fellowship has settled upon using "Yehovaw", which is the most frequently used name of the Godhead throughout His Old Testament!

Yehovaw's New Testament was written in Greek! So within that context we lose sight of His name as it was derived from the Hebrew language that He gave to His people, the children of Israel!

The second Person of the Godhead is Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), Yeshuaw the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or Jesus "the Christ"! (Matthew 16:20) Yehovaw looked upon Him as "the Son of God" (Luke 1:35; Matthew 28:19) but wanted also that He be "the Son of Man"! (Mark 2:10)

Master and Lord

Yeshuaw said, to His disciples:

Ye call Me Master and Lord! And ye say well! For so I am! (John 13:13)

Yehovaw's designation through His apostle of Yeshuaw's being Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1) clearly indicates that of the three primary functions of the Godhead, "Think, Speak and Act", Yeshuaw is the Person of the Godhead Who always speaks in the creative functions of the Godhead! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. (John 1:1)

All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. (John 1:3)

Yehovaw wrote, through Moses:

God said, Let there be light: and there was light. (Genesis 1:3)

Creating His Children

Taking the image that Yehovaw the Father had of His children, Yehovaw the Word spoke them into existence; and ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit of power and truth, brought the spoken word onto existence, which is how you and I came to be!

Yehovaw's children He “**created ... in His own image**” (Genesis 1:27) or after the likeness of Yeshuaw, Who also is His “**express image**”! (Hebrews 1:3)

Being “**created ... in the image of God**” (Genesis 1:27), Yehovaw's children, too, function with a dominion given them by Him “**over every living thing that moveth upon the Earth**” (Genesis 1:28), to where

whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart but shall believe that those things that he saith shall come to pass, he shall have whatsoever he saith! (Mark 11:23)

Intended to be Yeshuaw's body on Earth (1st Corinthians 12:27), His faithful children participate in the verbal functions of

God, who quickeneth the dead and calleth those things that be not as though they were! (Romans 4:17)

His Name

The second Person of the Godhead is called "Jesus", by the English-speaking world. That name is translated from the Greek word “**ee-ay-sooce**’ ” (Strong: Greek: 2424), which was translated from the Hebrew “**Yeh-ho-shoo'-ah**” (Strong: Hebrew: 3091), which is the name that was given to the child of the virgin Mary by the angel Gabriel, even before His birth as “**the Son of God**” (Luke 1:35), while being at the same time, amazingly, “**the Son of Man**”! (Mark 2:10)

The “**yeh-ho**” part of “**yeh-ho-shoo'-ah**” relates to the Hebrew name “**Yeh-ho-vaw**”, meaning “**self-existent**” or “**eternal**” (Strong: Hebrew: 3068), while “**yaw-shah**’ ” means “**to be open, wide or free**”! (3467) and “**shoo-aw**’ ” in the Hebrew means “**wealthy**”! (7774)

Being “**open, wide or free**” relates to the shield that Yehovaw told Abraham “**I am**” (Genesis 15:1); and “**wealth**” refers to the “**exceedingly great reward**” of which He spoke in the same amazing assurance! (Verse 1)

Shielded and Rewarded

Being shielded and rewarded amounts to being saved! And the Hebrew word for “salvation” is “yeshuaw”, the shortened form of “yeh-ho-shoo’-ah”, which has been the traditional choice of Hebrew name used to represent the One called “Jesus”, Yehovaw “**the Word**” (John 1:1) or Yehovaw “**the Son**”! (Matthew 28:19; Luke 1:35) And a close look at His Person from out of Yehovaw’s book, the Holy Bible, is an highly saving experience!

Whether we are talking about protection, wealth or eternal life, we are talking about Yehovaw, the holy, almighty, eternal and self-existent Creator and Lord God over all the universe, Whose “**express image**” is the Person of Yehovaw “**the Word**” (John 1:1), Yehovaw “**the Son**” (Luke 1:35), Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), Jesus the “**Messiah**” (Daniel 9:25) or Jesus “**the Christ**”! (Matthew 16:20)

In relation to a certain notable character in Yehovaw’s Holy Bible, “Yehoshua” is translated “Joshua” and is the name of the man who led the children of Israel into the land that was promised to them by Yehovaw!

Chapter 2 - His Salvation

Amazing Victories

Joshua's leadership was so important that an entire book in Yehovaw's book of books is named after him; and in it is found Yehovaw's account of Joshua's amazing victories over the wicked inhabitants of the land of Canaan, whose time of judgment had come and who were to be removed from it, to make way for the children of Israel, whose time of inheritance had come.

The name "Yehoshuaw" is given to us again through the New Testament but no longer recognizable as such, having been translated first into Greek as "ee-ay-sooce" (Strong: Greek: 2424), which was then translated as "Jesus" by the King James Scholars. This fellowship follows the messianic Jewish tradition of calling Him "Yeshuaw" or Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1) or "the Lamb" (Revelation 5:8), Who

was made flesh and dwelt among us; and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth! (John 1:14)

Meaning of "Yeshuaw"

Being similar to "Yeh-ho-shoo'-ah", the Hebrew name "Yeshuaw" means "salvation" (Strong: Hebrew: 3444), which is a fitting name for the man from Nazareth (Matthew 2:23), Who would be like the Joshua of old, in that Yeshuaw would lead His people into a land above and beyond anything that you or I can even comprehend! For it is Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power both on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5) and in Heaven! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Repent! For the kingdom of Heaven is at hand! (Matthew 4:17)

Of the glory of Yehovaw's kingdom we are given only a glimpse in His Book of the Revelation through Yeshuaw through His faithful apostle John! But even that glimpse is amazing!

With Him in Paradise

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, to a thief hanging alongside Yeshuaw:

Today shalt thou be with Me in Paradise! (Luke 23:43)

To know Yehovaw is impossible without the office and function of Yehovaw “**the Word**”! (John 1:1) Yeshuaw came to Earth and lived among men, to reveal the Father of all life in the universe! (John 14:7 to 9) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

No Man knoweth the Son but the Father; neither knoweth any man the Father, save the Son and he to whomsoever the Son will reveal Him. (Matthew 11:27)

He who hath seen Me hath seen the Father! (John 14:9)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author:

¹God, Who at sundry times and in divers manners spake in time past unto the fathers by the prophets, ²hath in these last days spoken unto us by His Son, Whom He hath appointed Heir of all things, by whom also He made the worlds, ³Who, being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His Person and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by Himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high! (Hebrews 1:1 to 3)

Speaking Yehovaw’s Words

We must understand that every word Yeshuaw uttered was in behalf of Yehovaw the Father! Yehovaw said, to Moses, of Yeshuaw:

I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak, unto them, all that I shall command Him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)

Many things that Yeshuaw said confirmed His obedience in speaking only what Yehovaw the Father commanded Him to say; Yeshuaw said, to His disciples:

The Son can do nothing of Himself but what He seeth the Father do: for what things soever He doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise! (John 5:19)

I have not spoken of Myself! But the Father Who sent Me, He gave Me a commandment, what I should say and what I should speak! And I know that His commandment is life everlasting! (John 12:49 and 50)

One with the Father

Believest thou not that I am in the Father and the Father in Me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of Myself! But the Father, Who dwelleth in Me, He doeth the works! (John 14:10)

Yeshuaw prayed, to Yehovaw the Father:

I have given, unto them, the words that Thou gavest Me! (John 17:8)

So, when Yeshuaw said, “Ye call Me Master and Lord ... for so I am” (John 13:13), He was speaking in behalf of the Father, Who indeed is “Master and Lord” over all the universe!

When people read how Peter baptized the household of Cornelius “in the name of the Lord” (Acts 10:48), they assume that Peter used the name “Jesus” to do that; but the above scriptures help us to understand that Yeshuaw always spoke in behalf of Yehovaw the Father!

So “the name of the Lord” (Acts 10:48) is “Yehovaw”! And, by “rightly dividing the word of truth” (2nd Timothy 2:15), we infer that the name “Yehovaw” was to be the name used in baptizing “all nations” (Matthew 28:19) with His Holy Spirit!

Teach All Nations

For Yehovaw Commanded, through Yeshuaw:

Go ... and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost! (Matthew 28:19)

Assuredly that name would be the one that embraces all three of those glorious Persons, which name was revealed to the children of Israel, by Yeshuaw or Yehovaw the Word! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

¹I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud and all passed through the sea ²and were all baptized unto Moses, in the cloud and in the sea, ³and did all eat the same spiritual meat ⁴and did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock Who followed them: and that Rock was Christ! (1st Corinthians 10:1 to 4)

So we are obliged to appreciate with awe and wonder the appropriateness and superb comprehensiveness of the name of Him Who has consistently revealed Yehovaw to the children of Israel, for six thousand years, Who is “Yeshuaw” - our God of protection and provision!

Shield and Reward

Yehovaw said, to Abraham:

Fear not, Abram: I am thy shield and thy exceeding great reward! (Genesis 15:1)

Yeshuaw said, to His disciples:

No man cometh unto the Father but by Me! (John 14:6)

So Yeshuaw placed great value upon coming “**unto the Father**” (John 14:6) and upon Himself as the Person by Whom any child of Yehovaw’s may come to the Father; Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

I am the door of the sheep! All who ever came before Me are thieves and robbers! But the sheep did not hear them. (John 10:7 and 8)

I am the Door! By Me if any man enter in, he shall be saved and shall go in and out and find pasture! (John 10:9)

So the matter of one’s coming to Yehovaw is worthy of serious consideration, to understand fully Yehovaw's holy Son of life and light!

Chapter 3 - His Power

Hallowed Be Thy Name

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

After this manner ... pray ye: Our Father Who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name! Thy kingdom come! (Matthew 6:9 and 10)

When Yehovaw began His Ministry through Yeshuaw, He said, through Him:

Repent! For the kingdom of Heaven is at hand! (Matthew 4:17)

Yeshuaw also placed a superb value upon “the kingdom of Heaven”! (Matthew 4:17) So, by “rightly dividing the word of truth” (2nd Timothy 2:15), we find that coming to the Father (John 14:6) compares favorably with entering into His kingdom!

From John's Book of the Revelation we learn that Yehovaw's kingdom includes an exceedingly glorious place awaiting the “sealed ... servants of our God ... of all the tribes of the children of Israel” (Revelation 7:3 and 4), who “keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus”! (Revelation 14:1 to 4 and 12; 22:3 and 4)

Who is Yeshuaw?

If, as Yeshuaw claimed (John 14:6), “No man cometh unto the Father but by Me” and if “God is not a man, that He should lie” (Numbers 23:19), one really needs to look into Who this Yeshuaw is and what He wants of us, if any one of us is to come to Yehovaw the Father and thus enter into the glorious and eternal kingdom about which His holy scriptures tell us so wonderfully! (Revelation 4, 21 and 22) Yehovaw said, through His Apostle Paul:

⁵Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus, ⁶Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God ⁷but made Himself of no reputation and took, upon Him, the form of a servant and was made in the likeness of men! (Philippians 2:5 to 7)

Chapter 3 - His Power (continued)

Obedient unto Death

And, being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross! (Philippians 2:8)

⁹Wherefore God also hath highly exalted Him and given Him a name that is above every name, ¹⁰that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in Heaven and things in Earth and things under the Earth **11** And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father! (Philippians 2:9 to 11)

This is a well known and often quoted text for establishing the supremacy of Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh over all people below Him; and He Himself confirmed His having been so exalted that all below Him should bow to Him and confess Him to be Lord! Yeshuaw said, to His Disciples:

All power is given, unto Me, in Heaven and in Earth! (Matthew 28:18)

“Heaven” and “Earth” are in the midst of the spirit ocean that Yehovaw’s vast kingdom embraces! And, by the worthiness Yeshuaw proved in Himself, Yehovaw has put Yeshuaw in charge of them; but did you notice that the power to which He alluded was “**given**” to Him? (Matthew 28:18)

More Power than He

Someone superior to Yeshuaw and with more power than He had was, necessarily, the Giver of His power; and Yeshuaw confirmed that, saying:

My Father ... is greater than all! (John 10:29)

But whatever Yehovaw the Father has given Yeshuaw will all be returned to Him, at some point: Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Paul:

When all things shall be subdued, unto him, then shall the Son also Himself be subject unto Him Who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all! (1st Corinthians 15:28)

Yeshuaw is Yehovaw “**the Word**” (John 1:1) or one of the Persons of Yehovaw, Who will “**subject unto Him Who put all things under Him**” (1st Corinthians 15:28), which appears to be Yehovaw the Father!

