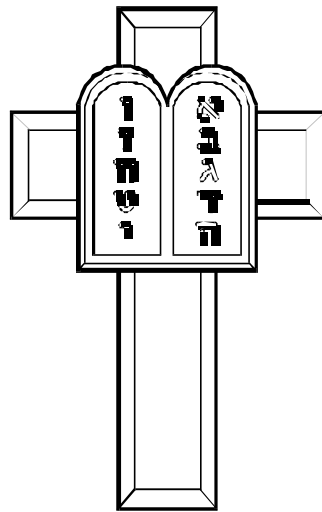

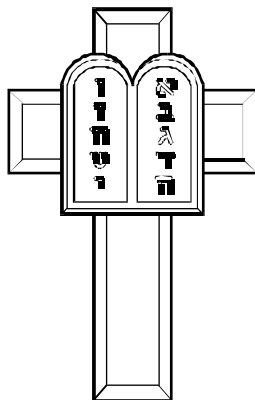

# The Person of the Holy Spirit ... know Him?

## Introduction

### Special Missions

During Yehovaw's Old Testament period ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, was seen to manifest particularly for the prophets and kings of Israel, who had special missions to perform, while the other children of Israel were still trying to figure out where they fit in to Yehovaw's plan for them.

People are still trying to figure that out; but that is the fault of Yehovaw's church and certainly not that of Yehovaw Himself, Who by now has given all that He has to give, including Yeshuaw, "**His only begotten Son**" (John 3:16), to help get that truth over to them, which, if received and appropriately acted upon, releases ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, to manifest mightily in behalf of an entire nation of kings and priests; He said, through Moses:

<sup>5</sup>If ye will obey My voice indeed and keep My covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people! For all the Earth is Mine! <sup>6</sup>And ye shall be, unto Me, a kingdom of priests and an holy nation! (Exodus 19:5 and 6)

### Lack of Knowledge

Yehovaw wrote, through His Prophet:

My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge! Because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt be no priest to Me. (Hosea 4:6)

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His Apostle John:

<sup>5</sup>Unto Him Who loved us and washed us, from our sins, in His own blood, <sup>6</sup>and hath made us kings and priests unto God and His Father, to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever! Amen! (Revelation 1:5 and 6)

Introduction (continued)

### **Anointing the King**

In Yehovaw's historical record of affairs with the children of Israel, when He wanted a certain king for Israel, He would send a prophet of His, who would anoint the new king, by pouring olive oil on his head! And, under His toraw or law, when a priest was to be brought into his office, olive oil was used also in that ceremony, to indicate the power and guidance of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Who was to empower and guide him in the discharge of his duties!

But the day would come when the development of the children of Israel under Yehovaw's strict yet loving discipline for them, would bring them into their own! And ha Kodesh Ruakh's supernatural empowerment and guidance would be the amazing experience of every one of them; Yehovaw said, through His prophet:

It shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh! And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy! Your old men shall dream dreams! And your young men shall see visions! (Joel 2:28)

### **Freed to Receive Him**

That prophecy relates to the communication of Yehovaw's truth through powerful, supernatural means! It is ha Kodesh Ruakh at work among a people freed to receive Him by having accepted the basic truth that was revealed by Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), Jesus the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or Jesus "the Christ" (Matthew 16:20), about Whom Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle:

In the beginning was the Word! And the Word was with God; and the Word was God. (John 1:1)

The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us; and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth! (John 1:14)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye love Me, keep My Commandments! And I will pray the Father! And He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

"If ye love Me" was a big "if"! That vital issue had been "iffy" for four thousand years!

Introduction (continued)

### **Worthy of Their Love**

Loving Yehovaw should not have been an issue, with Yehovaw's children, from Adam and Eve onward! Yehovaw was worthy of His children's love from the day of His having created them; but their stubborn willfulness, encouraged by Satan's lies, tempted them to cast blame for their afflictions upon Yehovaw instead of upon themselves, where it has always belonged!

Yehovaw had told the children of Israel the truth about blame for their afflictions through various prophets! (Leviticus 26; Deuteronomy 28) He had to do that, because of the dominion that He had given Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden

over every living thing that moveth upon the Earth! (Genesis 1:28)

That dominion was the right Yehovaw gave to Adam and Eve to say what was to be on Earth! So, to honor that dominion, Yehovaw never permitted Yeshuaw or Angels to speak directly to the children of Israel except on rare and very special occasions, to accomplish certain specific things, notably to give prophets His word, which put upon the prophet a great responsibility to pass that word on, to the children of Israel, using his dominion to do so.

### **Warning the Wicked**

Yehovaw said, to one young prophet:

When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die, and thou givest him not warning nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life, the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity! But his blood will I require at thine hand! (Ezekiel 3:18)

Yet, if thou warn the wicked and he turn not from his wickedness nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but thou hast delivered thy soul! (Ezekiel 3:19)

The typical response by doubting Israelites, which most of them were, was to ask the prophet:

What do you know about anything?

Introduction (continued)

### Ye Take Too Much

Yehovaw wrote, through His recorder, of one occasion on which certain of the children of Israel

gathered themselves together, against Moses and against Aaron, and said, unto them, Ye take too much upon you, seeing all the congregation are holy, every one of them, and the Lord is among them: wherefore then lift ye up yourselves above the congregation of the Lord? (Numbers 16:3)

Yehovaw was not pleased with that rebellious conduct; so

<sup>32</sup>the Earth opened her mouth and swallowed them up and their houses, <sup>33</sup>they and all that appertained to them went down alive into the pit; and the Earth closed upon them: and they perished from among the congregation! (Numbers 16:32 and 33)

Throughout the history that Yehovaw wrote of His people, the children of Israel, He recorded one sad instance after another where His word through a prophet was spurned and the unbeliever delivered into the violent hands of Satan, the Destroyer!

### Sending His Word

So Yehovaw finally sent Yehovaw “the Word” into the world (John 1:1), as a child born to the virgin Mary and sired by ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, making Him both “the Son of God” (Luke 1:35) and “the Son of Man” (Mark 2:10), Who then went about telling Yehovaw's truth, not saying “Thus saith the Lord”, as had Yehovaw’s prophets, but “**Verily, I say, unto you**” (Matthew 5:18), which made it clear that every word He uttered was that of Yehovaw Himself! (John 14:10)

The human dominion was still being honored! A son of man was doing the talking! But it was the voice of Yehovaw the Word now speaking the words of Yehovaw the Father, so that

<sup>28</sup>the people were astonished at His doctrine! <sup>29</sup>For He taught them as one having authority and not as the scribes! (Matthew 7:28 and 29)

Yeshuaw’s authority got the attention of some particularly receptive Israelites; but of the rest, Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin! But now they have no cloak for their sin.** (John 15:22)

### Hating Both

If I had not done among them the works that no other man did, they had not had sin! But now have they both seen and hated both Me and My Father! (John 15:24)

Yeshuaw's detractors were still challenging the prophet and demanding to know,

By what authority doest Thou these things? (Matthew 21:23)

And who gave Thee this authority? (Matthew 21:23)

Yehovaw then used that hate, commanding Yeshuaw to permit those servants of Satan to crucify Him, in the process of which He prayed for Yehovaw to forgive them, thus answering their challenge:

I have done these things by the authority of Him Who has suffered each time you have hurt a neighbor, for which sin He has had to remove you from His kingdom of life and leave you in His world of death, where His children are in rebellion against Him!

And I have done these things by the authority of Him Who would forgive you of any sin you have committed, even of this hateful violence unto death that you have now done to Me, if you will only repent of it!

