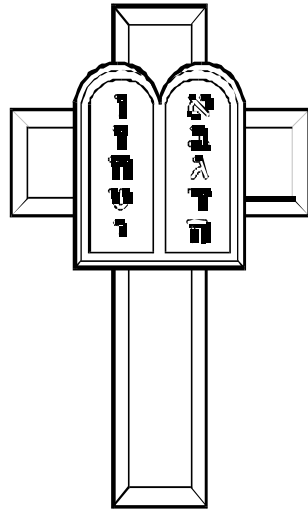

# Yehovaw the Spirit

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul, that "there are diversities of gifts but the same Spirit" (1st Corinthians 12:4) He was speaking of ha Kodesh Ruakh, the powerful Third Person of the Godhead! Yehovaw commanded, through Yeshuaw:

Go ... and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost! (Matthew 28:19)

By the awesome power of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw flung His galaxies into their places; He wrote, through His recorder:

The Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters! (Genesis 1:2)

Yehovaw asked His Servant Job:

Where wast thou, when I laid the foundations of the Earth? (Job 38:4)

Declare, if thou hast understanding. (Job 38:4)

Who laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? (Job 38:5)

Or who hath stretched the line upon it? (Job 38:5)

Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? (Job 38:6)

<sup>6</sup>Who laid the corner stone thereof, <sup>7</sup>when the morning stars sang together and all the sons of God shouted for joy? (Job 38:6 and 7)

<sup>8</sup>Who shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, as if it had issued out of the womb? <sup>9</sup>When I made the cloud the garment thereof and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it <sup>10</sup>and brake up for it My decreed place and set bars and doors <sup>11</sup>And said, Hitherto shalt thou come but no further: and here shall thy proud waves be stayed? (Job 38:8 to 11)

<sup>12</sup>Hast thou commanded the morning, since thy days, and caused the dayspring to know his place <sup>13</sup>that it might take hold of the ends of the Earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it? (Job 38:12 and 13)

Hast thou entered into the springs of the sea? (Job 38:16)

Or hast thou walked in search of the depth? (Job 38:16)

Have the gates of death been opened unto thee? (Job 38:17)

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Or hast thou seen the doors of the Shadow of Death? (Job 38:17)

Hast thou perceived the breadth of the Earth? (Job 38:18)

Declare, if thou knowest it all. (Job 38:18)

Where is the way where light dwelleth? (Job 38:19)

And, as for darkness, where is the place thereof, that thou shouldest take it to the bound thereof and that thou shouldest know the paths to the house thereof? (Job 38:20)

Knowest thou it because thou wast then born or because the number of thy days is great? (Job 38:20)

Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? (Job 38:21)

<sup>22</sup>Or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail, <sup>23</sup>which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war? (Job 38:and 23)

By what way is the light parted, which scattereth the East wind upon the Earth? (Job 38:24)

<sup>25</sup>Who hath divided a watercourse for the overflowing of waters or a way for the lightning of thunder, <sup>26</sup>to cause it to rain on the Earth, where no man is; on the wilderness, wherein there is no man, <sup>27</sup>to satisfy the desolate and waste ground and to cause the bud of the tender herb to spring forth? (Job 38:25 to 27)

Hath the rain a father? (Job 38:28)

Or who hath begotten the drops of dew? (Job 38:28)

Out of whose womb came the ice? (Job 38:29)

The hoary frost of Heaven, who hath gendered it? (Job 38:29)

The waters are hid as with a stone? and the face of the deep is frozen! (Job 38:30)

Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades or loose the bands of Orion? (Job 38:31)

Cast thou bring forth Mazzaroth in his season? (Job 38:32)

Or canst thou guide Arcturus with his sons? (Job 38:32)

Knowest thou the ordinances of Heaven? (Job 38:33)

Canst thou set the dominion thereof in the Earth? (Job 38:33)

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Canst thou lift up thy voice to the clouds, that abundance of waters may cover thee? (Job 38:34)