Beholding the Father

I suspect that the eventual consolidation to which Paul alludes will be occasioned by there being no more mortals needing an “Express Image” of the Father by Whom to appreciate Him: for spirit beings can behold the Father directly without His glory overwhelming them; Yehovaw said, to Moses:

Thou canst not see My face! For there shall no man see Me and live! (Exodus 33:20)

When we read Yehovaw’s prophecy through His Apostle Paul “that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord” (Philippians 2:9 to 11), we must allow that the term “Lord” throughout all the bible means “Yehovaw”! And the literal bottom line of that prophecy is that “the Glory of God the Father” or, more accurately, of Yehovaw the Father is that to which all else leads!

To gain a clearer understanding of that “Name ... above every name” (Philippians 2:9), we have a ways yet to go! For in Yehovaw’s vision through Yeshuaw to His faithful apostle John, the name “Jesus” is not even used, being superseded by the name “Lamb”, where obvious references are made to Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), the “Messiah” (Daniel 9:25) or “the Christ”! (Matthew 16:20)

The Lamb of God

John the Baptist gave the first hint of that name, to the children of Israel, saying:

Behold the Lamb of God, Who taketh away the sin of the world! (John 1:29)

And looking upon Jesus as he walked, he saith, Behold the Lamb of God! (John 1:36)

When Yehovaw had taken through Yeshuaw His faithful apostle John up into His throne room, all that John heard were constant references to the Lamb!

When He had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down. before the Lamb, having every one of them harps and golden vials full of odors, which are the prayers of saints! (Revelation 5:8)

Worthy is the Lamb Who was slain to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing! (Revelation 5:12)

Power to the Lamb

Every creature that is in Heaven, on the Earth and under the Earth and such as are in the sea and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, honour, glory and power, be unto Him Who sitteth upon the throne and unto the Lamb for ever and ever! (Revelation 5:13)

So Yehovaw “the Word” (John 1:1), Yehovaw “the Son” (Matthew 28:19), “the Son of God” (Luke 1:35), “the Son of Man” (Mark 2:10), “Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh” (Strong: Hebrew: 3444 and 4899) or “the Lamb” (Revelation 5:12) - Take your pick! - they All cause us to appreciate with awe and wonder the appropriateness and superb comprehensiveness of that most beautiful of all names - Yeshuaw, our God of protection and provision (Genesis 15:1), which He bore not for His own sake but in His representation and revelation of Yehovaw the Father!

Chapter 4 - His Works

Greater Works

Yeshuaw said:

He who believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also! And greater works than these shall he do, because I go unto My Father! (John 14:12)

We know that “the works”(John 14:12) of Yeshuaw were awesome! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed of the devil! For God was with Him. (Acts 10:38)

Yeshuaw’s greatest work as “the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world” (Revelation 13:8), was to suffer and die on the cross, to reveal the truth of Yehovaw's suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another; and, that truth having been revealed, He then showed the Father’s willingness to forgive the repentant among those children!

Come to Call Sinners

Yeshuaw said:

I am not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance! (Matthew 9:13)

Father, forgive them: for they know not what they do! (Luke 23:34)

As the Father hath life in Himself, so hath He given to the Son to have life in Himself and hath given Him authority to execute judgment also; because He is the Son of man! (John 5:26 and 27)

I can of Mine own self do nothing! As I hear, I judge! And My judgment is just; because I seek not Mine own will but the will of the Father Who hath sent Me. (John 5:30)

Chapter 4 - His Works (continued)

Ordained to Be the Judge

Yehovaw preached, through His apostle Peter, concerning Yeshuaw:

⁴Him God raised up the third day and shewed Him openly, ⁴not to all the people but unto witnesses chosen before of God, even to us, who did eat and drink with Him after He rose from the dead ⁴And He commanded us to preach unto the people and to testify that it is He Who was ordained of God to be the Judge of the quick and the dead! (Acts 10:40 to 42)

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His Faithful Apostle John:

Thou art worthy to take the book and to open the seals thereof: for Thou wast slain and hast redeemed us, to God, by Thy blood, out of every kindred, tongue, people and nation! (Revelation 5:9)

By what issued from them (Revelation 6), we can ascertain that “the seals” were on Yehovaw's Book of Judgment! And by His proven worthiness Yeshuaw was able to release them, to determine Yehovaw's blessings and cursings on His children for the next two millennia!

A Good Question

But what judge can render judgments based upon previous actions by people brought before him without a standard or a law by which to determine the rightness or wrongness of those actions?

So what does it mean that Yeshuaw “was ordained of God to be the Judge of the quick and the dead” (Acts 10:42) without there being Yehovaw’s toraw or law in place, by which to determine righteousness or wickedness in those who are alive or dead?

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Think not that I am come to destroy the law or the prophets! I am not come to destroy but to fulfill! For verily I say, unto you, Till Heaven and Earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled! (Matthew 5:17)

Is it not reasonable to suppose that a “fulfilled” law is one that has been used to judge the conduct of a citizen under its jurisdiction?

What other purpose has there been for any law of any land?

Universal Jurisdiction

Who is not under the jurisdiction of the holy, almighty, eternal and self-existent Creator and Lord God over all the universe? Yehovaw said, through Moses:

One law shall be to him who is homeborn and unto the stranger who sojourneth among you. (Exodus 12:49)

When Yehovaw will by His “**Resurrection of Life**” (John 5:29) have brought through Yeshuaw, up out of the world and into Heaven, His righteous saints, He will send, upon the wicked left in the world, His

seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, Who liveth for ever and ever!
(Revelation 15:7)

That is a prophecy of the end time contained in Yehovaw’s vision through Yeshuaw to His faithful apostle John, who “heard the angel of the waters say,” (Revelation 16:5)

⁵Thou art righteous, O Lord, Who art and wast and shalt be; because Thou hast judged thus ⁶For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets! And Thou hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy! (Revelation 16:5 and 6)

The Supreme Law

Whereas the law declared in the Constitution of the United States declares itself to be “the supreme law of the land”, Yehovaw’s toraw is the supreme law of the universe! And, when He sits on His “**Great White Throne**” (Revelation 20:11) to judge “**the dead, small and great**” (Verse 12), He will be the Court of Final Appeal

from Whose face the Earth and the Heaven fled away! And there was found no place for them. (Revelation 20:11)

In case you are wondering what the basis of that judgment will be, all you have to do is open Yehovaw’s Holy Bible to its first five books, Genesis through Deuteronomy! And you will find His entire system of justice laid out before you, which will be in force “**till Heaven and Earth pass**”! (Matthew 5:17)

The only exception to that immutability are the animal sacrifices of Yehovaw’s toraw or law, which He commanded be made only in His Temple, which He has now permitted to be destroyed! (Matthew 24:2) But His sacrifices will be reinstated in a temple that no one has yet seen on Earth, according to a Vision that Yehovaw gave His prophet! (Ezekiel 45:19 to 21)

Chapter 4 - His Works (continued)

The Priest as Judge

According to Yehovaw's toraw or law, the priest functions as the judge (Deuteronomy 17:9); so we find Yeshuaw, our "Judge of the quick and the dead" (Acts 10:42), referred to also as our "High Priest"! Yehovaw wrote, through His Author, of Yeshuaw:

In all things it behoved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people! (Hebrews 2:17)

As the High Priest of the children of Israel, Yeshuaw "ever liveth to make intercession for them" (Hebrews 7:25), which He demonstrated while dying on the cross, praying,

Father, forgive them: for they know not what they do! (Luke 23:34)

So Yeshuaw became "the Lamb of God, Who taketh away the sins of the world" (John 1:29), by His interceding for them with Yehovaw the Father, to forgive them, thereby

showing mercy unto thousands of them who love Me and keep My commandments! (Exodus 20:6)

Notice, please, that Yehovaw did not say through John the Baptist that as "the Lamb of God", Yeshuaw takes away all the sins of the world.

Repent for the Kingdom

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Repent! For the kingdom of Heaven is at hand! (Matthew 4:17)

I am not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance! (Matthew 9:13)

“Repent” means to “think differently”! (Strong: Greek: 3340) The false rationale used by those who violate their neighbor and the Lord God Who is in the neighbor must be changed to their keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law (Exodus 20:6) before He can or will forgive any of them;

Yehovaw said, through Moses:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

Being Hypocrites

Yehovaw criticized, through Yeshuaw, the scribes and Pharisees, for being “**hypocrites**” (Matthew 23:13), who, having taught “**in Moses' seat**” (Verse 2) “**say and do not**”! (Verse 3) Being a mix of both “hot” and “cold”, people with that mischievous mentality have a serious problem! For Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

I would thou wert cold or hot! So then, because thou art lukewarm and neither cold nor hot, I will spew thee out of My mouth! (Revelation 3:15 and 16)

Chapter 5 - His Righteousness (continued)

Yeshuaw's Intercession

The most notable example of Yeshuaw's intercession for the children of Israel is in Yehovaw's requirement for receiving the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit:

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father; and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

Yeshuaw permitted wicked men to kill Him (Matthew 27:35) and then rose up to be a gloriously resurrected man! (Luke 24:3 to 9; John 20:19 and 20) Yet the works of the apostles who followed Him were amazing too! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

These signs shall follow them who Believe! In My name shall they cast out devils! They shall speak with new tongues! ... And, if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick; and they shall recover! (Mark 16:17 and 18)

That will I do!

Verily, verily, I say, unto you, He who believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also! And greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father! And whatsoever ye shall ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son! (John 14:12)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Paul:

The manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal! (1st Corinthians 12:7)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author, of “⁴those who were once enlightened ... ⁵and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the world to come” (Hebrews 6:4 and 5) or those of the “**kingdom of God**” (Matthew 12:28), which Yeshuaw said “**is come unto you**” when “**by the Spirit of God**” He had “**cast out devils**”! (Verse 28)

Deep in the heart of every one of us lies the desire to cause miraculous things to happen! As children of the Most High God, we simply know that doing the amazing thing is a natural part of our heritage! And for some who have not been too discouraged concerning such power, the search of their lives is to learn how these things can be accomplished and their most heartfelt desires fulfilled!

Chapter 5 - His Righteousness (continued)

The Supernatural World

Satan knows that Yehovaw's children enjoy the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! And Satan works to convince them that his version of the supernatural world is where that fulfillment lies!

But, tragically, Satan's road to fulfillment leads to the certain destruction of Yehovaw's children rather than to their glorious fulfillment in Yehovaw! It is trying to "come to the Father" (John 14:6) by some way other than Yeshuaw, Who is Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1) and the "Express Image" (Hebrews 1:3) of Yehovaw, Who is "the Redeemer of Israel" (Isaiah 49:7) and their Savior! (Isaiah 43:3)

We are right back to Square One, at the moment: for I have not yet shown how a person can come to Yehovaw the Father by Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), Jesus the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or Jesus "the Christ"! (Matthew 16:20) The answer is the simplest thing imaginable, really; yet that simplicity has escaped the human race for six thousand years, despite all that Yeshuaw has done to bring the knowledge of it to Yehovaw's people, the children of Israel!

A God Showing Mercy

To the children of Israel, Yehovaw spoke of Himself as a God "showing mercy unto thousands of them who love Me and keep My commandments"! (Exodus 20:6) Then, He told His Disciples, through Yeshuaw:

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends! Ye are My friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:13 and 14)

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father; and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

He who hath My commandments and keepeth them, he it is who loveth Me; and he who loveth Me shall be loved of My Father! And I will love him and will manifest Myself to him. (John 14:21)

That is all there is to it: simply love Yehovaw and keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law! And that being the awesome simplicity of mankind's entrance into Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, every lying devil that Satan can summon has been unleashed against that simplicity and truth! On my website, I call it "the lost truth of Yehovaw"!