### Awesome Demonstration

Yeshuaw thus demonstrated, before the entire world, the suffering and death of Yehovaw the Father in the sinning of His children, one against another, and the ultimate mercy conceivable on His part, putting great significance upon His word through His prophet:

I have no pleasure in the death of him who dieth, saith the Lord God: wherefore turn yourselves and live! (Ezekiel 18:32)

The Roman soldiers got the point! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Now when the centurion and they who were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the Son of God! (Matthew 27:54)

A Lord God willing to forgive even those who had crucified His righteous Son was certainly worthy of His children's love and certainly not worthy to be blamed for all their afflictions! So that record was set straight for evermore!

### **Loving Yehovaw**

Once convinced of that fundamental truth about Yehovaw, His children could then freely love Him and keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law, thus qualifying themselves to receive the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit (John 14:15 to 17), Who then would guide them “**into all truth**”! (John 16:13) Alleluia!

## Chapter 1 - Spirit of the Supernatural

### **Lured by Fairy Tales**

When I was a boy of eight years, I systematically went through the fairy tale section of my small town's public library, until there was not a book they had of such bizarre tales that I had not read several times! I now recognize that the fascination I felt in reading those mischievous fables lay in the supernatural powers that were continually made available to the characters in the stories!

There were the fairies, who were good, and the witches, who were bad! But both were notable for their ability to do extraordinary things!

I was a child of Yehovaw, at that young age, in the sense of having been created by Him, whatever may have been the teaching I received from my parents concerning Him; and deep down inside of me I knew that there should be a supernatural realm of power able to fulfill my strong desires for all kinds of wonderful things!

### **Occult Children's Stories**

As false and dangerous as they were, in relation to spiritual truth as one can know it from Yehovaw's Holy Bible, the occult children's stories from the library kept me literally spellbound! And, not being sensitive to such considerations, my poor parents, even ministers of a large Christian denomination, had no more concern about my wayward preoccupation of that time than to see that I got the light out and into bed at least before midnight!

The cost to my parents and to myself of that dark indulgence was considerable! Having allowed me to be virtually consumed in that demonic pursuit, my parents could only watch as the Satanic spirits that drove me to that library to read their servants' works kept me continually afflicted with serious childhood diseases! I even contracted "scarlet fever", which threatened my heart, kept me bedridden for six weeks, made me learn to walk all over again and compromised me, physically, for years to come!

#### Grownup Fairy Tales

As a teenager, I graduated to accounts of the supernatural that were designed for an open mind just my age! And I found myself checking into hypnosis, spiritism, parapsychology, Eastern religions and other forms of the occult, that pursuit being motivated by this persistent idea that there should be a supernatural realm and ways for the ordinary person to use it.

Ironically, my appetite for the supernatural was whetted by the teachings of my parents and their church, which were based upon Yehovaw's Holy Bible, in which angels are written about and prophets, who went around doing amazing things; and, finally, the Lord Yeshuaw ha Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), Jesus the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or Jesus "the Christ" (Matthew 16:20) appears, in the New Testament, Who was not to be outdone by any of His forebears in Israel, in His constant performing of miracles, whether to calm the wind and the waves (Mark 4:39), to feed thousands with a boy's lunch (John 6:9), to heal people of their afflictions and even to cast out devils (Matthew 4:24), which was definitely the revelation of a realm beyond our physical senses, in which Yeshuaw felt perfectly at home!

#### Greater Works

Yeshuaw told His Disciples:

**He who believeth on Me, the works that I do shall he do also! And greater works than these shall he do, because I go unto My Father! And whatsoever ye shall ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son! (John 14:12 and 13)**

There is not a single one of us who does not like the idea of supernatural power to be true! The motion picture "Superman" was a Fabulous Success! And with millions of other viewers, my family got caught up in its euphoria, going several times to see a man in blue tights and a flying red cape do things that deep down inside each one of us we know we should be doing or would like to do, if it were not for the strict limitations of our physical existence, which simply do not permit the realization of such far fetched yet persistent fantasies!

The whole problem throughout the life of any one of us is not in wanting such things but, rather, in seeking them in the wrong places!

### Chapter 1 - Spirit of the Supernatural (continued)

#### **The Powerful One**

Yehovaw's Holy Spirit is the Person of the Godhead Who is the powerful and truthful One. It is by His incomprehensible power to create and maintain that you and I sit breathing right now, with an amazing heart beating strongly and faithfully, while our time as a physical being continues to be permitted by Yehovaw the Father!

Yehovaw's will for you and me is done, each moment of time, every day of our lives, according to Yeshuaw's intercession for us. (Hebrews 7:25)

Yehovaw has two agendas for His children: He sovereignly gives the life, blessing, liberty, joy and power of His glorious and eternal kingdom on Earth (Matthew 6:10) to those who love Him and keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law (Deuteronomy 28:1 to 14); and He sovereignly leaves the death and cursing of His world to those who hate Him and put the lowest possible value on those commandments. (Verses 15 to 68)

#### **Hands Off Hearts**

The only things that Yehovaw does not direct are the hearts of His children, wherein they decide whether to love Him or hate Him, to obey Him or rebel against Him; that sacred area He leaves entirely to their will, whether it ultimately leads to their "eternal life" (John 3:15) in His presence and kingdom or to eternal damnation in His "Lake of Fire" (Revelation 20:15), after a thousand years in "Hell" (Luke 16:23), in "the of the Earth" (Psalm 88; Matthew 12:40; Revelation 20:5)

It is ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, Who gives, to the righteous among Yehovaw's children, "the Word of Wisdom" (1st Corinthians 12:8) or the ability to glimpse Yehovaw's mind in relation to the future! He gives "to another the Word of Knowledge" (Verse 8), by which to know supernaturally certain things that have happened in relation to another person!

Under the power of that mighty Spirit, people in right standing with Yehovaw find themselves able to see the possibility of something that only Yehovaw could know for its unusualness! He has called that vision of great potential "faith"! (Mark 11:22)

Yehovaw supernaturally heals His faithful and trusting children, through servants of His who are rightly yielded to ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! (1st Corinthians 12:9) And He does extraordinary things through others and calls it "the Working of Miracles"! (Verse 10)

#### **Yehovaw Heals**

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, guides His children to speak certain words "that all may learn and be comforted"! (1st Corinthians 12:10; 14:31) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

He who prophesieth speaketh unto men to edification, exhortation and comfort!  
(1st Corinthians 14:3)

Occasionally, ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, will open a person's eyes to Yehovaw's spirit realm, to see His or those of Satan! Or ha Kodesh Ruakh will sensitize the mind of His child to what kind of spirit is at work in another person, for good or evil! Through the apostle Paul, Yehovaw called that manifestation of His Holy Spirit "Discerning of Spirits"! (1st Corinthians 12:10)

Yehovaw's amazing Spirit gives, freely, to all who seek Him by keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law (John 14:15 to 17), "Diverse Kinds of Tongues" (Verse 10) or a prayer language that forbids any rational understanding yet gives to the person speaking in tongues the power to speak "unto God"! (1st Corinthians 14:2)

## Chapter 2 - Spirit of Mystery

### He Speaketh Mysteries

Yehovaw explained, through His apostle Paul:

In the spirit he speaketh mysteries! (1st Corinthians 14:2)

We know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit Himself maketh intercession for us with groanings that cannot be uttered! (Romans 8:26)

<sup>12</sup>Forasmuch as ye are zealous of spiritual gifts, seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church! <sup>13</sup>Wherefore let him who speaketh in an unknown tongue pray that he may interpret! <sup>14</sup>For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prayeth, but my understanding is unfruitful! (1st Corinthians 14:12 to 14)

Paul wrote, lovingly:

I would that ye all spake with tongues but, rather, that ye prophesied! For greater is he who prophesieth than he who speaketh with tongues, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying! (1st Corinthians 14:5)