Canst thou send lightnings, that they may go and say, unto thee, Here we are? (Job 38:35)

Who hath put wisdom in the inward Parts? (Job 38:36)

Or who hath given understanding to the heart? (Job 38:36)

Who can number the clouds in wisdom? (Job 38:37)

<sup>37</sup>Or who can stay the bottles of Heaven, <sup>38</sup>when the dust groweth into hardness and the clods cleave fast together? (Job 38:37 and 38)

<sup>39</sup>Wilt thou hunt the prey for the lion? or fill the appetite of the young lions, <sup>40</sup>when they couch in their dens and abide in the covert to lie in wait? (Job 38:39 and 40)

Who provideth for the raven his food? (Job 38:41)

When his young ones cry unto God, they wander for lack of meat! (Job 38:41)

Knowest thou the time when the wild goats of the rock bring forth? (Job 39:1)

Or canst thou mark when the hinds do calve? (Job 39:1)

Cast thou number the months that they fulfill? (Job 39:2)

Or knowest thou the time when they bring forth? (Job 39:2)

They bow themselves; they bring forth their young ones; they cast out their sorrows! (Job 39:3)

Their young ones are in good liking! They grow up with corn! They go forth and return not unto them. (Job 39:4)

Who hath sent out the wild ass free? (Job 39:5)

Or who hath loosed the bands of the wild ass, whose house I have made the wilderness and the barren land his dwellings? (Job 39:5 and 6)

He scorneth the multitude of the city! Neither regardeth he the crying of the driver! (Job 39:7)

The range of the mountains is his pasture! And he searcheth after every green thing! (Job 39:8)

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Will the unicorn be willing to serve thee or abide by thy crib? (Job 39:9)

Canst thou bind the unicorn with his band in the furrow? (Job 39:10)

Or will he harrow the valleys after thee? (Job 39:10)

Wilt thou trust him; because his strength is great? (Job 39:11)

Or wilt thou leave thy labor to him? (Job 39:11)

Wilt thou believe him, that he will bring home thy seed and gather it into thy barn?  
(Job 39:12)

<sup>13</sup>Gavest thou the goodly wings unto the peacocks? or wings and feathers unto the ostrich? <sup>14</sup>which leaveth her eggs in the Earth, and warmeth them in dust <sup>15</sup>and forgetteth that the foot may crush them or that the wild beast may break them?  
(Job 39:13 to 15)

<sup>16</sup>She is hardened against her young ones, as though they were not hers: her labor is in vain without fear; <sup>17</sup>because God hath deprived her of wisdom, neither hath He imparted to her understanding! (Job 39:16 and 17)

What time she lifteth up herself on high, she scorneth the horse and his rider! (Job 39:18)

Hast thou given the horse strength? (Job 39:19)

Hast thou clothed his neck with thunder? (Job 39:19)

Canst thou make him afraid as a grasshopper? (Job 39:20)

The glory of his nostrils is terrible! (Job 39:20)

He paweth in the valley and rejoiceth in his strength! He goeth on to meet the armed men! (Job 39:21)

He mocketh at fear and is not affrighted; neither turneth he back from the sword!  
(Job 39:22)

The quiver rattleth against him, the glittering spear and the shield! (Job 39:23)

He swalloweth the ground, with fierceness and rage! neither believeth he that it is the sound of the trumpet! (Job 39:24)

He saith, among the trumpets, Ha, ha! And he smelleth the battle afar off, the thunder of the captains and the shouting! (Job 39:25)

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Doth the hawk fly by thy wisdom and stretch her wings toward the South? (Job 39:26)

Doth the eagle mount up at thy command and make her nest on high? (Job 39:27)

She dwelleth and abideth on the rock, upon the crag of the rock and the strong place. (Job 39:28)

From thence she seeketh the pray, and her eyes behold afar off! (Job 39:29)

Her young ones also suck up blood! And where the slain are, there is she! (Job 39:30)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, heals the bruised knee of a child! He wrote, through His apostle Luke:

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: Who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed of the Devil! For God was with Him. (Acts 10:38)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, removes a devil from His child; He said, through Yeshuaw:

If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. (Matthew 12:28)

At the same time ha Kodesh Ruakh is Yehovaw's "Spirit of Truth"! (John 16:13) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

When He, the Spirit of Truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth! For He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak; and He will show you things to come! (John 16:13)

Being Yehovaw's "Spirit of Truth"! (John 16:13), ha Kodesh Ruakh records in books all knowledge throughout His universe! Yehovaw wrote, through His recorder:

<sup>31</sup>Moses returned, unto the Lord, and said, Oh, this people have sinned a great sin and have made them gods of gold! <sup>32</sup>Yet now, if thou wilt forgive their sin ...; and, if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of the book that Thou hast written! (Exodus 32:31 and 32)

And the Lord said, unto Moses, Whosoever hath sinned against Me, him will I blot out of My book. (Exodus 32:33)

Yehovaw said, through Moses:

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<sup>9</sup>The LORD thy God will make thee plenteous in every work of thine hand, in the fruit of thy body, and in the fruit of thy cattle, and in the fruit of thy land, for good: for the LORD will again rejoice over thee for good, as he rejoiced over thy fathers, <sup>10</sup>if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to keep His commandments and His statutes, which are written in this book of the law, and if thou turn unto the Lord thy God, with all thine heart and with all thy soul!  
(Deuteronomy 30:9 and 10)

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God! And the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the Book of Life! And the dead were judged out of those things that were written in the books, according to their works!  
(Revelation 20:12)

And whosoever was not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the Lake of Fire! (Revelation 20:15)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, then transmits that precious knowledge to the children of Israel! Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet:

Afterwards the spirit took me up and brought me, in a vision, by the Spirit of God, into Chaldea, to them of the captivity! So the vision that I had seen went up from me. (Ezekiel 11:24)

Then I spake, unto them of the captivity, all the things that the Lord had shewed me. (Ezekiel 11:25)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

<sup>7</sup>The manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal <sup>8</sup>For to one is given, by the Spirit, the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge, by the same Spirit, <sup>9</sup>to another faith, by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing, by the same Spirit, <sup>10</sup>to another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues. (1st Corinthians 12:7 to 10)

But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will! (1st Corinthians 12:11)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, also reveals, moment-by-moment, Yehovaw's will for each of His righteous children! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Jesus, being full of the Holy Ghost, returned, from Jordan, and was led, by the Spirit, into the wilderness! (Luke 4:1)

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Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

The Spirit said, unto Philip, Go near and join thyself to this chariot! (Acts 8:29)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

As many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God! (Romans 8:14)

Yehovaw mentioned, through Yeshuaw, that ha Kodesh Ruakh, His "Spirit of truth" (John 16:13) would "show you things to come"! (Verse 13) He called that manifestation His "word of wisdom"! (1st Corinthians 12:8)

Yehovaw did not permit king David to build His temple! But "by the Spirit" (1st Chronicles 28:12) He gave him

the pattern of the porch and of the houses thereof and of the treasuries thereof and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlors thereof and of the place of the Mercy Seat. (1st Chronicles 28:11)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

There stood up one of them named Agabus and signified, by the Spirit, that there should be great dearth throughout all the world, which came to pass in the days of Claudius Caesar! (Acts 11:28)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh is the Spirit by Whom Yehovaw fulfills His covenant with the children of Israel! For it is by the power of His Spirit that Yehovaw's gives His children any supernatural reward to the worthy, whether of "power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing"! (Revelation 5:12)

So the knowledge of ha Kodesh Ruakh that is given in this extraordinary work will enhance the student's understanding of any one of those awesome rewards! (Verse 12)

Anyone interested in receiving "power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing" (Revelation 5:12) must know ha Kodesh Ruakh, the powerful person of the Godhead (Micah 3:8) by Whom we know the nature of Yehovaw - the holy, almighty, eternal and self-existent Creator and Lord God over all the universe!