Wicked Strategy

Satan's major strategy is to lead Yehovaw's children into every avenue of self realization other than the one offered by Yeshuaw, bringing confusion and perplexity into the life of every one of us, until we come before Yehovaw repenting of our foolishness and crying out:

God, be merciful to me, a sinner! (Luke 18:13)

Of the man who did that, Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

I tell you, this man went down to his house justified! ... For every one who exalteth himself shall be abased! And he who humbleth himself shall be Exalted! (Luke 18:14)

Satan's approach to tasting of the supernatural always appeals to a person's sense of sufficiency without Yehovaw, while Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Without Me, ye can do nothing! (John 15:5)

Chapter 6 - His Friendship

Being Friends with Him

Without a person's voluntary submission to Yehovaw's will as it has been expressed through His word, law, covenant and commandments, the rebel winds up in an involuntary state of oppression, powerless to accomplish anything, which is extremely humiliating and far more humbling than the simple humility Yehovaw asks of us in the first place, Who is willing to do the utterly amazing thing in behalf of His children, if they will simply be the friend to Him that He desired when He created them. (John 15:13 to 15) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

I have called you friends! For all things that I have heard of My Father I have made known unto you! (John 15:15)

Word of Truth

In the prayer that He spoke the night wicked men would be coming to kill Him, Yeshuaw said, to Yehovaw the Father:

I have given them the words that Thou gavest Me! (John 17:8)

Thy word is truth! (John 17:17)

And through His psalmist, Yehovaw declared:

Thy law is the truth (Psalm 119:142); and

All Thy commandments are truth. (Psalm 119:151)

That same night Yeshuaw also prayed:

For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth! (John 17:19)

Witnessing to the Truth

To the Roman governor Pilate, who would be giving the order to crucify Him, Yeshuaw said:

To this end was I born and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth! Every one who is of the truth heareth My voice! (John 18:37)

Since “**the truth**” (John 18:37) relates specifically to Yehovaw's law and commandments (Psalm 119:142 and 151), is it any wonder that, in His specifying who are His friends, Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Ye are My friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:14)

And are we not astonished to learn that it was specifically for those who would obey Him and the Father Who sent Him that Yeshuaw did indeed give Himself into the hands of wicked men, who proceeded to kill Him.

Greater Love

Yeshuaw said:

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends! Ye are My friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:13 and 14)

This brings us right back to the condition Yeshuaw laid down for any child of His receiving the supernatural manifestations of His Kodesh Ruakh or Holy Spirit:

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! (John 14:15)

Yehovaw told His disciples, through Yeshuaw, that they must love Him and keep His commandments, if they wanted Him to pray that Yehovaw the Father give them His Holy Spirit of power and truth! (John 14:15 to 17) Does that mean that Yehovaw demands a lifelong record of perfect obedience to His commandments, before He will empower His children and enlighten them with ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit?

That would be an hopeless situation! And a look into the meaning of the words “keep” and “observe” clarifies this perplexing issue:

Chapter 6 - His Friendship (continued)

“Keep” or “Observe”

Whether a person is reading in the Old Testament or the New, the words “keep” or “observe” are continually used to express Yehovaw’s desire for His children in relation to the commandments of His toraw or law as well as the commandments He gives each one of us through the communication of His Kodesh Ruakh or Holy Spirit in our hearts! And, when we look up either “keep” or “observe” in James Strong's Exhaustive Concordance, we find that either of them, whether in the Hebrew of the Old Testament or the Greek of the New, reflects the basic idea of guarding something.

In the Old Testament, either “keep” or “observe” is a translation of the Hebrew word “shaw-mar’ ”, which means “to hedge about as with thorns, i.e. guard”! (Strong: Hebrew: 8104) In the New Testament, either of those words relates to the Greek word “tay-reh’-o”, meaning “to guard by keeping the eye upon”. (Strong: Greek: 5083)

What do we guard?

Old worn out clothing or used milk cartons?

Guarding the Valuable

No, beloved visitor: we guard our lives, our health, our families, our homes and cars, our gold and silver, our precious jewels and the money that represents these valuable things. In fact, we put a value upon these things; or we would not bother to guard them.

Adding to those definitions is Yehovaw’s commandment that His children love Him **“with all thine heart, with all thy soul and with all thy might”!** (Deuteronomy 6:5)

So it has been for us to guard or to put the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law that He has pled with us, all these six millennia, putting to rest forever the heresy of Satan that God is a beast for having demanded an impossible thing of His people, which is perfectly obeying every commandment that He ever gave to His children before He will do anything for them.

Yehovaw is Interested in His child’s heart and its direction, which is why the Old Testament made reference to the **“Perfect Heart”!** (2nd Kings 20:3)

Of the man who cried out **“God, be merciful to me, a sinner”** (Luke 18:13), Yeshuaw said, **“I tell you, this man went down to his house justified”!** (Verse 14)

Be Ye Perfect

The heart of the man asking for Yehovaw's mercy had entered into the perfection asked by Yehovaw through Yeshuaw, when He said,

Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father Who is in Heaven is Perfect. (Matthew 5:48)

The repentant man's cry related to the law of his God, because he was asking Yehovaw's mercy upon him for his being "a sinner"! (Luke 18:13) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Sin is the transgression of the law! (1st John 3:4)

Returning to the words of Yehovaw through Yeshuaw, we find that the commandments of His toraw or law were exactly what He meant, when He said,

If ye love Me, keep My Commandments! (John 14:15)

For a man asked Yeshuaw:

What good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? (Matthew 19:16)

Yehovaw's Answer through Yeshuaw was:

If thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments! (Matthew 19:17)

The inquirer asked, "Which?" (Matthew 19:18) And Yehovaw then quoted, through Yeshuaw, six commandments directly from out of His toraw or law through Moses! (Verses 18 and 19)

Chapter 7 - His Law

Scribes and Pharisees

To His disciples and an entire “multitude” (Matthew 23:1), Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses’ seat: All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do! (Matthew 23:2 and 3)

Yehovaw had said, to Moses himself:

Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear, when I speak with thee, and believe thee for ever! (Exodus 19:9)

Yehovaw said those words to Moses right before He spoke the Ten Commandments to His children from Mount Sinai! Fifteen centuries later He said, through Yeshuaw:

Had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed Me! For He wrote of Me! But, if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe My words? (John 5:46 and 47)

Being in Torments

In Yehovaw’s story through Yeshuaw about Lazarus and the rich man, the rich man “**lifted up his eyes, being in torments**”! (Luke 16:23) The rich man was concerned about his five brothers’ ending up in the same torment! Yeshuaw quoted Abraham as telling the rich man:

They have Moses and the Prophets! Let them hear them! (Luke 16:29)

The rich man had wanted Abraham to send Lazarus to warn his five brothers about the torment that awaited them, if they did not enter into the righteousness that Lazarus had apparently enjoyed, even though he had been no more than

a certain beggar ... who was laid at the rich man’s gate, full of sores and desiring to be fed with the crumbs that fell from his table! (Luke 16:20 and 21)

Chapter 7 - His Law (continued)

A Matter of Salvation

Whether the rich man's brothers avoided his torment or not was a matter of their salvation, beloved visitor; yet Yehovaw's words through Abraham recommended "**Moses and the prophets**", for their remedy! (Luke 16:29) And, when the rich man insisted that "**if one went unto them from the dead, they will repent**" (Luke 16:30), Yehovaw's answer through Abraham's was astonishing:

If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead! (Luke 16:31)

Yeshuaw would be rising from the dead; and what would be the chance of people believing Yehovaw's words through Yeshuaw, if they have spurned His words through Moses?

For, when He came to walk among the children of Israel, Yeshuaw would be doing exactly what Yehovaw said through His prophet that Yeshuaw would do:

The Lord is well pleased for His righteousness' sake; He will magnify the law and make it honorable! (Isaiah 42:21)

Exception to the Rule

But church history sadly comments upon the fact that not many paid any attention to what Yeshuaw said about Yehovaw's toraw or law. It is the delight of this fellowship to be an exception to that rule!

The fulfillment of Yeshuaw's own ministry among the children of Israel was expected to hang upon the effect of His death and resurrection! Yet we are instructed, by these amazing words, that His return "**from the dead**" (Luke 16:30) would have no meaning to any persons who "**hear not Moses and the prophets**"! (Luke 16:31) Yehovaw said through Yeshuaw:

If ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe My words? (John 5:47)

Before Abraham was, I AM! (John 8:58)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul, of Yeshuaw:

¹I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea ²and were all baptized, unto Moses, in the cloud and in the sea ³and did all eat the same spiritual meat ⁴and did all drink the same spiritual drink! For they drank of that spiritual Rock Who followed them: and that Rock was Christ! (1st Corinthians 10:1 to 4)

Chapter 7 - His Law (continued)

Yeshuaw the Anointed

The disciple Peter called Yeshuaw “**the Christ**” (Matthew 16:16), indicating that he recognized Yeshuaw to be the anointed “**Most Holy One**” (Daniel 9:24) of Israel spoken about by the prophet and “**Messiah the Prince**” (Verse 25), Who would be “**cut off but not for Himself**” (Verse 26), exactly as Yeshuaw was killed at exactly the time specified by “**the man (angel) Gabriel**” (Verse 21), who had “**come forth to give thee skill and understanding**”! (Verse 22)

As Yehovaw “**the Word**” (John 1:1), Yeshuaw was the One Who gave to Abraham and to Moses the blood covenant of Yehovaw the Father, which contained the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law! It was to be “**an everlasting covenant**” (Genesis 17:13; Leviticus 24:8; Psalm 105:10), which explains why Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His prophet, of His “**New Covenant with the House of Israel**” (Jeremiah 31:31):

This shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel: After those days, saith the Lord, I will put My law in their inward parts and write it in their hearts! And I will be their God; and they shall be My people! (Jeremiah 31:33)

Come to Fulfill

Yeshuaw declared, of His Mission:

¹⁷Think not that I am come to destroy the law or the prophets: I am not come to destroy but to fulfill! ¹⁸For verily I say, unto you, Till Heaven and Earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled! (Matthew 5:17 and 18)

Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of Heaven! But whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of Heaven. (Matthew 5:19)

For I say, unto you, that except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

Yehovaw was dealing, through Yeshuaw, specifically with His “**law or the prophets**” (Matthew 5:17), as He continued to plead with the children of Israel to keep or put the highest possible value on His commandments, for their best possible experience in “**the kingdom of Heaven**”! (Verse 19) Then He talked about “**righteousness**” and acceptable or unacceptable degrees of that critical standing in Yehovaw’s sight! (Verse 20)

Righteousness and Obedience

In Yehovaw's toraw or law, He gave the children of Israel this definition of righteousness - the only one in His entire Holy Bible:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

There it is again, that word "observe", which means to put the highest possible value on "all these commandments"! (Deuteronomy 6:25)

The person whose heart is thus disposed has entered into the righteousness required by Yehovaw through Yeshuaw down through the millennia for coming to the Father and into His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, both on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5) and in Heaven! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19)

Chapter 8 - His Truth

The Enabling Truth

Since one's coming to the Father cannot be accomplished except by Yeshuaw (John 14:6), we see His primary Mission as that of bringing to His children the truth of the words of His Father (John 18:37), which relates directly to His covenant and the commandments of His toraw or law (John 17:8; Psalm 119:142, 151), by the keeping of which one does come to the Father!

More specifically relevant to "righteousness" is Yehovaw's commandment relating to the atonement of His toraw or law (Numbers 15:27 and 28), which He instituted clear back with the two sons of Adam and Eve! (Genesis 4) Yehovaw wrote, through His author:

By faith Abel offered, unto God, a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous! (Hebrews 11:4)

Righteousness and Sacrifice

The reason for that way of becoming "righteous" (Hebrews 11:4) is that Yehovaw's atonement, in which the sinner must watch an innocent animal be unjustly killed, is His way of reproofing the hearts of His children in relation to their having sinned against Him, Whose Spirit is in each of those children who are hurt in being sinned against! For ha Kodesh Ruakh immediately communicates to Him the pain of the sin that is unjustly thrust upon the sinner's victim; and He also communicates to Yehovaw the pain of separation resulting from the fact that anyone who sins He immediately removes from His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! Yehovaw called that terrible separation "Death"! He said, to Adam:

Of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die! (Genesis 2:17)

Chapter 8 - His Truth (continued)

Long but Short

Yehovaw's record in His Book of Genesis tells us that Adam lived to be nine hundred thirty years old before he died physically! (Genesis 5:5) So the "death" spoken of by Yehovaw in His warning to Adam related to the spiritual death of separation from His kingdom on Earth that would result should Adam disobey Him.

It is for that reason that Yehovaw showed, through Yeshuaw, the direct relationship between righteousness and one's entering the kingdom of Heaven! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

Yehovaw was willing to forgive His Erring children, by which forgiveness they become righteous and which is the object of every atonement! But that merciful provision He gives only when His punishment of them or the truth of the atonement about how their sin has brought suffering and death to themselves and others, including Himself, has caused them to repent of their sins, which means to "think differently"! (Strong: Greek: 3340)

Sin and the Law

Considering that "**sin is the transgression of the law**" (1st John 3:4), Yehovaw's purpose in the atonement is to cause the sinner to "think differently" (Strong: Greek: 3340) about having transgressed the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law!