### Building Up

"Edifying" relates to "architecture" (Strong: Greek: 3619) and implies the building up of a person, which was constantly stressed by Yehovaw through His apostle Paul, in His profound description of the manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh:

He who speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth himself! But he who prophesieth edifieth the church! (1st Corinthians 14:4)

Yeshuaw is the Person of the Godhead Who, as the "express image" of Yehovaw the Father (Hebrews 1:3) is the Revelation to us of our Father in Heaven! (John 10:45; 14:9) Yeshuaw said:

He who hath seen Me hath seen the Father! (John 14:9)

### Chapter 2 - Spirit of Mystery (continued)

#### Yeshuaw the Word

Yeshuaw is called Yehovaw “**the Word**”, by the apostle John (John 1:1), who wrote that He was “**with God; and the Word was God**”. (Verse 1) Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle, concerning Yeshuaw, that

*All things were made by Him; and without Him was not any thing made that was made. (John 1:3)*

When “**God said, Let there be light**” (Genesis 1:3), it was Yeshuaw who spoke that Word; but it was ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, Who “**moved upon the face of the waters**” (Verse 2), Who actually manifested that light or caused it to be seen! (Verse 3)

When Yehovaw the Father had sent Yeshuaw to Earth, to reveal Him to the children of Israel, Yeshuaw identified ha Kodesh Ruakh, as the Spirit of power and truth by which He accomplished all things that He did! He said:

*If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. (Matthew 12:28)*

#### Honoring the Spirit

Yeshuaw constantly honored ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit; He said:

*All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven, unto men; but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. (Matthew 12:31)*

Yeshuaw said that ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, is “**the Spirit of truth**” (John 16:13), Who “**will guide you into all truth**”. (Verse 13):

*For He shall not speak of Himself; but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will show you things to come! (John 16:13)*

“Blasphemy” means “vilification” or “evil speaking” (Strong: Greek: 988); and, when you choose to speak against the one Person in the Universe Whose function is to “**guide you into all truth**” (John 16:13), you divorce yourself from that truth, which is the only knowledge available anywhere to keep you from being destroyed! Yehovaw wrote, through His Prophet:

*My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge! (Hosea 4:6)*

### Chapter 2 - Spirit of Mystery (continued)

#### **Dangerous Practice**

Yehovaw's merciful willingness to forgive His children when they repent of their sins is part of the truth into which ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, guides them; so one's speaking against the One Who provides that knowledge for anyone cuts him or her off from the only act of mercy by which Yehovaw has provided for His children's salvation! So one can readily see why blasphemy or speaking against ha Kodesh Ruakh is so dangerous! (Matthew 12:31)

Everything Yeshuaw did in obedience to Yehovaw the Father He did by the power and guidance of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power, Who went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil! For God was with Him. (Acts 10:38)

When it came time for Yeshuaw to make of His own body and blood (Matthew 26:26 to 28) "an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel" (Leviticus 16:17; Romans 5:11), He did so by the power and guidance of ha Kodesh Ruakh!

#### **Purging Your Conscience**

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author:

How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? (Hebrews 9:14)

When on the cross Yeshuaw cried out "It is finished! ... bowed His head and gave up the ghost" (John 19:30) and He was put into His tomb, ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, immediately raised Him up as a gloriously resurrected man and was the power and guidance for His preaching "in the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40) to Yehovaw's children who had died! Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

<sup>18</sup>Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but quickened by the Spirit, <sup>19</sup>by Whom also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison! (1st Peter 3:18 and 19)

### Chapter 2 - Spirit of Mystery (continued)

#### **From Earth to Paradise**

When Yeshuaw had offered to “the spirits in prison” the truth He had revealed in making of Himself “an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel” (Leviticus 16:17), so that they might be “be clean from all your sins before the Lord” (Verse 30) as well as those who were still living, He brought them from “the heart of the Earth” (Matthew 12:40) to “Paradise”! (Luke 23:43)

The power and guidance of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, was what enabled “the spirits in prison” (1st Peter 3:18) to be taken to “Paradise”! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God! (John 3:5)**

Yehovaw wrote, through His Prophet, of Yeshuaw:

**I, the Lord, have called Thee in righteousness and will hold thine hand and will keep Thee and give Thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles! (Isaiah 42:6)**

## Chapter 3 - Spirit of Light

### Given for a Covenant

When Yeshuaw made of His own body and blood “an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel” (Leviticus 16:17), He fulfilled the first part of Yehovaw’s prophecy, that He would, speaking of Yeshuaw, “give Thee for a covenant of the people”! (Isaiah 42:6) Yeshuaw said, to His disciples:

**This is My blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins!** (Matthew 26:28)

To fulfill the second part of Yehovaw’s prophecy, that He would “give Thee ... for a light of the Gentiles” (Isaiah 42:6), Yeshuaw returned from taking “the spirits in prison” (1st Peter 3:18) to “Paradise” (Luke 23:43) and

shewed Himself alive, after His passion, by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God!  
(Acts 1:3)

### Light of the Gentiles

The purpose of that period of instruction was for Yeshuaw to enlist His disciples to go in His name and be the “light of the Gentiles” (Isaiah 42:6) that Yehovaw had wanted Him to be; and it would be by the power and guidance of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, that they would do that; He said, to them:

**Ye shall receive power, after the Holy Ghost is come upon you; and ye shall be witnesses, unto Me, in Jerusalem, in all Judaea, in Samaria and unto the uttermost part of the Earth!** (Acts 1:8)

### Chapter 3 - Spirit of Light (continued)

#### Teach All Nations

When it came time for Yehovaw to bring Yeshuaw back to Heaven, He said, through Yeshuaw, to His disciples:

**Go ... and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you.** (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

The baptism of which Yehovaw spoke through Yeshuaw was that of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence!** (Acts 1:5)

That prophecy was in fulfillment of what John the Baptist had said:

**I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance! But He Who cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear! He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire!** (Matthew 3:11)

#### Teaching and Baptism

When Yehovaw commanded through Yeshuaw His Disciples to go “**and teach all nations**” (Matthew 28:19), He immediately spoke of baptizing them; and He was speaking through Yeshuaw of that awesome baptism with ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit!

There is an important reason why Yehovaw spoke, through Yeshuaw, in the same breath, of both the teaching and the baptism: for He had given them, as His requirement for being given the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, their keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law! Yeshuaw said:

**If ye love Me, keep My Commandments! And I will pray the Father! And He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth!** (John 14:15 to 17)

Refusing to obey Yehovaw’s Great Commission to “**teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you**” (Matthew 28:19 and 20), the disciples taught only their own Jewish brethren to keep the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law, to where they could receive ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit!

### Chapter 3 - Spirit of Light (continued)

#### **Zealous of the Law**

The Apostle James told the apostle Paul:

Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are who believe; and they are all zealous of the law! (Acts 21:20)

But, having failed to grasp the importance of Yehovaw's teaching through Yeshuaw that they love their Enemies (Matthew 5:44 and 45), the disciples-become-apostles refused to include "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) in their teaching of Yeshuaw's words of "spirit" and "life"! (John 6:63)

"All nations" (Matthew 28:19) were the Gentiles! (Strong: Greek: 1484) And the Gentiles included the Romans, who had brutally crucified thousands of Jews, in their reign of terror over them; and it was unthinkable, in the hate-filled hearts of the apostles, for them to include "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) in Yehovaw's life-giving truth! (Acts 15:23)

So, when it came down to a serious conference in Jerusalem about the matter of including the "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23), they wrote instead, with defiance for Yehovaw's Great Commission through Yeshuaw (Matthew 28:19 and 20):

#### **Subverting Your Souls**

We have heard that certain who went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised and keep the law, to whom we gave no such commandment! (Acts 15:24)

As a result of that grievous departure by Yehovaw's apostles in Jerusalem, the people who were brought into the powerful truth of Yehovaw, which is based upon their being taught "to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you" (Matthew 28:20), were limited primarily to those who had been born and raised a Jew! And Yehovaw wrote about those people, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John!