Although He is the tremendous and awesome power of "Yehovaw", the comprehensive name of the three Persons Who comprise the Godhead (Matthew 28:19), ha Kodesh Ruakh functions only as a faithful servant for Yehovaw the Father and for Yeshuaw, Who is Yehovaw "the Word" (John 1:1 to 3 and 14), "the Son of God" (Luke 1:35) and "the Son of Man"! (Mark 2:10) Yeshuaw said, of ha Kodesh Ruakh:

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He shall glorify Me! For He shall receive of Mine and shall show it unto you! All things that the Father hath are Mine! Therefore said I, that He shall take of Mine and shall show it unto you! (John 16:13 to 15)

What an amazing example and a clear demonstration of what Yehovaw meant through Yeshuaw when He said:

Whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased! And he who shall humble himself shall be exalted! (Matthew 23:12)

For Hi Kodesh Ruakh's humble though supremely powerful service to the Godhead, He is revered even by Yehovaw the Father, Who said, through Yeshuaw:

All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men; but blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven, unto men. (Matthew 12:31)

Whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him; but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world nor in the world to come! (Matthew 12:32)

We find strange roles assigned to ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, where Yehovaw wrote through His prophet:

<sup>3</sup>It shall come to pass, that he who is left in Zion, and he who remaineth in Jerusalem, shall be called holy, even every one who is written among the living in Jerusalem, <sup>4</sup>when the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the Spirit of judgment and by the Spirit of burning! (Isaiah 4:3 and 4)

One finds not only that visions are one way by which ha Kodesh Ruakh communicates Yehovaw's truth to the children of Israel but that He actually transports people from one place to another! His Prophet wrote:

Afterwards the Spirit took me up and brought me, in a vision, by the Spirit of God, into Chaldea, to them of the captivity! (Ezekiel 11:24)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

<sup>39</sup>When they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more! <sup>40</sup>But Philip was found at Azotus! (Acts 8:39 and 40)

But sometimes ha Kodesh Ruakh is simply the powerful inspiration by which a prophet speaks, as witnessed by Yehovaw's prophet writing:

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Truly I am full of power by the Spirit of the Lord and of judgment and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression and to Israel his sin! (Micah 3:8)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. (Matthew 12:28)

That simple statement conveys several important truths about Yehovaw; I showed above that ha Kodesh Ruakh is the Person of the Godhead who drives the wrong kind of spirit from Yehovaw's children, when they are ready to stop believing and serving that spirit.

The close correlation between ha Kodesh Ruakh's functioning and the presence of "the kingdom of God" (Matthew 12:28) is important to note! For wherever that magnificent kingdom is, Yehovaw's power is always being manifested! And Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Behold, the kingdom of God is within you. (Luke 17:21)

So, whether one's object is to "enter into the kingdom of God" (John 3:5) or to have it enter into him or her, which are simply two ways of viewing the same basic oneness, Yeshuaw made it clear that neither of those blessed conditions can be attained "except a man be born of Water and of the Spirit"! (Verse 5) And one cannot have ha Kodesh Ruakh, unless he or she loves Yehovaw and keeps or puts the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father! And He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

He who keepeth His commandments dwelleth in Him and He in him! And hereby we know that He abideth in us, by the Spirit Whom He hath given us. (1st John 3:24)

Yehovaw wrote, through another apostle:

<sup>25</sup>Behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon! And the same man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. <sup>26</sup>And it was revealed, unto him, by the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death before he had seen the Lord's Christ! <sup>27</sup>And he came, by the Spirit, into the temple! (Luke 2:25 to 27)

That passage shows how ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, does several important things, such as His abiding presence being upon Simeon (John 14:15 to 17),

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His revelation of the future that Yehovaw had in mind for Simeon (John 16:13) and His leading Simeon to do that which would fulfill Yehovaw's prophecy for him, as He reveals His will for each of His righteous children on a moment-by-moment basis! (Verse 13) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle, of Yeshuaw:

As many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name! (John 1:12)

Sanctification is another interesting function of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit; Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

<sup>25</sup>Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it, <sup>26</sup>that He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word! (Ephesians 5:25 and 26)

According to the apostle John, Yeshuaw is God "the Word" (John 1:1 to 3), through Whom Yehovaw said:

I am the Way, the Truth and the Life! (John 14:6)

So the sanctification or cleansing of Yehovaw's church is accomplished, by Yeshuaw's speaking Yehovaw's word! He prayed, to Yehovaw the Father:

I have given unto them the Words that Thou gavest Me! (John 17:8)

Yehovaw the Father gives His words to Yeshuaw! And Yeshuaw prayed, to Yehovaw the Father:

Sanctify them through Thy truth! Thy word is truth. (John 17:17)

Yeshuaw then said, of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Who is "the Spirit of truth" (John 16:13):

He shall take of Mine and shall show it unto you! (John 16:15)

So Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? (1st Corinthians 6:9)

And such were some of you! But ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified, in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God! (1st Corinthians 6:11)

Since the church's cleansing is done by Yehovaw's word through His "Spirit of truth" (John 16:13; Ephesians 5:25 and 26), it is a fair assumption that the children of Israel are cleansed from believing Satan's lies, prompting Yehovaw to write through His apostle Paul:

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Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord but by the Holy Ghost. (1st Corinthians 12:3)

According to Yehovaw's word through Paul, the children of Israel also were justified, "by the Spirit of our God" (1st Corinthians 6:11), which relates to their being made righteous or at least to being considered as righteous by Yehovaw, Whose righteous kingdom His children want to enter! He said, through Moses:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness! And all these things shall be added unto you. (Matthew 6:33)

Yeshuaw is "the righteous Judge" of Israel (Micah 5:1; 2nd Timothy 4:8); but it is ha Kodesh Ruakh, Who "shall take of Mine and shall show it unto you"! (John 16:15) So we find also, by Yehovaw's word through His apostle Paul, that it is ha Kodesh Ruakh Who

<sup>16</sup>The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God  
<sup>17</sup>and, if children, then heirs - heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ! (Romans 8:16 and 17)

That amazing inheritance is extremely important! For "the Christ" (Matthew 16:20), the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899) is "the Lamb of God"! (John 1:29) And Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

<sup>11</sup>I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne ... <sup>12</sup>saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb Who was slain to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing! (Revelation 5:11 and 12)

So, if the children of Israel are considered worthy to be "joint-heirs with Christ" (Romans 8:17), they, too, are worthy "to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing"! (Revelation 5:12)

The wonder of that truth is virtually incomprehensible and can be, for those who receive it, a scriptural foundation for being exalted and fulfilled beyond a person's wildest dreams! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

He who hath My commandments and keepeth them, he it is who loveth Me; and he who loveth Me shall be loved of My Father! And I will love him and will manifest Myself to him. (John 14:21)

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Although Yehovaw is indeed "the Author and Finisher of our Faith" through Yeshuaw (Hebrews 12:2), it is ha Kodesh Ruakh Who does Yeshuaw's manifesting to the obedient! For Yehovaw tells us, through His apostle Paul, that

the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal! (1st Corinthians 12:7)

Yehovaw's revealing of Himself is by ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, as He has expressed through His apostle Paul:

We all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image, from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord! (2nd Corinthians 3:18)

The mystery of Yeshuaw was His personal involvement with Yehovaw's "eternal redemption" for the children of Israel (Isaiah 43:1; 44:22; 53), which is Yehovaw's permission after four thousand years to bring the righteous dead from "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40) to "Paradise"! (Luke 23:43; Hebrews 9:12; Revelation 14:3)

Yehovaw wrote about that mystery, through His apostle Paul, giving acknowledgment to ha Kodesh Ruakh for revealing it:

<sup>4</sup>When ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ, <sup>5</sup>which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto His holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit! (Ephesians 3:4 and 5)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh makes alive and causes men to preach about that mystery, as described by Yehovaw through His apostle Peter:

<sup>18</sup>Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but quickened by the Spirit, <sup>19</sup>by Whom also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison! (1st Peter 3:18 and 19)

The most important lesson I personally have derived from learning about ha Kodesh Ruakh is the understanding of how the prevailing spirit in anyone's life or in any organization or state of people determines what their hearts contain in the way of knowledge about anything and how they will interpret whatever knowledge is presented to them.