How Yehovaw's atonement causes a change of heart in the child who participates in the atonement of His toraw or law is interesting!

Yehovaw suffers the pain of a victim's hurt, when His Child sins; and He also suffers the death of the sinner's separation from His kingdom! So for generations He commanded the sinner to bring a goat to a priest (Numbers 15:27), which in Hebrew is also considered to be a "lamb"! (Strong: Hebrew: 7716)

The lamb was to be a "**sin offering**" (Numbers 15:27); and the Priest would cut its throat and make it bleed to death, before the sinner, which impressed upon him the fact that his sin or that of his family had thrust both suffering and death upon an innocent animal, which represented the unjust suffering and death of Yehovaw in His innocence that the Israelite's sin or that of his family had thrust upon Him - the suffering of their victim and the death of their immediate separation from His kingdom!

Chapter 8 - His Truth (continued)

The Sinner's Conscience

When the sinner had experienced the emotional trauma of watching the lamb bleed and die, Yehovaw was satisfied that the sinner's conscience had been reprov'd or brought a step nearer to the repentance needed to be restored to His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! Yehovaw wrote, through His author, of His animal sacrifice, that it was

a figure for the time then present ... that could not make him who did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience! (Hebrews 9:9)

Although the result of the Old Covenant's atonement was not "perfect, as pertaining to the conscience" (Hebrews 9:9), it was a step toward making the sinner perfect in that regard; and, for the time being, Yehovaw was satisfied with that ritual as the way by which to restore His children to the life, blessing, liberty, joy and power of His glorious and eternal kingdom on Earth!

But, because the affect of the animal sacrifice upon His children's consciences was not perfect, even the righteous among them - those who had faithfully participated in the atonement of His toraw or law (Numbers 15:27 and 28) - Yehovaw brought them no further than "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40), when they died, as was the case with "Lazarus" and "the rich man"! (Luke 16:22 and 23)

A New Development

But the time came when Yehovaw's plan for His children required that Yeshuaw bring them to "Paradise" (Luke 23:43) in "the kingdom of Heaven"! (Matthew 4:17) And His atonement for them had to become far more impressive! They really had to get the message of how serious their sinning one against another was in hurting not only their victim and themselves but Him as well, both as to the victim's pain and the death of the sinner's separation from Yehovaw's kingdom on Earth! (Matthew 6:10)

So Yehovaw took advantage of the fact that before "the foundation of the world" (Revelation 13:8) He had asked Yeshuaw to be His Lamb for the supreme atonement of all time, which He hoped would prepare His children's hearts adequately to be accepted in Heaven!

Chapter 8 - His Truth (continued)

Behold the Lamb

So, when He had sent Yeshuaw to Earth, to become through Mary both “the Son of God” (Luke 1:35) and “the Son of Man” (Mark 2:10), John the Baptist saw Him and said:

Behold the Lamb of God, Who taketh away the sin of the world! (John 1:29)

When it came time for Yeshuaw to submit to the hands of His murderers, He explained, to His disciples that His blood would be

of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins! (Matthew 26:28)

Being completely familiar with Yehovaw’s atonement by the sacrifice of lambs - particularly on His Day of Atonement (Leviticus 16) - there was no way that the disciples could miss the significance of that amazing statement! Yeshuaw was going to make, of His own body and blood a “sin offering”! (Verse 5) And, when His blood was shed, they had to know that He had “made an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel”! (Verse 17)

Chapter 9 - His Forgiveness

To Be Forgiven

The object of every sinner's participation in the atonement of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Numbers 15:27 and 28) had been to obtain Yehovaw's forgiveness for the repentant sinner and his family! He said, through Moses, of the Israelite's obedience in the atonement:

It shall be forgiven him. (Numbers 15:28)

Yehovaw said, through Moses, of His Day of Atonement:

On that day shall the priest make an atonement for you, to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord! (Leviticus 16:30)

So it was where Yeshuaw prayed for Yehovaw to forgive His children that He transformed the most cruel and senseless injustice ever to be committed on Earth into the most amazing atonement ever performed in behalf of "all the congregation of Israel"! (Leviticus 16:17)

Joy in God

Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Paul:

We ... joy, in God, through our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom we have now received the atonement! (Romans 5:11)

Since Yeshuaw provided His own body and blood as the "sin offering" (Leviticus 16:5; Matthew 26:26 to 28), that part of the atonement was not required of "all the congregation of Israel" (Leviticus 16:17); so what remained was for them to "afflict your souls"! (Verse 31)

Chapter 9 - His Forgiveness (continued)

Afflict Your Souls

To show the children of Israel how to “afflict your souls” (Leviticus 16:31), which got right down to the object of every atonement ever performed, Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle:

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness! (1st John 1:9)

That well confirms what Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and, if he repent, forgive him. (Luke 17:3)

That infinitely wise and loving way of dealing with one’s offending neighbor is an exact mirror of the way in which Yehovaw applies the atonement that Yeshuaw performed on the cross “for all the congregation of Israel”! (Leviticus 16:17) It only becomes effective when the person hearing about it reacts appropriately!

The Purged Conscience

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author:

How much more shall the blood of Christ ... purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Hebrews 9:14)

The condition of one’s “conscience” - often considered one’s heart - concerning his or her keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law is the whole point of what Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw to accomplish “for all the congregation of Israel”! (Leviticus 16:17)

When each child of Israel feels himself or herself purged from any further desire to perform “dead works” or things done contrary to Yehovaw’s toraw or law, his or her natural reaction is to repent of that deadness (Matthew 4:17) and confess it (1st John 1:9), whereupon Yehovaw forgives and cleanses “from all unrighteousness” (Verse 9) and restores the His Child not only to His Kingdom on Earth (Matthew 6:10) but upon the child’s death to His “kingdom of Heaven”! (Matthew 5:20)

It is the “righteousness” (Matthew 5:20) of afflicting one’s soul (Leviticus 16:31) that qualifies a child to “enter into the kingdom of Heaven”! (Matthew 5:20)

Chapter 9 - His Forgiveness (continued)

Righteousness of Affliction

Such affliction is the appropriate response to Yehovaw's atonement through Yeshuaw that causes Him to regard the repentant child as "righteous"! (Hebrews 11:4) So we finally begin to understand why it is that

God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life! (John 3:16)

Failing to believe Yeshuaw is failing to receive the truth about Yehovaw's suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another, which nullifies in the unbeliever the effectiveness of Yehovaw's atonement through Yeshuaw (Romans 5:11), leaving him or her in the spiritual ignorance of the world, separated, in Yehovaw's cursing and death (Deuteronomy 28:14 to 68), from Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power!

There are only two places outside that kingdom, should the unbeliever die without having repented of not keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law, which are "Hell" for one thousand years (Deuteronomy 32:22; Psalm 88; Luke 16:23; Revelation 20:5) and His "Lake of Fire" (Revelation 20:15) "for ever and ever"! (Revelation 14:11)

His Children

It is Important that Yehovaw's church understand the truth that the atonement of His toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11) reveals! For Yehovaw declared, through His psalmist, of Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh, Whom He called "David My Servant" (Psalm 89:20), Who would be Yehovaw's "Firstborn, higher than the kings of Earth" (Verse 27):

30If His children forsake My law and walk not in My judgments, **31**if they break My statutes and keep not My commandments, **32**then will I visit their transgression with the rod and their iniquity with stripes! (Psalm 89:30 to 32)

Yehovaw said, through His Prophet:

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge! Because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to Me: seeing thou hast forgotten the law of thy God, I will also forget thy children! (Hosea 4:6)

Chapter 9 - His Forgiveness (continued)

John the Baptist

In the beginning of his Gospel of Yeshuaw, Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle:

⁶There was a man sent from God, whose name was John ⁷The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through Him might believe! ⁸He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light. (John 1:6 to 8)

That was the true Light, Who lighteth every man who cometh into the world! (John 1:9)

As many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God! (John 1:12)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, of Himself:

I am the light of the world! ... He who followeth Me shall not walk in darkness but shall have the light of life! (John 8:12)

The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit and they are life! (John 6:63)

If thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments! (Matthew 19:17)

Chapter 10 - His Light

Yeshuaw's Light

We are instructed, by Yehovaw's holy scriptures, to see the light of Yeshuaw as the truth of His Father's words, of which He was to "bear witness" (John 18:37), the primary expression of which was and continues to be His "covenant with the house of Israel" (Jeremiah 31:31) and the commandments of His toraw or law, which comprise the "terms and conditions" of that contract!

I did not write the bible; I merely teach it; and, despite all devilish voices to the contrary, that book declares that Yehovaw's truth and Yeshuaw's words in the conveyance of that truth relate directly to His covenant and the commandments of His toraw or law (Psalm 119:142 and 151), the observing of which is "our righteousness" (Deuteronomy 6:25), by which we "come to the Father" (John 14:6) and "enter into the kingdom of Heaven"! (Matthew 5:20)

The Right Righteousness

But for a person to fulfill that requirement, his righteousness must "exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees"! (Matthew 5:20) So we really need to know what kind of problem Yehovaw had with them; Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat; All therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do! But do not ye after their works! For they say and do not! (Matthew 23:2 and 3)

There is that word "observe", again; Yeshuaw's disciples were to put the highest possible value on what Moses taught from his seat and what the scribes and Pharisees taught from that same seat, which had to be Yehovaw's toraw or law as it was given to His children through Moses!

The cynical "leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees" was deadly! (Matthew 16:6) And Yehovaw warned His disciples, through Yeshuaw, against it. (Verses 5 to 11)

Chapter 10 - His Light (continued)

Leaven of Hypocrisy

The “**leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees**” (Matthew 16:6) was their hypocrisy! And Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Matthew of His berating of them through Yeshuaw for it. (Matthew 23)

The man who did not go “**down to his house justified**” (Luke 18:14) was the Pharisee, who

stood and prayed with himself, God, I thank thee that I am not as other men are - extortioners, unjust, adulterers or even as this publican! I fast twice in the week! I give tithes of all that I possess! (Luke 18:11 and 12)

That man's heart was not “perfect” toward Yehovaw; rather, it was perfect toward himself! It is evident that he did not love Yehovaw nor was he keeping Yehovaw’s commandments!

“**The First and Great Commandment**” (Matthew 22:38) is:

Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, with all thy soul and with all thy might! (Deuteronomy 6:5; Matthew 22:37)

The Weightier Matters

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Woe, unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For ye pay tithe of mint, anise and cummin and have omitted the weightier matters of the law - judgment, mercy and faith! These ought ye to have done and not to leave the other undone! (Matthew 23:23)

The Pharisee in this passage (Luke 18:11 and 12) was, by no means, loving Yehovaw with all his heart, soul or might! Rather, it was an example of those who

trusted in themselves, that they were righteous, and despised others! (Luke 18:9)

Throughout His Holy Bible, Yehovaw always coupled the idea of “love” with one's obedience to the commandments of the person whom he or she loved! (Deuteronomy 30:16; John 14:21) This is basic to all truly meaningful relationships between people and between Yehovaw and His children!

Any person advancing a doctrine that excludes that kind of accountability between parties to a covenant is “**giving heed to seducing spirits and doctrines of devils**” (1st Timothy 4:1) and shall have his just reward!

Chapter 10 - His Light (continued)

Woe to All Liars

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

All liars shall have their part in the lake that burneth with fire and brimstone, which is the Second Death! (Revelation 21:8)

It is a lie of Satan that Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh, Yehovaw's Holy Son of life and light came to do other than to "Magnify the law and make it honorable"! (Isaiah 42:21)

Hearing my teaching on such matters, people have asked me, "What happened to Jesus' salvation and redemption by the shedding of His blood?"

The Love of Yehovaw by which He sent Yeshuaw to Earth to make "an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel" (Leviticus 16:17; Romans 5:11) usually assumes the love of Yehovaw the Father! He said, through Yeshuaw:

God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son! (John 3:16)

But it took Yeshuaw's obedience to Yehovaw the Father's commandment that He be given for the awesome purpose of making an atonement of His own body and blood! (Matthew 26:26 and 28; Romans 5:11)

Laying Down His Life

Yeshuaw said:

Therefore doth My Father love Me; because I lay down My life, that I might take it again! No man taketh it from Me; but I lay it down of Myself! I have power to lay it down! And I have power to take it again! This commandment have I received of My Father! (John 10:17 and 18)

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends! (John 15:13)

That amazing relationship born of mutual love between Yehovaw the "Father" (Matthew 6:9) and Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1), Whom He sent to Earth to become through Mary "the Son of God" (Luke 1:35) was beautifully enacted in the similarly amazing relationship between Abraham and his son Isaac!