Members of Faith Harvest Israel see themselves as being among the Sealed "Servants of our God" (Revelation 7:2), in whose foreheads Yehovaw the Father has written His name (Revelation 14:1), who before "the throne of God and of the Lamb ... shall serve Him and ... see His face"! (Revelation 22:3 and 4)

That confidence comes of this fellowship's knowledge concerning those amazing people seen by the apostle John in the great vision that Yehovaw gave him on the Isle of Patmos in the Mediterranean Sea some nineteen hundred years ago!

### Chapter 3 - Spirit of Light (continued)

#### **Awesome Realization**

From what Yehovaw wrote through John about the Sealed Servants, we have come to understand who and what these people are and have come to the awesome realization that you and I can be numbered among them, when we love Yehovaw and keep the commandments of His toraw or law! (Revelation 14:12)

There is much that can be learned about the Sealed Servants; but for the purpose of this study, we will focus merely upon one key attribute of them; Yehovaw wrote, of them, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John,:

Here is the patience of the saints! Here are they who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus! (Revelation 14:12)

This biblical insight was the result of study into which I was led by Yehovaw, when He had made it clear to me that His calling for me in His ministry was to be based upon these words through His prophet:

The Lord is well pleased, for His righteousness' sake; He will magnify the law and make it honorable! (Isaiah 42:21)

## Chapter 4 - Spirit of Law

### **The Major Emphasis**

As familiar as ha Kodesh Ruakh is to most of Yehovaw's children and as frequently as that mighty Spirit is chosen for the topic of sermons or of written studies, it is not likely that you will have encountered a treatment of Him that includes the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law as the major emphasis! It is an extremely important emphasis and one that has been neglected to the weakness, sorrow and pain of Yehovaw's Gentile church for two thousand years!

For in this law-based perception of our relationship to Yehovaw, the Father of all life throughout His amazing universe, lies the key to enjoying in marvelous ways the almighty power and truth of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, to bring health, wealth and eternal life to His obedient children!

### **Worthy Is the Lamb**

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

<sup>11</sup>I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand and thousands of thousands, <sup>12</sup>saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb Who was slain to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing!  
(Revelation 5:11 and 12)

Amazingly, it is by the witness of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, that we are made aware that His seven supernatural rewards to the worthy belong to the righteous among His children! He wrote, through His apostle Paul:

<sup>16</sup>The Spirit Himself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God  
<sup>17</sup>and, if children, then heirs - heirs of God and joint-heirs with Christ, if so be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together! (Romans 8:16 and 17)

### Chapter 4 - Spirit of Law (continued)

#### **Yehovaw's Requirement**

It is my heartfelt prayer that this unique insight into Yehovaw's requirement to have the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, will be sought by you, my beloved visitor, as one of the most cherished possessions in your Life! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father; and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)**

Several years ago I heard a young lady tell a Pastor, "I have not been baptized with the Holy Spirit!" Using one of the terms that she had learned while reading "Pentecostal" books on the subject, she expressed her feeling that she did not have that "infilling"!

I happened to know that lady quite well! And I was both surprised and saddened, by her sense of deprivation in relation to ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit: for at that time I knew her as a person who loved Yehovaw and who was sincerely trying to do those things that she believed are pleasing to Him.

#### **Waiting in Vain**

In answer to her question the pastor told the lady: "We will have to help you with that," which was certainly an appropriate response; but I was to wait in vain for that help to come, for the lack in that pastor's heart of any true appreciation of Yehovaw's law and commandments and their relevance to having ha Kodesh Ruakh, His "infilling" or whatever else you may wish to call it.

Still relying upon her having heard "Pentecostal" terms, the lady then wanted to know whether or not that baptism is a definite experience accompanied by "the evidence of speaking in tongues", whereupon the pastor said, "Oh, yes! You will remember the day on which it happens!"

So by his scriptural understanding and experience, this pastor expressed his belief that ha Kodesh Ruakh's most valuable contribution toward the human being is indeed this "baptism" that our Father in Heaven has promised us (Acts 1:5); and, obviously, the pastor knew that Yehovaw is the One Who gives it (John 14:15 to 17) and that ha Kodesh Ruakh manifests Himself in a way that is unmistakable to the person who is baptized (Acts 2:14 to 18) and observable by others around him or her by his or her speaking "with other tongues" and by his or her prophesying! (Acts 2:4; 10:44 to 46; 19:6)

### Chapter 4 - Spirit of Law (continued)

#### **Scriptural Phenomenon**

So this is a completely scriptural phenomenon that has been experienced by thousands upon thousands of Yehovaw's saints, undoubtedly many of them under the ministry of that particular pastor over his considerable years, whom I loved and for whom I had the greatest of admiration from the day I came to know him.

Still, I felt concern about that pastor's understanding of a person's relationship with ha Kodesh Ruakh: for my own experience with Him had not been exactly as the traditional scenario would have us expect!

When on February 7 of 1975 I was reproved by ha Kodesh Ruakh (John 16:8 to 11) and confessed "the Lord Jesus" (Romans 10:9) along with my sins (1st John 1:9), I learned what Yehovaw meant, when He wrote, through His faithful Apostle:

*If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness!* (1st John 1:9)

I sobbed like a saturated bath towel being wrung out; and, freed of my burden under Yehovaw's death and cursing upon me (Deuteronomy 30:19), I could not wait to get all that He had for any believer!

#### **Afterglow Services**

So I attended my sponsoring ministry's "Afterglow Services", in which members of the fellowship worshiped Yeshuaw, read holy scriptures about being baptized with ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, and laid hands on new members, for them to receive His "baptism"!

So I stood in line and let them lay Hands on me! But, truthfully, nothing happened!

I stood in line again during the next service and in services after that; and the loving hands were laid on me again and again! But, still, nothing happened, at least nothing of which I was aware!

Perplexed, I stayed before Yehovaw, on that matter, for many days! And, finally, He used a dear sister in our fellowship to minister to me on my receiving that baptism "by faith", without which nothing can be received from Him. (Hebrews 11:6; James 1:5 to 7)

The key to understanding the problem of receiving ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, lies in His words through Yeshuaw:

*What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them; and ye shall have them.* (Mark 11:24)

### Chapter 4 - Spirit of Law (continued)

#### **Believe Ye Receive**

I had to believe that I received that greatly desired baptism when I prayed! Then it remained for me simply to wait on ha Kodesh Ruakh to manifest to me “as he will”! (1st Corinthians 12:11)

It is not that I did not believe Yeshuaw could or would baptize a person with ha Kodesh Ruakh; His wonderful promise of the baptism was there, in Yehovaw’s word! (Acts 1:4 and 5) And I had heard various testimonies concerning it and heard tongues used in the services! The problem lay in how little I knew about the manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh and

**how much more your Heavenly Father shall give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him.** (Luke 11:13)

For me, one of the most disconcerting things about being baptized with ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit (Acts 1:5;11:16), was my expecting that upon receiving Him I would find myself speaking out automatically in an unknown language, which simply did not happen! Nothing overtook me and caused me to speak anything!

## Chapter 5 - Spirit of Utterance

### Simply Not Listening

What my dear sister in Yehovaw caused me to understand is that, from the time I had prayed to be baptized with ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, the sounds of that prayer language had been there, simply waiting for me to use them. He had faithfully given me the "utterance."! (Acts 2:4) I had simply not listened for the sounds of that utterance and spoken them.