The vast difference in ideas or interpretations of fact that one encounters among people is best explained by the spirit to whom they have learned to listen, whether that of Yehovaw or of Satan! For Yehovaw's righteous children will ever see His truth in a situation, while Satan's victims will invariably see only the lies about fact or reality with which he has filled their hearts! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

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O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh! (Matthew 12:34)

The hateful spirit of destruction that has by now overwhelmed the world and has so many feeling utterly helpless is, simply, one more manifestation through Satan's servants of the spirit that is Satan and his hordes of foul spirits of darkness! These are his devils, which, in the last days before Yeshuaw will return to establish His righteous reign over the world, Yehovaw has permitted to manifest more than ever, as more and more of His children have entered into rebellion against Him.

Homosexuality is rampant, in direct defiance of Yehovaw's commandment:

If a man ... lie with mankind, as he lieth with a woman, both of them have committed an abomination: they shall surely be put to death; their blood shall be upon them. (Leviticus 20:13)

Exactly that abomination was the spiritual state of the city of Sodom, when Yehovaw sent two angels to destroy it; and historians tell us that rampant homosexuality has preceded the downfall of every major empire!

The framers of the constitution by which they would define and establish these united states of America, determined that their government would never be permitted to embrace by its law any particular religion! And for that reason the door of that union of states was for ever opened and the protection of their federal government guaranteed to every kind of religion, including Satan's false religions, teaching all manner of abomination in relation to the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law, which the First Amendment of its Constitution forbade it to embrace!

So the union's constitutional commitment to neutrality with respect to religion has kept its states and federal government from enforcing all the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law, relying upon statutes, some of which do reflect the more obvious of those commandments, such as theft, property damage, injury and murder, to carry the day!

But, since Yehovaw reserves the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, for those among His children who love Him and keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law (John 14:15 to 17), only those among His children who are keeping those commandments are enjoying those manifestations, while the rest of the world's people stubbornly adhere to the lies of Satan for their ways of solving problems, which are the last things that will ever do it; so they are being systematically destroyed!

That being the obvious picture for anyone who knows Yehovaw's truth, the question naturally arises: What can one do to change any of that?

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And a second question follows: since human behavior is determined by the spirit to whom anyone is listening and obeying, how does one get another to change that spiritual direction and become attuned to, guided by and saved by the right Spirit from all that has been plaguing him or her?

The answer again lies with paying attention to Yehovaw's way of doing things rather than Satan's, the latter of which the world has so foolishly embraced! And Yehovaw's way can only be learned and implemented by keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law!

Mankind's basic problem has been in place ever since Adam and Eve disobeyed Yehovaw in the Garden of Eden!

The children of Israel brought a willing offering unto the Lord, every man and woman whose heart made them willing to bring for all manner of work that the Lord had commanded to be made by the hand of Moses! (Exodus 35:29)

### **Numbers 9:22 Israel's Obedience to Ha Kodesh Ruakh**

Whether it were two days, a month or a year that the cloud tarried upon the tabernacle, remaining thereon, the children of Israel abode in their tents and journeyed not! But, when it was taken up, they journeyed. (Numbers 9:22)

### **Numbers 14:24 Caleb Having Ha Kodesh Ruakh with Him, His Following Yehovaw Fully**

My servant Caleb ... him will I bring into the land whereinto he went! And his seed shall possess it (Numbers 14:24);

because he had another Spirit with him and hath followed Me fully!