Wanting to prove how willing Abraham was to obey Him, Yehovaw commanded that he sacrifice Isaac as a "burnt offering"! (Genesis 22:2) When Abraham was about to do that, Yehovaw stopped him from harming Isaac and then made a marvelous promise to him.

Chapter 10 - His Light (continued)

Blessing the Nations

Yehovaw said, to Abraham:

In thy seed shall all the nations of the Earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed My voice! (Genesis 22:18)

The precedent set of a man showing a willingness to sacrifice his only and beloved son for Yehovaw would in time permit Yehovaw to sacrifice Yeshuaw as the ultimate atonement of all time!

Yeshuaw's amazing atonement on the cross would indeed bless "all the nations of the Earth" (Genesis 22:18), by the righteousness that their repentance would obtain for them (Deuteronomy 6:25; Hebrews 11:4; 1 John 1:9) and by Yehovaw's restoring the repentant to His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5), for which that righteousness qualifies a child (Matthew 5:20), he or she having heard the gospel based upon what Yeshuaw did in obedience to Yehovaw the Father!

What Yeshuaw did in His obedience to Yehovaw's commandment that He make an atonement on the cross for His children was, indeed, astounding!

Chapter 11 - His Worthiness

Worthy of Praise

All nations now worship and praise Yeshuaw for the loving obedience by which He fulfilled Yehovaw's commandment of the atonement in His law! (Leviticus 16:17; Numbers 15:27 and 28; Matthew 5:17)

Abraham's obedience to sacrifice Isaac was subsequently honored by Yehovaw, Who wrote, through His apostle:

Was not Abraham, our father, justified by works, when he had offered Isaac, his son, upon the altar? (James 2:21)

Seest thou how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? (James 2:22)

And the scripture was fulfilled that saith, Abraham believed God; and it was imputed, unto him, for righteousness! And he was called the friend of God! (James 2:23)

Isaac's Part

As Yeshuaw's obedience to Yehovaw the Father was extremely important to the fulfillment of the atonement that Yehovaw eventually made through Him (Leviticus 16:17; Romans 5:11), Isaac's part in Yehovaw's proving of Abraham was both important and remarkable!

Isaac was a lad strong enough to carry the wood necessary for the commanded sacrifice up to the top of Mount Moriah! (Genesis 22:6) And the Fact that he wondered where the sacrifice itself was did not deter him from going the remainder of the way! (Verse 7) Yehovaw wrote, through His Recorder:

They came to the place that God had told him of; and Abraham built an altar there and laid the wood in order and bound Isaac, his son, and laid him on the altar, upon the wood! (Genesis 22:9)

Chapter 11 - His Worthiness (continued)

Isaac's Amazing Submission

Abraham had been an hundred years old, when Isaac was born! So Abraham was at least that old plus however many years Isaac was old, at the time that he “**bound Isaac, his son, and laid him on the altar**”! (Genesis 22:9) Had Isaac wanted to resist Abraham, in that amazing and frightful circumstance, I cannot see how Abraham could have overpowered a son that old and strong, if Isaac had not meekly submitted to what both of them were agreed was Yehovaw's will in the situation!

In my view that amazing, loving and trusting compliance on Isaac's part is why Yehovaw uniquely blessed him, when Abraham had died and it was time for Isaac to achieve his success! Yehovaw wrote, through His recorder, of Isaac in a time of famine:

¹²Then Isaac sowed in that land, and received in the same year an hundredfold: and the Lord blessed him; ¹³and the man waxed great and went forward and grew, until he became very great; ¹⁴for he had possession of flocks and possession of herds and a store of servants! And the Philistines envied him. (Genesis 26:12 to 14)

He became Obedient

So, like Isaac, the love of Yeshuaw for Yehovaw's children expressed itself, primarily, in that He

became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross! (Philippians 2:8)

I am still working to answer the question I hear so frequently:

If Yehovaw's salvation is based upon His children's keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law (Matthew 19:16 and 17), what happened to the shedding of Yeshuaw's blood on the cross?

First let me make clear that by “**rightly dividing the word of truth**” (2nd Timothy 2:15) I am obliged to conclude that Yeshuaw's permitting wicked men to murder Him, by which His blood was shed, simply set up an amazing situation in which He could in the most dramatic and astounding way “**bear witness unto the truth**”! (John 18:37)

Yeshuaw did not say, to Pilate, “**To this end was I born and for this cause came I into the world, that I should shed My blood!**” He said that His purpose for being born and coming into the world was that he “**should bear witness unto the truth**” (John 18:37), which He revealed as His blood was being shed.

Blood of the Covenant

The night before He suffered and died Yeshuaw had said, to His disciples:

This is My blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins! (Matthew 26:28)

Then Yeshuaw prayed, to Yehovaw the Father:

For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth! (John 17:19)

Truth in Atonement

The truth to which Yeshuaw referred is that which all performances of Yehovaw's atonement had worked to reveal, which was His suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another; and, when Yeshuaw prayed,

Father, forgive them: for they know not what they do (Luke 23:34),

He fulfilled (Matthew 5:17) the forgiveness of Yehovaw that every atonement had offered since He gave His toraw to the children of Israel through Moses! (Leviticus 16:30; Numbers 15:28) And, by speaking that amazing prayer, Yeshuaw transformed the most heinous injustice that had ever been committed on Earth into the most amazing atonement that Yehovaw's children had ever seen! (John 10:17 and 18)

Attainment of Righteousness

The atonement, then, was Yehovaw's amazing provision for the attainment of righteousness by His sinning people, the children of Israel!

Yehovaw the Father's willingness to forgive even the Roman soldiers who had nailed His beautiful, completely innocent Son to the cross melted their hearts! (Matthew 27:54) That was the second part of Yehovaw's word of truth that would sanctify the disciples and all others whose hearts would ever be touched by the gospel or "good message" (Strong: Greek: 2098) of that awesome event! (John 17:19) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one who believeth! (Romans 1:16)

Chapter 11 - His Worthiness (continued)

Effectiveness of the Blood

The blood of Yeshuaw or its being shed had no power within itself to forgive anyone! If it had, Yehovaw's children could have relied on its merely being shed; and they would have been forgiven without a care in the world! And no one would ever have gone to Hell from that day forward!

Had that falsehood been the case, people who had no intention of doing other than to continue their wickedness in violating their neighbors without any conscience about it would have been included in Yehovaw's "kingdom of Heaven"! (Matthew 4:17) And, instead of that kingdom's being "of Heaven", it would have approximated a mere continuation of the hell that Satan's wickedness on Earth had created for millions of Yehovaw's beloved but foolish children in the world!

Knowing perfectly well that such an arrangement would be a grievous abortion of Yehovaw's desire that His children have an eternal reward for obeying His toraw or law (Deuteronomy 6:25), Satan has tried to tell people for two thousand years that Yeshuaw's blood automatically forgave anyone who would believe that lie!

Judas' Betrayal

The gospel of Yeshuaw as reported by four of His apostles tells how Judas betrayed Him into the hands of the priests in Jerusalem for thirty pieces of silver! But that only precipitated Yehovaw's plan for Yeshuaw to fulfill (Matthew 5:17) the atonement of His toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11) with His own body and blood (Matthew 26:26 to 28) on the cross! (Luke 23:34)

But there is a far more serious betrayal that took place, after Yeshuaw had returned to sit "on the right hand of power"! (Matthew 26:64) Yehovaw's own servant Paul taught Yehovaw's children, concerning Yeshuaw's death on the cross, that they should have "faith in His blood" (Romans 3:25), to where there would be a "righteousness of God without the law" (Verse 21), thus presumably admitting into Yehovaw's kingdom lawless wreckers of havoc within Yehovaw's holy kingdom! The apostle Paul wrote

that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law (Romans 3:28),

so that, presumably, Yehovaw would have no basis by which to require accountability for one's actions from the day of Yeshuaw's death onward!

Doctrinal Abomination

By preaching that perverted gospel, sincere servants of Yehovaw threw grievous confusion into the gospel or into "the power of God unto salvation to every one who believeth" (Romans 1:16) and robbed them of the truth for which Yeshuaw paid such a dear Price! And, lamentably, that doctrinal abomination has been succeeding in all too well over the centuries that have gone by since then.

But Yeshuaw knew what Yehovaw hoped to accomplish through the atonement of His toraw or law; He knew that He was to pray for Yehovaw the Father to forgive "all the congregation of Israel" (Leviticus 16:17) for their having crucified Him.

Chapter 12 - His Being Betrayed (continued)

Saving Untold Millions

Having uttered that infinitely merciful prayer, Yeshuaw established, for ever, the hope for Yehovaw's forgiveness that would save untold millions of people who would receive the astounding truth Yeshuaw had revealed from the cross and then do their part, repenting of their sin (Matthew 4:17) and confessing it. (1st John 1:9)

That humble and appropriate response to Yeshuaw's suffering and death on the cross would bring into glorious fulfillment the truth that His blood had been “**shed for many for the remission of sins**” (Matthew 26:28), not arbitrarily, by any power of forgiveness in the blood itself, but by the truth about Yehovaw's suffering and death in the sinning of His children!

Yeshuaw's suffering and death revealed the truth by which the hearts or consciences of Yehovaw's children would be purged “**from dead works to serve the Living God**”! (Hebrews 9:14) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye continue in My word, then are ye My disciples indeed! And ye shall know the truth! And the truth shall make you free! (John 8:31 and 32)

A Reasonable Explanation

Having spoken to His disciples through Yeshuaw of their “**eating**” His Flesh and “**drinking**” His blood (John 6:53 and 54), which His disciples regarded as “**an hard saying**” (Verse 60), Yehovaw backed off, through Yeshuaw, and gave a reasonable explanation for the symbolism He was using with Yeshuaw's body and blood:

It is the Spirit Who quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing! The words that I speak unto you, they are spirit and they are life! (John 6:63)

So the night before Yeshuaw was to be taken and killed, when He asked His disciples to eat the bread representing His body and drink the wine representing His blood, it was His words that they knew they were accepting, which He would be shouting in His body's being broken and His Blood's being shed on the cross, to convey the reason and purpose of the atonement of the toraw or law that Yehovaw had commanded Him to fulfill (Matthew 5:17), which words, He said, “**are spirit and they are life**”! (John 6:63)

It is one's life to know and appreciate the suffering and death that Yehovaw has had to endure in the sinning of His children, to where they will want, in their hearts, to serve Him well in all things! He wrote, through His prophet, of His “**New Covenant with the house of Israel**” (Jeremiah 31:31):

I will put My law ... and write it in their hearts! (Jeremiah 31:33)

Chapter 12 - His Being Betrayed (continued)

Bearing Witness

Yeshuaw's blood was shed so that, in its being shed, He was able to “**bear witness**” (John 18:37) to the amazing truth of Yehovaw's suffering and death in the sinning of His children against Him together with the fact that Yehovaw the Father was willing to forgive the most heinous and unjust crime ever committed on Earth, if people would simply repent of it. (Matthew 4:17; 9:13; 27:54)

The truth of Yehovaw to which Yeshuaw bore witness on the cross (John 18:37) would put to rest for ever Satan's lies to Yehovaw's children that, whatever they may have done, it was no one else's affair and that such sin was too bad to be forgiven anyway! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

There is nothing hid that shall not be manifested; neither was anything kept secret but that it should come abroad! (Mark 4:22)

All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men; but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. (Matthew 12:31)

Blaspheming the Spirit

“Blasphemy” is “vilification” or speaking against someone (Strong: Greek: 988); and to speak against ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Spirit of Truth, is to deny His truth, which is to deny the heart of what His atonement through Yeshuaw was intended to reveal! So one can readily understand why that sin is fatal in one's relationship to Yehovaw!

Even people in the world understand that without mutual trust, there is no relationship between two people wanting to live or work together to achieve some mutually desired goal! That is what covenants or contracts are all about!

The problem of people in the world is that they are wide open to “**the wiles of the Devil**” (Ephesians 6:11), who continually works to destroy that mutual trust!

When a person has responded appropriately to hearing the gospel about Yeshuaw's atonement on the cross (Romans 5:11), he or she has turned one key in a box requiring two keys to open! The second key relates to doing for others what Yeshuaw has done for the saved and redeemed child of Yehovaw!