I was looking for something extraordinary to happen, when all the time what had happened was as simple as can be! Ha Kodesh Ruakh's approach to me had been gentle, kind and not overbearing! He was simply waiting on me to avail myself of the fact that He and His manifestation of diverse tongues was there, simply waiting to be used by my moving upon them - indeed by my speaking them.

As Yeshuaw is Yehovaw the Word, we who are His body on Earth (Ephesians 5:30) must speak things too, believing and expecting them to happen at some point in time!

### Receive Any Sound

My sister told me: "By faith, receive any sound that comes to your mind and speak it, no matter how simple or foolish it may sound to you. Then speak the next sound you hear:  
for

when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place! (Acts 2:1)

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance! (Acts 2:4)

It was "they" who spoke, not ha Kodesh Ruakh! He simply provided the sounds they were to speak!

## The Person of the Holy Spirit ... know Him?

### Chapter 5 - Spirit of Utterance (continued)

#### Speaking Nonsense

Obediently, out in my car, where no one but Yehovaw could hear me, I did speak whatever sound I heard in my mind; and before long I was speaking one sound after another and coming across as fluently with words about which I had no understanding as any one else I had ever heard! (1st Corinthians 14:2)

Satan tried to tell me, “That is not the tongues of the bible!” But I was prepared for that liar’s interference; I knew that Yehovaw had said through Yeshuaw:

*Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find! Knock, and it shall be opened unto you: for every one who asketh receiveth! And he who seeketh findeth! And to him who knocketh it shall be opened!* (Luke 11:9 and 10)

*If a son shall ask bread of any of you who is a father, will he give him a stone? Or, if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or, if he ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?* (Luke 11:11 and 12)

*If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?* (Luke 11:13)

#### Expanding Knowledge

Over the Years, I began learning other things about ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit. Most importantly, He is “**the Spirit of Truth**”! (John 14:16 and 17) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

*When He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth.* (John 16:13)

In the next chapter I will give considerable attention to ha Kodesh Ruakh's role as the communicator of Yehovaw’s truth: for we, His children, desperately need the truth about Who and What He is, what He really wants from us and what He will do for us infinitely beyond what He already has done for us; He is already worthy of our praise and thanksgiving!

But before I do go into discussing such vital things, I need to point out that “truth” is a two-way street! If you and I were trying to be friends and all we talked about was the “truth” about what I am, what I want and what I will or will not do for you, I believe you will agree with me that such an arrangement would get old fast, from your point of view!

### Chapter 5 - Spirit of Utterance (continued)

#### **Commanded to Love**

You are commanded, by Yehovaw, to love me, your neighbor! (Leviticus 19:18) And finding out all the above “truth” about me would help you please me in your obedient love for me.

But I, also, am commanded to love you! And, if I am acting on that love, I must know what you are, what you want and what you will or will not do for me!

So, if you and I were serious about our relationship, we would use the medium of language to find out these “truths” about each other and then one treat the other accordingly!

So also is it between Yehovaw and His children! He has ordained ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, to guide them into all truth relating to Him! (John 16:13) But He also uses His Spirit of truth to communicate to Him the truth about us, which is an even broader interpretation of the term “**all truth**” that is normally considered to be such (John 16:13); Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the Day of Judgment!** (Matthew 12:36)

#### **Keeping the Record**

How is that possible, if there is not some one keeping a record of “**every idle word that men shall speak**”? (Matthew 12:36)

Can you imagine the record keeping that is going on in Heaven, to keep track of all words spoken by every man, woman and child on Earth over all the days during which they have been on Earth?

At one point Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, to His disciples:

**Rejoice; because your names are written in Heaven!** (Luke 10:20)

The most blessed event awaiting those whose names are written in Heaven is Yehovaw's “**Resurrection of Life**” (John 5:29), about which He wrote, through His apostle John:

<sup>16</sup>The four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshiped God, <sup>17</sup>saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, Who art and wast and art to come; because Thou hast taken, to Thee, Thy great power! (Revelation 11:16 and 17)

### Chapter 5 - Spirit of Utterance (continued)

#### **Choosing to Order**

Being the beginning and the end of “great power”, Yehovaw certainly has no need of such; but on Earth He has limited His participation in the affairs of His children to what they choose to order by the dominion He gave Adam and Eve; and, where their choice has been to love Him and keep His commandments, He has provided, for them, the powerful and enlightening manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! (John 14:15 to 17)

So, in that sense, Yehovaw's empowered and enlightened children of Israel are His “great power” on Earth, Whom He will have “**taken to**” Him (Revelation 11:17) at His “**Resurrection of Life**”! (John 5:29) Yehovaw prophesied, through Yeshuaw, through His Faithful apostle John:

Thy wrath is come and the time of the dead, that they should be judged and that Thou shouldest give reward unto Thy servants, the prophets, and to the saints and them who fear Thy name, small and great, and shouldest destroy them who destroy the Earth! (Revelation 11:18)

### Providing the Record

For Yehovaw's judgments to take place, He would have to have the record of what should be rewarded or punished, according to the works of His children, either "them who fear Thy name, small and great" or "them who destroy the Earth"! (Revelation 11:18) And Who other than ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Spirit of truth, would be likely to have provided that "truth" about the activities of His children?

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His Faithful apostle John, of His holy city, New Jerusalem:

There shall in no wise enter into it anything that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination or maketh a lie but they who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life! (Revelation 21:27)

### That Awesome Book

The other side of that awesome book we find expressed by Yehovaw, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful Apostle John:

Whosoever was not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the Lake of Fire! (Revelation 20:15)

The project suggested by these quotations is stupendous in itself! Think of the size of a book containing the name of every man, woman and child ever born on Earth in over six millennia who was or is loving Yehovaw and keeping His commandments!

Then we find that there are other books that Yehovaw keeps, which I am inclined to believe also relate to ha Kodesh Ruakh's role as the Spirit of truth: for somebody will have to have provided the "truth" contained in "the books" that will be opened at Yehovaw's "Great White Throne" Judgment! (Revelation 20:11 and 12)

### Chapter 6 - Spirit of Record (continued)

#### **Judged by the Books**

In anticipation of that tremendous event in Heaven, Yehovaw prophesied, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

The dead were judged out of those things that were written in the books, according to their works! (Revelation 20:12)

For that judgment to be possible, ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, will have had to record every act committed by every man, woman and child ever born on Earth! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

When He, the Spirit of truth, is come, He will guide you into all truth! (John 16:13)

Yeshuaw said, to His Father in Heaven:

Thy word is truth! (John 17:17)

So ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, comes to bring us the word of our Father in Heaven!

#### **Law of Truth**

Yehovaw said, through His psalmist:

Thy law is the truth (Psalm 119:142); and

all Thy commandments are truth. (Psalm 119:151)

So ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, also comes to bring us His law and commandments! To Pilate, the Roman governor who would crucify Him, Yeshuaw said:

To this end was I born and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth! Everyone who is of the truth heareth My voice! (John 18:37)

So, "rightly dividing the word of truth" (2nd Timothy 2:15), we are obliged to see that Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw to bear witness unto His law and commandments! (Psalm 119:142 and 151) And everyone who is of that law will hear His voice through ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit!

### Chapter 6 - Spirit of Record (continued)

#### Freedom in Truth

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If ye continue in My word, then are ye My disciples indeed! And ye shall know the truth! And the truth shall make you free!** (John 8:31 and 32)

If “Thy law is the truth” (Psalm 119:142) and “all Thy commandments are truth” (Verse 151), then one is obliged to see that Yehovaw’s law and all His commandments “**shall make you free**”! (John 8:32) Indeed, Yehovaw called them, through His apostle, “**the perfect law of liberty**”! (James 1:25) Yehovaw said, through Moses:

O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear Me and keep all My commandments always, that it might be well with them and with their children for ever! (Deuteronomy 5:29)

The Lord commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the Lord our God for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as it is at this day! (Deuteronomy 6:24)

#### Salvation for You

Hell certainly is not being “**free**” (John 8:31 and 32), “**well ... for ever**” (Deuteronomy 5:29), “**good always**” or preserved “**alive**”! (Deuteronomy 6:24) So, in talking about Yehovaw’s law and commandments, I am talking about His salvation for you, beloved visitor!