As Yehovaw's “**High Priest**” (Hebrews 2:17) Yeshuaw prayed that Yehovaw forgive those who had sinned against Him, which made of His otherwise tragic and unthinkable suffering and death “**an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel**”! (Leviticus 16:17)

Chapter 12 - His Being Betrayed (continued)

One Right Step

Then those who by confessing their sins have availed themselves of that atonement (1st John 1:9) have gone one step in the right direction toward being restored to Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! But Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses. (Matthew 6:15)

By one's forgiving a neighbor who has hurt him or her, he or she fulfills Yehovaw's longstanding intent for each of His children, which is that all of them be priests ministering His love and forgiveness to all people around them; He said, through Moses:

⁵If ye will obey My voice indeed and keep My covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people: for all the Earth is Mine! ⁶And ye shall be, unto Me, a kingdom of priests and an holy nation! (Exodus 19:5 and 6)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Prophet:

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge! Because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to Me! (Hosea 4:6)

Kings and Priests

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

⁹They sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book and to open the seals thereof: for Thou wast slain and hast redeemed us, to God, by Thy blood, out of every kindred, tongue, people and nation ¹⁰and hast made us, unto our God, kings and priests! And we shall reign on the Earth! (Revelation 5:9 and 10)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Peter:

Even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow His steps! (1st Peter 2:21)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Paul:

¹⁶The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God
¹⁷and, if children, then heirs - heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ - if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together! (Romans 8:16 and 17)

Following Yeshuaw's Example

Having repented (Matthew 4:17) and confessed one's sins (1st John 1:9), it remains for him or her to follow Yeshuaw's example and forgive others, which fulfills Yehovaw's second requirement for obtaining His forgiveness; He said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye forgive men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you!
(Matthew 6:14)

Whosoever will save his life shall lose it; but whosoever will lose his life for My sake, the same shall save it. (Luke 9:24)

Whosoever doth not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple!
(Luke 14:27)

Two Keys to Restoration

So one must both confess his or her sins (1st John 1:9) and forgive others of theirs (Matthew 6:14) to be restored to Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, here on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5), which then leads to one's being brought upon dying to Yehovaw's amazing "Paradise" (Luke 23:43) in His "kingdom of Heaven"! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19)

To make doubly sure that His children well understood these important things about His salvation and redemption for them, Yehovaw told, through Yeshuaw, a special story! Peter had asked Yeshuaw:

Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him? till seven times?
(Matthew 18:21)

But Yeshuaw answered Peter:

I say not, unto thee, Until seven times: but, until seventy times seven. (Matthew 18:22)

Therefore is the kingdom of Heaven likened unto a certain king, who would take account of his servants! (Matthew 18:23)

Ten Thousand Talents

One was brought, unto him, who owed him ten thousand talents! Forasmuch as he had not to pay, his Lord commanded him to be sold and his wife and children and all that he had and payment to be made! (Matthew 18:24 and 25)

The Servant therefore fell down and worshiped him, saying, Lord, have patience with me; and I will pay thee all! (Matthew 18:26)

Then the Lord of that servant was moved with compassion and loosed him and forgave him the debt. (Matthew 18:27)

Thus far in the story, we have seen Yehovaw deal through Yeshuaw with His first requirement for the salvation and redemption of His children - their repenting and confessing that they have sinned or incurred a "debt" along with their resolve to do the right thing, which is to pay the debt! (Matthew 18:26) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin. (John 8:34)

Chapter 13 - His Priesthood (continued)

The Great Debt

The great debt owed by the king's servant represents the bondage into which any sinner falls! For his or her sin brings the pain of it back on his or her head along with the spiritual death of being removed from Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power!

Having been shown what nonpayment of his debt was going to cost him and his family (Matthew 18:25), the servant wisely repented of it and confessed it to the king (Verse 26), which brought the King's compassion, liberty and forgiveness! (Verse 27)

In tragic contrast to how he was treated, the highly indebted servant then went out and used his mercifully given freedom from bondage to send into prison a fellow servant who owed him a small debt, even though the fellow servant asked patience of him, exactly as he had asked it of his king!

When the king heard of that outrageous failure to show mercy on the part of the servant for whom he had shown great mercy, he called the debt and put the unmerciful servant into prison!

Heavy Penalty

Yehovaw's words rang, loudly and clearly, through Yeshuaw's lips, as He said:

So likewise shall My Heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses! (Matthew 18:35)

With that truth of Yehovaw having been made abundantly clear, let me make it clear also that Yeshuaw was a man! Yet He was "without sin"! (Hebrews 4:15) Yeshuaw said:

The Father hath not left Me alone! For I do, always, those things that please Him. (John 8:29)

That righteous innocence could not stop, till Yeshuaw had breathed His last breath as a physical man on Earth, lest He sin and lose His salvation under Yehovaw's toraw or law the same as any other man who chooses to rebel against it.

The Great Commandment like unto "the First and Great Commandment" (Matthew 22:38) was for the Israelite to love his or her neighbor as he or she loved himself or herself! (Leviticus 19:18; Matthew 22:39) Who does not want to be forgiven, when found to have sinned against a neighbor?

Chapter 13 - His Priesthood (continued)

The Golden Rule

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**All things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them!
For this is the law and the prophets! (Matthew 7:12)**

So forgiving a neighbor is part of loving him or her; furthermore, Yehovaw's child is obligated, if he or she wants to be His child, to love, bless, do good to and pray for his or her enemy! (Matthew 5:44; Luke 6:27)

So Yeshuaw not only had His Father's purpose to enlighten their children concerning His suffering and death in their sinning one against another and His willingness to forgive the repentant among them, He had the personal obligation to pray that Yehovaw forgive the Roman soldiers, who as enemies had crucified Him, lest His neglecting to forgive be the sin that would bar Him from His place by Yehovaw on the throne of the universe!

When Yehovaw showed me that profound truth, one day, it emerged as the clearest key to understanding what He meant when He said through Yeshuaw:

**Whosoever doth not bear his cross and come after Me, cannot be My disciple!
(Luke 14:27)**

Half Done Works

Yehovaw told, through Yeshuaw, stories of building a tower or defending against an enemy, with material sufficient for only half the tower or with only half the size of the army that is approaching! In those stories through Yeshuaw He was clearly asking, His child,

Do you have what it takes to be My Disciple?

Are you ready to pay the Price?

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

The kingdom of Heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field, the which, when a man hath found, he hideth and for joy thereof goeth and selleth all that he hath and buyeth that field! (Matthew 13:44)

Again, the kingdom of Heaven is like unto a merchant man seeking goodly pearls, who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had and bought it. (Matthew 13:45 and 46)

An Ambitious Mother

The mother of two disciples asked of Yeshuaw:

Grant that these, my two sons, may sit, the one on Thy right hand and the other on the left, in Thy kingdom! (Matthew 20:21)

Yeshuaw answered with questions for the mother's sons:

Ye know not what ye ask! Are ye able to drink of the cup that I shall drink of and to be baptized with the baptism that I am baptized with? (Matthew 20:22)

Are you Prepared?

When we consider the mother's inquiry concerning the honoring of her two sons and Yeshuaw's answer to her, one's obligation to love, bless, do good to and pray for even his or her enemies (Matthew 5:44; Luke 6:27) comes to mind and begs the question:

Are you prepared to forgive even those who are killing you?

By the guidance of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, Stephen had understood Yehovaw's requirement to forgive; and, while he was being stoned by Satan's servants, who had been enraged by his testimony for Yeshuaw,

he kneeled down and cried, with a loud voice, Lord, lay not this sin to their charge!
(Acts 7:59)

Being pleased with what Stephen was doing to advance His kingdom in that selfless way, Yehovaw opened Heaven, to him; and

he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up steadfastly, into Heaven, and saw the glory of God and Jesus standing on the right hand of God. (Acts 7:55)

Yeshuaw was giving Stephen a standing ovation, for His faithful witness in behalf of his erring brothers and for the suffering unto death that they were thrusting upon him for that vital witness!

Overcoming Satan

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle John, of Satan:

They overcame him, by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony!
And they loved not their lives unto the death! (Revelation 12:11)

That is why I have thus far written two stories to be offered on my Website - " 52314412 The Unforgiving Rosanna" and " 52314413 The Unforgiving Catherine" - which through the medium of fictional writing tell some of my own suffering for the unforgiveness of a neighbor; and certain of my relatives will undoubtedly have a few words for me, for my having written the stories the way I did!

Yehovaw's forgiveness is His means of saving and redeeming His children through Yeshuaw! It relates to the witness that He bore through Yeshuaw of the truth about His suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another and His merciful lovingkindness to forgive the repentant among them!

Chapter 14 - His Awesome Requirement (continued)

Simply No Place

Firmly established by Yeshuaw's atonement on the cross (Romans 5:11), the truth about Yehovaw would be for evermore the strongest encouragement that He could possibly have arranged for their children by which to seek His forgiveness and be saved from “**Hell**” (Deuteronomy 32:22; Psalm 88; Luke 16:23) and His “**Lake of Fire**” (Revelation 20:15), which He has ready to receive those among them who are determined to violate their neighbors and Him as their Heavenly Father! There is, simply, no place in His kingdom of peace for people who insist upon disrupting that Peace by the warring of sin!

But there is an important difference between Yehovaw’s salvation through Yeshuaw for the children of Israel and the “**eternal redemption**” that Yeshuaw obtained by His obedience to Yehovaw on the cross! Yehovaw’s salvation comes by Yeshuaw’s atonement on the cross (Leviticus 16:17; Romans 5:11) followed by the appropriate response of those who hear its gospel, while His redemption through Yeshuaw is based only upon Yeshuaw’s atonement on the cross! (Leviticus 16:17; Romans 5:11)

Eternal Redemption

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author, of Yeshuaw:

Neither by the blood of goats and calves but by His own blood He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. (Hebrews 9:12)

Yehovaw’s “eternal redemption” through Yeshuaw is simply the permission He gave Yeshuaw to move the righteous dead among His children from “**the heart of the Earth**” (Matthew 12:40) to “**Paradise**” (Luke 23:43), which is well confirmed by what He wrote through Yeshuaw through His faithful apostle John, of His sealed servants:

³They sung, as it were, a new song before the throne and before the four beasts and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the Earth ... ⁴were redeemed from among men! (Revelation 14:3 and 4)

Yehovaw’s salvation through Yeshuaw restores the repentant among His children to His glorious and eternal kingdom on Earth (Matthew 6:10), while His redemption is the glorious arrangement between the Father and Son of the Godhead to take, upon their dying physically, His righteous children to “**Paradise**” (Luke 23:43) in “**the kingdom of Heaven**”! (Matthew 5:20)

Chapter 14 - His Awesome Requirement (continued)

Resurrection of Life

Another major event remains, wherein, without Yehovaw's righteous children having died, He will through Yeshuaw take them up in His "**Resurrection of Life**"! (John 5:29) And at that time "**Paradise**" (Luke 23:43) will have become "**the Holy City, New Jerusalem, coming down from God out of Heaven**"! Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

To him who overcometh will I give to eat of the Tree of Life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God! (Revelation 2:7)

¹He shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb! ²In the midst of the street of it and on either side of the river was there the Tree of Life, which bare twelve manner of fruits and yielded her fruit every month! And the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations! (Revelation 22:1 and 2)

Yehovaw's "**eternal redemption**" (Hebrews 9:12) was bought by the dear price Yeshuaw paid for Yehovaw to move His righteous dead from "**the heart of the Earth**" (Matthew 12:40) to "**Paradise**"! (Luke 23:43)

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Chapter 15 - His Paradise

Their Own Place

In “Paradise” each of child of Yehovaw was to have his or her own “place” (John 14:2 and 3) prepared by Yeshuaw in Yehovaw the “Father’s house” (Verse 2) in which to spend their time until “the Resurrection of Life” (John 1:29), when they will be gathered from “the outmost parts of Heaven” (Deuteronomy 30:4) and moved to His “Holy City, New Jerusalem”! (Revelation 21:2)

In the center of Yehovaw’s “Holy City, New Jerusalem” (Revelation 21:2) is His throne! He wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

There shall be no more curse! But the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and His servants shall serve Him. (Revelation 22:3)

They shall see His face! And His name shall be in their foreheads! (Revelation 22:4)

The Sealed Servants

It will come as a shock to teachers in Yehovaw’s Gentile church, who insist that they have nothing to do with the children of Israel and therefore are not obligated to keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law, as “the brethren who are of the Gentiles” (Acts 15:23) were falsely directed by grievously mistaken apostles in Jerusalem! (Matthew 28:19 and 20; Acts 15:24)

But the “Servants” (Revelation 22:3) who will “see His face” (Verse 4), who have “His name ... in their foreheads” are, according to His word through Yeshuaw through His faithful apostle John, “the servants of our God” (Revelation 7:3), who are “sealed ... in their foreheads”, who are “of all the tribes of the children of Israel”! (Verse 4)

John saw those sealed servants “on Mount Sion ... having His Father's name written in their foreheads”! (Revelation 14:1) What an awesome heritage to miss!