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, is the Agent for one’s deliverance from the bondage of his or her sin against that law (1st John 3:4) into Yehovaw’s glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, first on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5) and then in Heaven! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Behold, one came and said, unto Him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? (Matthew 19:16)

And He said, unto him ... **If thou wilt enter into Life, keep the Commandments!** (Matthew 19:17)

He saith, unto Him, Which? (Matthew 19:18)

### Chapter 6 - Spirit of Record (continued)

#### **Qualification for Life**

Yeshuaw then quoted six of Yehovaw's commandments through Moses, that there might be no mistaking which commandments He was giving as objects of a person's keeping, to enter into "eternal life" (Matthew 19:17), which is all about the salvation of a person's soul, beloved visitor; and so also is one's having the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit! (John 14:15 to 17) He told Nicodemus, through Yeshuaw:

**Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God!** (John 3:5)

Having the power and truth of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, is how His children do anything that they undertake to do; indeed, Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Without Me ye can do nothing!** (John 15:5)

Yehovaw told Nicodemus, through Yeshuaw:

**God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life!** (John 3:16)

## Chapter 7 - Spirit of Faith

### **Believing Unto Life**

The Difficulty of Yehovaw's children to believe in Him was and continues to be the core of His difficulty with them; He said, through Yeshuaw:

**This is the work of God, that ye believe on Him Whom He hath sent!** (John 6:29)

That being true, Yehovaw gave ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, to His children, that they might believe and do **"the work of God"** (John 6:29): for **"faith"** (1st Corinthians 12:9) is a **"manifestation of the Spirit"**, which **"is given to every man to profit withal"**. (Verse 7)

When by the power of His resurrection Yeshuaw returned from Death and Hell (Revelation 1:18), He appeared to His Disciples! And Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

**Then were the disciples glad!** (John 20:20)

### **Seeing is Believing**

Now the disciples were seeing, with their own eyes, what Yehovaw had told them through Yeshuaw would happen! But they had been unable to comprehend the fact of it. (John 13:7)

Yeshuaw's disciples had wanted to believe Him; and by His faith, Yeshuaw had received that level of belief, saying to His Father in Heaven:

**I have given, unto them, the words that Thou gavest Me! And they have received them and have known, surely, that I came out from Thee! And they have believed that thou didst send Me.** (John 17:8)

But, when their beloved Lord was taken, to be brutally abused and killed and when they had witnessed that terrible death, **"the doors were shut, where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews"**! (John 20:19)

### Chapter 7 - Spirit of Faith (continued)

#### No Fear in Love

But Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle:

<sup>18</sup>There is no fear in love! But perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment! He who feareth is not made perfect in love! <sup>19</sup>We love Him, because He first loved us! (1st John 4:18 and 19)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Therefore doth My Father love Me, because I lay down My life, that I might take it again! (John 10:17)

Greater Love hath No man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends! (John 15:13)

Yeshuaw's love showed itself in His permitting wicked men to kill Him, that He might, as Yehovaw's High Priest (Hebrews 2:17), make of His own body and blood (Matthew 26:26 to 28) a "sin offering" (Leviticus 16:5), to make "an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel" (Verse 17), "to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord"! (Verse 30)

#### Quickened by the Spirit

Then Yehovaw raised up Yeshuaw, from the dead; and again we see ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit at work! He wrote, through His apostle:

Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but quickened by the Spirit! (1st Peter 3:18)

Yeshuaw was "quickened", "revitalized" or "made alive" (Strong: Greek: 2227), as a gloriously resurrected man, at the sight of which "were the disciples glad"! (John 20:20)

At Yeshuaw's appearance to the disciples, the gladness of their renewed and marvelously confirmed belief in Him made it possible for them to receive Him anew! And, they knowing that truth, He had a special assignment for them; Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as My Father hath sent Me, even so send I you! And, when He had said this, He breathed on them and saith, unto them: Receive ye the Holy Ghost! (John 20:21 and 22)

### Chapter 7 - Spirit of Faith (continued)

#### **Fulfilling the Mission**

Yehovaw the Father had sent Yeshuaw to Earth to make of His own body and blood (Matthew 26:26 to 28) “**an atonement ... for all the congregation of Israel**”! (Leviticus 16:17) He fulfilled that mission (Matthew 5:17), when He prayed from the cross:

**Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do!** (Luke 23:34)

For four thousand years, Yehovaw’s forgiveness had been the object of every atonement that had ever been performed under His toraw or law, beginning with that which He had required of Cain and Abel, Adam’s and Eve’s first two sons! (Genesis 4:3 and 4)

In the commandment concerning His atonement that He gave the children of Israel, He said, through Moses:

**It shall be forgiven him.** (Numbers 15:28)

So the minute Yeshuaw prayed for Yehovaw to forgive the children of Israel, He transformed what had been the worst violence to Yehovaw’s justice that had ever been committed on Earth into the most amazing atonement ever performed among the children of Israel!

#### **Receiving the Atonement**

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

**We joy in God, through our Lord Jesus Christ, by Whom we have now received the atonement!** (Romans 5:11)

Fulfilling that atonement had been the purpose for which Yehovaw had sent Yeshuaw (John 20:21); and now He was telling His disciples that they, too, were to function as His priests, to go forth and make atonements for others, which is why He had

**breathed, on them, and saith, unto them, Receive ye the Holy Ghost!** (John 20:22)

Yeshuaw was ordaining His disciples to function as priests (Exodus 19:6; Hosea 4:6; Revelation 5:9 and 10), which under Yehovaw’s First Covenant with the children of Israel had always required that they be anointed with olive oil, signifying their being empowered by ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, to function in that office!

#### **The High Priest**

In making an atonement of His own body and blood (Matthew 26:26 to 28) “for all the congregation of Israel” (Leviticus 16:17), Yeshuaw had functioned as Yehovaw the Father’s High Priest (Hebrews 2:17), “to cleanse you, that ye may be clean from all your sins before the Lord”! (Verse 30)

Yeshuaw had told His disciples, concerning His blood, that it was

of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins! (Matthew 26:28)

Yehovaw’s commandment concerning the Day of Atonement, included telling the children of Israel what they must do to make the High Priest’s atonement for them effective! Yehovaw said, through Moses:

Ye shall afflict your souls! (Leviticus 16:31)

Then, when Yeshuaw had as His High Priest made His atonement on the cross (Romans 5:11), Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle, to let His Children know how they were to afflict their souls and make Yeshuaw’s atonement effective for them:

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness! (1st John 1:9)

### **Their Own Atonements**

Now Yehovaw's disciples were to go forth, under the power of ha Kodesh Ruakh (John 20:22; Acts 1:8), and encourage, by their own atonements in forgiving their enemies (Matthew 6:14), those who had hurt them in any way (Matthew 16:24), the hope's being that the enemies will afflict their souls (Leviticus 16:31), by repenting of their sins and confessing them (1st John 1:9), to enjoy the same forgiveness and cleansing "from all unrighteousness"! (Verse 9) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow His steps! (1st Peter 2:21)

The disciples were to follow Yeshuaw's example (Luke 23:34) by forgiving their enemies! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

If ye forgive men their trespasses, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you!  
(Matthew 6:14)

### **Mandatory Forgiveness**

Forgiving others is not an option! That was Yehovaw's second requirement for Yeshuaw's atonement to be effective for the one who wanted to be restored to his or her place in Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power, which again is a manifestation of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! He said, through Yeshuaw:

If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.  
(Matthew 12:28)

Casting out devils is one of ha Kodesh Ruakh's supernatural manifestations! (Matthew 12:28) And Yehovaw has made it clear, through Yeshuaw, that where His Spirit is functioning, that is evidence of where His kingdom is!