Chapter 15 - His Paradise (continued)

Awesome Heritage

That awesome heritage will not be missed by those whose hearts are right toward Yehovaw, even though they have been taught confusion and falsehood by the leaders of the Gentile church! Having brought attention to His “**law or the prophets**” (Matthew 5:17), which He had sent Yeshuaw not “**to destroy but to fulfill**” (Verse 17), Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of Heaven! But whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of Heaven. (Matthew 5:19)

Those who have been falsely taught to “**break one of these least commandments and shall teach men so ... shall be called the least in the kingdom of Heaven**” (Matthew 5:19); but at least they will be “**in**” the kingdom (Verse 19), the pity being that they cannot be “**called great**” (Verse 19), for the effectiveness that ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, could have given them had they known His truth!

Commandments of Spirit

For Yeshuaw will not manifest Himself with ha Kodesh Ruakh’s great power and truth for the one who does not keep the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

He who hath My commandments and keepeth them, he it is who loveth Me; and he who loveth Me shall be loved of My Father! And I will love him and will manifest Myself to him. (John 14:21)

But for those whose hearts are not right toward Yehovaw, He had this warning through Yeshuaw:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

Yehovaw’s problem with “**the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees**” (Matthew 5:20) was that it was flawed, fatally, by their being “**hypocrites**”! (Matthew 23:13) He said, through Yeshuaw:

The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat; all therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do! But do not ye after their works: for they say and do not! (Matthew 23:2 and 3)

Only This Much

In explaining to you only this much of Yehovaw's salvation and redemption through Yeshuaw, I have made astounding statements, which would soon convict me of being off my rocker (certain members of my family call me "senile"), were it not that I can and continually do substantiate them from out of Yehovaw's Holy Bible!

As I persistently point out, I did not write Yehovaw's Holy Bible; I merely teach it.

Yehovaw's redemption was bought by Yeshuaw's blood having been shed on the cross! The apostle Paul wrote:

Ye are bought with a price! Therefore glorify God, in your body and in your spirit, which are God's! (1st Corinthians 6:20)

Although I appreciate Paul's zeal for Yehovaw, I have a problem with that statement: slaves are bought for a price; Joseph was sold, into slavery, by his evil brothers, "for twenty pieces of silver"! (Genesis 37:28) Israeli daughters were sold, to be maidservants! (Exodus 21:7)

Selling People

Such buying and selling of people is always done against their will, by people who somehow believe that neighbors are things to be used, without regard to how they feel about it; it is Satanic and completely foreign to the liberty that Yehovaw had in mind for His children!

I am not Yehovaw's slave! He has never asked or required or forced me to be His slave; Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw, to Earth, Who said:

I have called you friends! For all things that I have heard of My Father I have made known unto you! (John 15:15)

Part of what Yeshuaw has made known to me of His Father is the fact that, if I do not love and serve Him, He will curse me, until I perish! (Leviticus 26; Deuteronomy 28) And, when I have tried to argue that Yehovaw has never put a gun to my head, to get my cooperation, I have had an atheist acquaintance of mine take delight in quoting such passages, to insist that, if not a gun, certainly warnings of that kind and the judgments that come of them are there, to make me wish I had "loved" Him and "served" Him.

Chapter 15 - His Paradise (continued)

His Righteous Goodness

But I have never been able to get it through such a darkened mind that Yehovaw's warnings through Moses and then through Yeshuaw were to let His Children know that His righteous goodness is unavoidably against those who hold that goodness in contempt and deliberately do those things that disrupt or frustrate it.

Yehovaw's cursing is not what He has imagined to do to His children, if they refuse to "build His Empire" for His own pleasure at their expense, as Pharaoh's taskmasters did to the Hebrew slaves, if they refused to build his cities! Yehovaw said, to Yeshuaw, through His psalmist:

Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness! Therefore God, Thy God, hath anointed Thee with the oil of gladness above Thy fellows! (Psalm 45:7)

Yehovaw the Father was saying, in the Throne Room of the Universe, to Yehovaw the Word:

You're My kind of Guy! You can do no other! And neither can I! Let's celebrate!

Bought by Blood

I said and I meant:

Yehovaw's "Eternal Redemption" for the Children of Israel (Hebrews 9:12) was bought by Yeshuaw's Blood, as He shed it on the Cross!

What Yeshuaw "bought" was Yehovaw's permission to bring His children's righteous dead from "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40) to "Paradise"! (Luke 23:43) Yeshuaw did not buy the involuntary servitude of Yehovaw's children! He bought what Yehovaw would do for them, if they voluntarily chose to serve Him because of the truth of the cross that was revealed to them! Yehovaw said, through Moses:

The life of the flesh is in the blood! And I have given it, to you, upon the altar, to make an atonement for your souls! For it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul! (Leviticus 17:11)

Forgiving to Bless

Yehovaw was willing to forgive His children, to provide a blessed environment in which they might dwell and work out their relationship with Him, by the School of Hard Knocks - specifically, in His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power!

But Yehovaw demanded that each time He restored a child to His kingdom, the child be reminded, by the suffering and death of an innocent animal, of the suffering he or she had caused a neighbor in his or her sin against the neighbor and against Him Whose Spirit is in the neighbor along with the spiritual death of separation from His kingdom that is the immediate result of one's sinning! (Genesis 2:17)

Ultimately, through Yeshuaw's amazing conduct on Earth, Yehovaw caused His sinful children to see the suffering of innocence that results from their sin in the crucifixion of His beautiful, sinless Son!

Chapter 16 - His Eternal Redemption (continued)

Forgiving and Restoring

The revelation having been accomplished, Yehovaw continued, through His beloved Son, His amazing willingness to forgive and restore to His kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power His formerly violent and wayward children - children whose consciences have been made perfect (Hebrews 9:9) or purged “**from dead works to serve the living God**”! (Verse 14)

Prior to Yeshuaw's coming and fulfilling His promise to Yehovaw, that He would allow Himself to be crucified for the awesome purpose I have presented throughout this work, Yehovaw's righteous dead were kept, for centuries, in “**the heart of the Earth**”, where Yeshuaw said He would be for three days after being killed! (Matthew 12:40)

To help the children of Israel understand what that Subterranean place was like, Yehovaw told, through Yeshuaw, the story of Lazarus and the rich man:

It came to pass, that the beggar died and was carried, by the angels, into Abraham's Bosom! (Luke 16:22)

The rich man also died and found himself “**in torments**”! (Luke 16:23)

Two Conditions

So those two conditions in “**the heart of the Earth**” (Matthew 12:40), one for the righteous and one for the wicked, were the case before Yeshuaw

went and preached unto the spirits in prison! (1st Peter 3:19)

When Yeshuaw was through preaching and certain among Yehovaw's spirit children had repented of their sins (Matthew 4:17) and confessed them (1st John 1:9), He activated the “**eternal redemption**” He had just obtained for them (Hebrews 9:12) and brought them with Him to “**Paradise**”! (Luke 23:43) Yehovaw had already prophesied, through His psalmist, what Yeshuaw would eventually do:

Thou hast ascended on high! Thou hast led captivity captive! Thou hast received gifts for men - yea, for the rebellious also - that the Lord God might dwell among them. (Psalm 68:18)

The “**rebellious**” (Psalm 68:18), who had been “**in torments**” (Luke 16:23) were given another chance, for the last time ever!

Chapter 16 - His Eternal Redemption (continued)

Astounded Rebels

Along with the righteous, who had died and were in “**Abraham's Bosom**” (Luke 16:22), the rebellious were astounded, as Yeshuaw showed every man, woman and child who had died since the days of Adam and Eve the nail prints in His hands and feet!

Yeshuaw told “**the spirits in prison**” (1st Peter 3:19) how He had prayed for Yehovaw to forgive “**all the congregation of Israel**”! (Leviticus 16:17) And He offered to forgive them, restore them to Israel and Yehovaw’s kingdom on Earth (Matthew 6:10) and bring them with Him to “**Paradise**” (Luke 23:43), if they would repent of their sins (Matthew 4:17; 9:13), confess them (1st John 1:9) and then lovingly forgive their enemies! (Matthew 5:44 and 45; 6:14)

Praying for Yehovaw to forgive one’s enemies of their sins does him or her no good without repenting of his or her own sins (Matthew 4:17) and confessing them (1st John 1:9); but at least there is no charge being held against them in Heaven by their victim, should they decide to repent and confess!

Keys of the Kingdom

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of Heaven: Whatsoever thou shalt bind on Earth shall be bound in Heaven! And whatsoever thou shalt loose on Earth shall be loosed in Heaven! (Matthew 16:19)

When Yeshuaw had appeared to His disciples after rising from the dead, Yehovaw breathed on them, through Yeshuaw, and then said, through Yeshuaw, to them:

Receive ye the Holy Ghost! (John 20:22)

Yehovaw was ordaining His disciples, through Yeshuaw, to be His new priests! (Exodus 19:6; Hosea 4:6; Revelation 5:10) Then He said, to them, through Yeshuaw:

Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained! (John 20:23)

Fascinatingly, that potential for liberty for those entangled in the service of sin (John 8:34) mirrors the same condition for freedom that Yeshuaw set up “**from the foundation of the world**” (Revelation 13:8), when He agreed with Yehovaw to be His Lamb for the atoning of His children, the entire purpose of which is to release them from their bondage to sin into His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power!

Purpose of Atonement

Yehovaw clearly told, through Moses, the purpose of His atonement -

that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord (Leviticus 16:30), that
it shall be forgiven him! (Numbers 15:28)

The condition for freedom that Yeshuaw set up “from the foundation of the world” (Revelation 13:8) is the reason why Yehovaw was able to write, through His psalmist:

Let the redeemed of the Lord say so, whom He hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy! (Psalm 107:2)

Similarly, Yehovaw wrote, through His Prophet:

Thus saith the Lord Who created thee, O Jacob, and He Who formed thee, O Israel, Fear not! For I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name! Thou art Mine! (Isaiah 43:1)

I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, thy transgressions, and, as a cloud, thy sins: return, unto Me; for I have redeemed thee. (Isaiah 44:22)

Pleasing Yehovaw

I Have Redeemed Thee

Forgiving one's enemy is pleasing to Yehovaw, our merciful Lord God; so He pleases the merciful among His children, by accepting them into His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, first on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5) and then in Heaven! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19) He said, through Yeshuaw:

Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful; judge not; and ye shall not be judged! Condemn not; and ye shall not be condemned! Forgive; and ye shall be forgiven! (Luke 6:36 and 37)

Give; and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over shall men give into your bosom! For with the same measure that ye mete withal, it shall be measured to you again! (Luke 6:38)

Expression of His Mercy

From Yehovaw's Holy Bible we can perceive and understand that His salvation for the children of Israel, which is an expression of His mercy (Exodus 20:6) and His judgment of intent, is actually a special application of His justice and judgment of reward and punishment!

For Yehovaw's justice requires that whatever is given a neighbor by His child be returned to the giver (Luke 6:38); and that works as well for being merciful, judging, condemning or forgiving! (Verses 36 and 37)

Being saved from "torments" (Luke 16:23) in "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40), if formerly evil, or even from the confinement of "Abraham's Bosom" (Luke 16:22), if formerly good, meant that Yehovaw's children would have to be taken somewhere else! Yeshuaw had already told the repentant thief by His side where that would be!