### Chapter 8 - Spirit of Atonement (continued)

#### Being Righteous

Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle, that the object of confessing our sins is for Him “**to cleanse us from all unrighteousness**”! (1st John 1:9) Another way of saying that is to speak of one’s being made righteous! Yehovaw wrote, through His Author:

**By faith Abel offered, unto God, a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous!** (Hebrews 11:4)

Abel having done what Yehovaw told him to do, Yehovaw was pleased and bore witness, by ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, that Abel was righteous! In turn, that restored Abel to his place in Yehovaw’s glorious and eternal kingdom on Earth! (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven!** (Matthew 5:20)

**Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God!** (John 3:5)

#### Born of the Spirit

From the holy scriptures we have been looking at, one can see that his or her being “**born of water and of the Spirit**”(John 3:5) is comparable to Yehovaw’s bearing witness through ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, that he or she is “**righteous**” (Hebrews 11:4) by Having Participated in Yehovaw’s Atonement!

Since the object of Yehovaw’s atonement through Yeshuaw on the cross was to get His children to confess their sins (1st John 1:9) and since “**sin is the transgression of the law**” (1st John 3:4), we are not surprised to learn that righteousness relates as well to one’s keeping or putting the highest possible value on all the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law! He said, through Moses:

**It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us.** (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Yehovaw gave, through Moses, the only definition for “**our righteousness**” (Deuteronomy 6:25) that can be found anywhere in His Holy Bible! And “**righteousness**” is one’s key to entering Yehovaw’s “**kingdom of Heaven**” (Matthew 5:20), which comes of participating in Yehovaw’s atonement! (Hebrews 11:4; 1st John 1:9)

Chapter 8 - Spirit of Atonement (continued)

**From Atonement to the Law**

So one is obliged to conclude that the purpose of Yehovaw's atonement is to affect His children's thinking in regard to keeping or putting the highest possible value on doing "all these commandments before the Lord our God"! (Deuteronomy 6:25)

One's thinking is affected by what he or she believes to be true; and that is again the sole province of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, since He is His "Spirit of truth"! (John 16:13)

With that necessity in mind it is possible for one to understand why Yeshuaw prayed, to Yehovaw the Father, concerning His forthcoming atonement on the cross:

**Sanctify them through Thy truth! Thy word is truth!** (John 17:17)

Yehovaw wrote, through His psalmist:

**Thy law is the truth** (Psalm 119:142); and

**all Thy commandments are truth.** (Psalm 119:151)

So, when Yehovaw spoke through Yeshuaw of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit's being "the Spirit of truth" (John 16:13), one can see that He is establishing His Spirit as being the Spirit of His law and commandments! (Psalm 119:142 and 151)

**Sanctifying Truth**

So, when Yeshuaw continued His final prayer to Yehovaw the Father, we find Him saying, concerning His forthcoming atonement on the cross:

**For their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth!** (John 17:19)

Conveying a truth is what Yehovaw had always intended that His atonement do - specifically, the truth of His suffering and death in the sinning of His children! So it is not possible that His atonement be fulfilled without the functioning of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His "Spirit of truth"! (John 16:13)

One must know what the truth of Yehovaw's atonement is to understand why thousands of lambs were sacrificed over hundreds of years and finally Yeshuaw, Yehovaw's "only begotten Son"! (John 3:16) And the reason we must seek that understanding lies within the nature of sin, which "is the transgression of the law"! (1st John 3:4)

### Chapter 8 - Spirit of Atonement (continued)

#### **Violation of Law**

“Transgression” is the King James translation of a word meaning “illegality”, “violation of law” or “wickedness”! (Strong: Greek: 458) Yehovaw said, through Moses:

The Lord commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the Lord our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as it is at this day! (Deuteronomy 6:24)

One’s breaking a commandment of Yehovaw’s toraw or law is his or her breaking of Yehovaw’s goodness; it is hurting a neighbor, whom He commanded His children to love, (Leviticus 19:18), which is “**like unto**” (Matthew 22:39) His “**First and Great Commandment**” (Verse 38), which is to love Him! (Verse 37)

So one’s sinning causes two painful things to happen: first, it hurts the neighbor; and, secondly, Yehovaw is forced to remove the sinner from His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! He said, to Adam:

Of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die! (Genesis 2:17)

### **Spiritual Death**

Yehovaw's record of early generations tells us that Adam was nine hundred thirty years old when he died (Genesis 5:5), showing us that Yehovaw had to be referring to the spiritual death of separation from His kingdom, when He was warning Adam that disobeying Him would cause him to "die"! (Genesis 2:17)

In sinning one hurts a Neighbor! And the sinner dies spiritually, by Yehovaw's separating him or her from His kingdom on Earth! (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21; John 3:5)

Furthermore, since ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, is in both the neighbor and the sinner, He immediately communicates, to Yehovaw, the pain of the neighbor's hurt and the death of the sinner's separation, with each sin ever committed by any one of His children! So, when any sin is committed, Yehovaw suffers right along with the hurt neighbor and feels the spiritual death of the sinner, neither of which are acceptable experiences for Him, Who is righteously innocent!

### **From Life to Death**

For a child to be apart from Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power is to be in His world of death and cursing! (Deuteronomy 30:19) And for a child to remain in that terrible separation until Yehovaw's patience runs out and he or she dies brings him or her into "Hell" for a Thousand Years (Psalm 88: Luke 16:23; Revelation 20:5) followed by an eternity in His "Lake of Fire" (Revelation 20:15), which is an appalling prospect to be avoided at all costs!

If that eventuality seems unfair, to you, you will have to take it up with Yehovaw! I did not write the Bible; I only teach it; Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**It is not the will of your Father Who is in Heaven that one of these little ones should perish!** (Matthew 18:14)

### Chapter 9 - Spirit of Communication (continued)

#### Thinking Differently

Yehovaw had to do something to restore His Children to their places in His kingdom, which He was willing to do, if they would repent or “think differently” (Strong: Greek: 3340) about having sinned or transgressed His law! (1st John 3:4) He said, through Yeshuaw:

**Repent! For the kingdom of Heaven is at hand!** (Matthew 4:17)

**I am not come to call the righteous but sinners to repentance!** (Matthew 9:13)

Beginning with Cain and Abel, the first two sons of Adam and Eve, Yehovaw offered His children a way by which to be restored to their place in His kingdom, which they had lost whenever they had sinned!

Receiving new information about something is what causes anyone to repent or “think differently” about it (Strong: Greek: 3340); and the information that a sinner usually lacks is the seriousness of the repercussions that his or her sin brings!

Hurting the neighbor brings that hurt upon Yehovaw, which He returns upon the sinner! (Luke 6:38; Galatians 6:7)

#### He feels our Death

Separation from Yehovaw’s kingdom brings upon the sinner the death and cursing of Yehovaw’s world, which Yehovaw feels right along with the spiritually dead and cursed child! (Deuteronomy 30:19)

For four thousand years the suffering and death of a lamb was the way Yehovaw established by which to dramatize the suffering and death of sin - the neighbor’s hurt and Yehovaw’s, the sinner’s spiritual death and Yehovaw’s along with him or her!

So, if an Israelite would bring a lamb to a priest, who would cut its throat and cause it to bleed to death in the presence of the sinner, Yehovaw was satisfied, for the time being, that sufficient awareness of the complications of sin had been communicated to the sinner; and “**it shall be forgiven him**” (Numbers 15:28) and his family!