Chapter 17 - His Justice (continued)

With Him in Paradise

While hanging from the Cross, Yeshuaw said, to the repentant thief:

Today shalt thou be with Me in Paradise! (Luke 23:43)

While teaching His disciples, Yehovaw had said, through Yeshuaw:

In My Father's house are many mansions! ... I go to prepare a place for you; and, if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you unto Myself, that where I am, there ye may be also! (John 14:2)

The decision of Yehovaw's dead children to receive His forgiveness was their salvation! His decision to take each righteous dead child to his or her own paradise at that particular time (there is no difference in sex among the dead - Matthew 22:30) was His "eternal redemption" for them; Yehovaw wrote, through His author, of Yeshuaw:

Neither by the blood of goats and calves but by His own blood He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. (Hebrews 9:12)

Please note that by the time Yeshuaw brought His own blood into the Holy Place of Yehovaw's temple in Heaven, He had already obtained the redemption! For He had paid the price upon which He and Yehovaw had agreed for it, when, by their faith in that word, He became

the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world! (Revelation 13:8)

Mission Accomplished

When Yeshuaw was hanging on the cross, He said:

It is Finished! And He bowed His head and gave up the ghost! (John 19:30)

The word translated "finished" is from the Greek word "tel-eh'-o", which means "to end, that is, complete, execute, conclude, discharge (a debt)". (Strong: Greek: 5055) Archaeologists have found commercial documents using that word as though to say, "Paid in Full"!

Yeshuaw had kept His Promise! So, by the fulfilled condition of their agreement, Yehovaw was now free to remove through Yeshuaw their children from "**the heart of the Earth**" (Matthew 12:40) each to his or her own "**Paradise**" in Heaven! (Luke 23:43) And, having spoken that tremendous event into existence, Yeshuaw had the great joy of fulfilling it; Yeshuaw told Mary Magdalene:

Touch Me not! For I am not yet ascended to My Father! (John 20:17)

Chapter 17 - His Justice (continued)

Important Promises

Yeshuaw had important promises to keep (Luke 23:43; John 14:2 and 3); still He said, to Mary:

Go to My brethren and say, unto them, I ascend, unto My Father and your Father, to My God and your God. (John 20:17)

Yehovaw called, through Yeshuaw, Mary Magdalene, to be His first evangelist, the first person He asked to relay to others the joyous gospel or good news of His victory over death, which is the third thing He accomplished at the close of His earthly ministry - the instilling of a marvelous hope in the example of His resurrection, which He then promised to everyone who remained faithful “unto the end”! (Matthew 24:13)

Like every other fulfilled prophecy of His, Yehovaw's “eternal redemption” (Hebrews 9:12) through Yeshuaw for the children of Israel is based upon His toraw or law (Leviticus 17:11; 25:47 and 48), which He declared through His prophets (Isaiah 43:1; 44:22; 53:5) and magnified through His psalmists! (Psalm 103:12; 107:2)

Amazing Provisions

But those amazing provisions could not have been offered had Yeshuaw not been “the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world”! (Revelation 13:8) That was His agreeing to take upon Himself the suffering and death of the cross, to where He would powerfully demonstrate Yehovaw’s suffering and death in the sinning of His children one against another!

Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet, both of Himself over the centuries and of what Yeshuaw would experience on the cross:

He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities! The chastisement of our peace was upon Him! And with His stripes we are healed! (Isaiah 53:4)

To “bear witness unto the truth” (John 18:37) of His ancient role as “the Lamb of God Who taketh away the sins of the world” (John 1:29), Yeshuaw permitted wicked men to kill Him, outside Jerusalem, on a Roman cross of execution!

In the course of that amazing demonstration, Yeshuaw's blood was shed, fulfilling a stipulation that Yehovaw had built into His toraw or law! He said, through Moses:

It is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul! (Leviticus 17:11)

Come to Fulfill

Yeshuaw said:

Think not that I am come to destroy the law or the prophets: I am not come to destroy but to fulfill! (Matthew 5:17)

One other of Yehovaw's stipulations in His toraw or law was that the redeemer must be “**one of his brethren**” to the bondservant being freed in that transaction, by the redeemer's paying his or her debt to the slave master! (Leviticus 25:48)

For four thousand years even the righteous dead among the children of Israel were being kept in “**the heart of the Earth**”! (Matthew 12:40) Being taken to Heaven would be an awesome release into the freedom, glory and beauty of Yehovaw's heavenly kingdom, which no child of Yehovaw had ever known since He had sent them from His throne room into the wombs of their mothers on Earth, becoming “**these little ones who believe in Me**”! (Matthew 18:6)

Chapter 18 - His Brotherhood

Behold My Brethren

Yehovaw had made Yeshuaw a brother to His children, by causing Him to be born into the world through the womb of Mary, His earthly mother! (Luke 2:7) But, when Mary and some of her later children came to visit Him, He pointed to His disciples and said:

Behold My mother and My brethren! For whosoever shall do the will of My Father Who is in Heaven, the same is My brother, sister and mother! (Matthew 12:49 and 50)

That ties in with another statement Yehovaw made, through Yeshuaw:

Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends! Ye are My friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:13 and 14)

Hope of Redemption

The hope of Yehovaw's redemption for the children of Israel had uplifted and sustained them for four thousand years! (Psalm 107:2; Isaiah 43:1; Isaiah 44:22) Yehovaw's children might have understood it better had He said,

I have promised to redeem you.

But within the realm of faith within which Yehovaw functions, having promised something is as good as having done it; Yehovaw said, through the false prophet Baalim:

God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man, that He should repent! Hath He said; and shall He not do it? Or hath He spoken; and shall He not make it good? (Numbers 23:19)

Chapter 18 - His Brotherhood (continued)

Reality of Redemption

Yehovaw's "eternal redemption" (Hebrews 9:12) for the children of Israel became a reality for them, when Yeshuaw brought their repentant and righteous dead to "Paradise"! (Luke 23:43) But His freeing them from Egypt had been a type of it, at the cost of the life of every firstborn child and animal of Egypt!

That physical redemption had been based upon Yeshuaw's Word that He would fulfill Yehovaw's requirement for Him to be "the Redeemer of Israel" (Isaiah 49:7), which was that He would shed His blood! (Leviticus 17:11) And that explains why the lamb was killed by each Israeli family and its blood sprinkled upon their doorposts! (Exodus 12:6 and 7)

All of that having been fulfilled (Matthew 5:17) in Yeshuaw's atonement (Romans 5:11) on the cross, the dead among the children of Israel could be removed to "Paradise" (Luke 23:43), which is in "the Third Heaven" (2nd Corinthians 12:2), rather than in "Abraham's Bosom" (Luke 16:22) in "the heart of the Earth"! (Matthew 12:40)

I have specified that Yehovaw's "eternal redemption" (Hebrews 9:12) was for the children of Israel; because He specified that.

The Lost Sheep

Yeshuaw said:

I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel! (Matthew 15:25)

Yehovaw informed His children, through His prophet, that His "New Covenant" (Jeremiah 31:31) would be with "the house of Israel"! (Verse 31) And that covenant carried with it a grave responsibility, which His children under the Old Covenant did not bear!

When Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw into the world to proclaim that "the kingdom of Heaven is at hand" (Matthew 4:17), He knew that their days of having a second chance at being saved were fast coming to a Close! He said, through Yeshuaw:

If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin! But now they have no cloak for their sin. (John 14:22)

If I had not done among them the works that none other man did, they had not had sin! But now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father! (John 14:24)

Chapter 18 - His Brotherhood (continued)

Offer of Forgiveness

Not having regarded the rebellion of His ignorant children as “sin”, Yehovaw gave them, through Yeshuaw, an opportunity to receive His offer of forgiveness and the redemption that came with it, when the things that Yeshuaw had said and done as Yehovaw the Word walking among them had given them an opportunity to hear Yehovaw's truth first hand!

For, when Yeshuaw spoke, He never said, “**Thus saith the Lord**” (Exodus 4:22), as had Yehovaw's prophets before Him ; rather, He always said, “**Verily I say, unto you.**” (Matthew 5:18) Yehovaw had told Moses:

I will raise them up a Prophet, from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in His mouth; and He shall speak unto them all that I shall command Him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)

Yehovaw added, to Moses, this ominous warning:

And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto My words, which He shall speak in My name, I will require it of him. (Deuteronomy 18:19)

Requiring the Blood

Later Yehovaw spoke, to His prophet, of “requiring” the blood of a lost child at his hand, if the prophet should fail to warn him or her; and, from the language that Yehovaw used in that passage, one learns His meaning that for the prophet’s failure to warn His children Yehovaw would not deliver his soul! (Ezekiel 3:19) Upon dying, he would wind up in “**the heart of the Earth**” (Matthew 12:40) “**in torments**”! (Luke 16:23)

Children “**in torments**” (Luke 16:23) would have a second chance, if they hearkened to Yehovaw’s Words through Yeshuaw after He came down to them after dying and rising again! But children yet alive who failed to hearken to those precious words of “**spirit**” and “**life**” (John 6:63), of Salvation and Redemption, would “**have no cloak for their sin**” (John 14:22); indeed, when Yeshuaw died,

the veil of the temple was rent in twain, from the top to the bottom (Matthew 27:51),

which had remained there for fifteen hundred years, protecting the children of Israel from Yehovaw's certain judgments as contained in His covenant, law and commandments, a copy of which was in His Ark of the Covenant, which had always been kept hidden behind the veil, in the temple's Most Holy Place!

Chapter 18 - His Brotherhood (continued)

Unleashed Judgments

Having “**no cloak for their sin**” (John 14:22), the children of Yehovaw would find Him requiring unrepentant sin of them by sending them first to “**the heart of the Earth**” (Matthew 12:40) for a thousand years (Revelation 20:5) “**in the lowest pit, in darkness, in the deeps**” (Psalm 88:6) and then to His Lake of Fire, where “**the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever**” (Revelation 14:11), “**whosoever was not found written in the Book of Life**”! (Revelation 20:15)

Speaking to “**the house of Israel**” (Matthew 15:24), Yeshuaw said,

Other sheep I have, who are not of this fold: them also I must bring; and they shall hear My voice! And there shall be one fold and one shepherd! (John 10:16)

Just before Yehovaw the Father brought Yeshuaw to Heaven to be with Him, He commanded, through Yeshuaw, His Disciples:

Go ... and teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

Chapter 19 - His Passion

Reason for Teaching

The simple reason for teaching “**all nations**” (Matthew 28:19), Yehovaw explained, through Moses, is that any person who

doeth ought presumptuously, whether he be born in the land or a stranger, the same reproacheth the Lord; and that soul shall be cut off from among his people! (Numbers 15:30)

Because he hath despised the word of the Lord and hath broken His commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; his iniquity shall be upon him. (Numbers 15:31)

Our gracious and holy Lord God feels keenly each thing His children do to violate a neighbor! (John 17:22 and 23) And He most assuredly returns that pain to them. (Exodus 21:23 to 25; Luke 6:38)

Iniquities Afflict

Yehovaw said, through His Psalmist:

Fools, because of their transgression and because of their iniquities, are afflicted! (Psalm 107:17)

Then, when the time of Israel’s deliverance is at hand and when the children of Israel repent of their wrongdoing (Matthew 4:17), Yehovaw sends “**His Word**” and heals His children of that affliction (Psalm 107:20), if they ask Him to. (Psalm 107:2, 19; Matthew 7:7)

At the same time, when they qualify for it (Exodus 20:6; John 15:13 and 14), Yeshuaw, Who is that Word, delivers Yehovaw’s children “**from their destructions**” (Psalm 107:20), which are the certainty of “**everlasting fire**” (Matthew 25:41) for those who do not love Yehovaw and keep His Commandments! (Exodus 20:6; Revelation 20:15)

Chapter 19 - His Passion (continued)

An Absolute Mockery

To want the benefits of that amazing redemption yet have no desire to stop sinning by keeping or putting the highest possible value on the Redeemer's commandments - all of them, including His circumcision (Genesis 17:10 to 14) - is an absolute mockery of what Yehovaw had in mind in offering up His beloved Lamb as His sacrifice for His children's atonement! (Romans 5:11) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

Be not deceived! God is not mocked! For whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap! (Galatians 6:7)

Yehovaw said, through His author:

²⁶If we sin willfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins ²⁷but a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery, which shall devour the adversaries! (Hebrews 10:26 and 27)

Yehovaw wrote, through His Faithful Apostle:

Sin is the transgression of the law! (1st John 3:4)

Knowing Him

Hereby we do know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments! (1st John 2:3)

Whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight! (1st John 3:22)

This is the love of God, that we keep His commandments! And His commandments are not grievous! (1st John 5:3)

In obedience to Yehovaw the Father, Yeshuaw, "the Lamb of God" (John 1:29), permitted Himself to be crucified that His children might know how eager Yehovaw is to forgive those who are sorry they have violated His will, His goodness and the very nature of His being and sincerely want to fulfill His desire for them in all righteousness, thereby qualifying for the most amazing and glorious destiny imaginable in His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, first on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5) and then in Heaven! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19)