Yehovaw’s suffering and death in the sinning of His children against Him was the truth of the atonement, which was to be communicated by ha Kodesh Ruakh, His “**Spirit of truth**”! (John 16:13) Yeshuaw told Pilate, the Roman governor who was about to order His crucifixion:

**To this end was I born and for this cause came I into the world that I should bear witness unto the truth!** (John 18:37)

### Chapter 9 - Spirit of Communication (continued)

#### **That Same Word**

Then the disciples, to whom that truth had been conveyed by ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, were to go forth and cause that same word to be communicated by the same Spirit to their enemies, when they forgave the enemies of their trespasses against them.

Yehovaw's giving ha Kodesh Ruakh through Yeshuaw to His disciples at the time of Yeshuaw's appearing to them and then empowering them later by that same Spirit, on the Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:2 to 4), is why Pentecostal theologians insist that receiving ha Kodesh Ruakh at the time of a person's salvation in Yehovaw is one thing, while receiving Him at a time of specifically seeking Him is quite something else!

Such teachers rightly insist that without Yehovaw's Holy Spirit working in a person's life, he or she cannot be a bold, gifted, "Spirit-filled" witness for Yehovaw **"unto the uttermost part of the Earth"**! (Acts 1:8) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Without Me ye can do nothing!** (John 15:5)

#### **Showing the Power**

What Yeshuaw does with respect to a child of Yehovaw is to manifest or show some power of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! He said:

**He who hath My commandments and keepeth them, he it is who loveth Me; and he who loveth Me shall be loved of My Father! And I will love him and will manifest Myself to him.** (John 14:21)

One must not miss the purpose of Yeshuaw's special anointing of the disciples as He was sending them forth **"as My Father hath sent Me"** (John 20:21) to forgive the sins of their enemies! Yehovaw said, through Him:

**Whose soever sins ye Remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained!** (John 20:23)

That clarification of the disciples' conduct toward their enemies was a confirmation of what Yehovaw had said earlier through Yeshuaw:

**I will give, unto thee, the keys of the kingdom of Heaven! Whatsoever thou shalt bind on Earth shall be bound in Heaven! And whatsoever thou shalt loose on Earth shall be loosed in Heaven!** (Matthew 16:19)

### Chapter 9 - Spirit of Communication (continued)

#### **Loosing and Forgiving**

The Word “loosed” is clarified in Yehovaw’s story through Yeshuaw of the highly indebted servant who repented for not paying his debt, whereupon His King

**was moved with compassion and loosed him and forgave him the debt.** (Matthew 18:27)

The Judgment of Actions that Yehovaw administers according to the works of His children in the light of His perfect justice (Luke 6:38; Galatians 6:7) come without their being sought by any child; but His Judgment of Intent, which is above and beyond His Judgment of Actions, must be specifically sought and prayed for; or it simply will not happen!

So gentle, considerate and loving is our mighty Lord God that He absolutely will not intrude upon the affairs of His children without their permission!

What happens, then, when one prays for something and it does not happen?

### Wait for the Promise

Now enters in the factor of Yehovaw's timing of things; why did Yeshuaw command His Disciples

that they should not depart from Jerusalem but wait for the promise of the Father  
(Acts 1:4) ?

Yehovaw was waiting for a certain feast of His to take place, so that His empowering of the disciples could take place according to His meticulous timing and will! "The Day of Pentecost" (Acts 2:1), on which this mighty first baptism took place historically was actually Yehovaw's "Feast of Weeks"! (Exodus 34:22; Leviticus 23:15 to 21)

In the Greek, "Pentecost" means "fiftieth" (Strong: Greek: 4005), which by Yehovaw's commandment was the number of days Following a previous feast that would determine the time of His Feast of Weeks!

### Feast of Weeks

The historical precedent for Yehovaw's Feast of Weeks was the day on which Yehovaw spoke His Ten Commandments to the children of Israel from Mount Sinai, which took place exactly fifty days from the day on which they had climbed the bank of the Red Sea after crossing over on dry ground, only to see that body of water close over their Egyptian enemies and remove for ever their hold on the life and experience of Yehovaw's children! (Exodus 14)

An extremely powerful parallel to the high experience of hearing Yehovaw's voice from Mount Sinai came to pass in Jerusalem, when Yehovaw's obedient disciples "were all with one accord in one place"! (Acts 2:1)

Chapter 10 - Spirit of Timing (continued)

**A Rushing Mighty Wind**

Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Luke:

<sup>2</sup>Suddenly there came a sound from Heaven as of a rushing mighty wind! And it filled all the house where they were sitting! <sup>3</sup>And there appeared, unto them, cloven tongues like as of fire; and it sat upon each of them. <sup>4</sup>And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance! (Acts 2:2 to 4)

Indeed, the children of Israel were hearing Yehovaw's voice again, as a special climactic event! Likewise, in your own walk with Yehovaw, it will be His precise timing that will determine ha Kodesh Ruakh's manifestations in your behalf or in behalf of His community through you.

When by the impact of Yeshuaw's gospel upon you the moment comes when you are glad for His salvation in your behalf (John 20:20; 1st John 1:9), loving Him and keeping His commandments (John 14:15 to 17), He will breathe on you, saying,

**Receive ye the Holy Ghost!** (John 20:22)

**Manifestation and Judgment**

But, as with the disciples, that receiving of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, may or may not be accompanied by any special manifestation (1st Corinthians 12:7 to 11), according to Yehovaw's judgment upon you at that time! But, as the days go by and as you obey His commandments and you pay your debt to Him, that judgment will change! Yehovaw invited, through His prophet:

**Come and let us return unto the Lord! For He hath torn, and He will heal us; He hath smitten, and He will bind us up!** (Hosea 6:1)

Yehovaw has commanded us, through His psalmist:

**Let the redeemed of the Lord say so.** (Psalm 107:1)

Whatever may be the timing of ha Kodesh Ruakh's manifestations in your behalf, from Day One of understanding and following this truth of Yehovaw, speak your privileges in Him, on the authority of His promises, as He wrote through His psalmist:

<sup>19</sup>They cry, unto the Lord, in their trouble; and He saveth them out of their distresses! <sup>20</sup>He sent His word and healed them and delivered them from their destructions! (Psalms 107:19 and 20)

### Chapter 10 - Spirit of Timing (continued)

#### **Redeemed but Troubled**

Through His psalmist, Yehovaw is here talking about "the redeemed of the Lord"! (Psalm 107:2) Still, they have "trouble ... distresses" and "destructions" (Verses 19 and 20), all of which relate to His Judgment of Actions and Intent! (Deuteronomy 28:15 to 68)

Through His psalmist, Yehovaw spoke about Yeshuaw as ha Mawshiyakh or "David, My Servant" (Psalm 89:20), Whom He had anointed "with My holy oil" (Verse 20):

<sup>30</sup>If His children forsake My law and walk not in My judgments, <sup>31</sup>if they break My statutes and keep not My commandments, <sup>32</sup>then will I visit their transgression with the rod and their iniquity with stripes! (Psalm 89:30 to 32)

Nevertheless My lovingkindness will I not utterly take from Him nor suffer My faithfulness to fail! (Psalm 89:33)

In that passage Yehovaw speaks of His children as being "His children" (Psalm 89:30) or those of Yeshuaw or "David, My Servant" (Verse 20), the simple reason being that they are the children "of Israel"! (Genesis 46:8)

#### **Ruling as God**

Yehovaw renamed Jacob, the Son of Isaac, the Son of Abraham, giving him the name "Israel" (Genesis 32:28), which means "He will rule as God"! (Strong: Hebrew: 3478)

So Jacob's twelve sons then became known as "the children of Israel" (Genesis 46:8) or the children of Him Who will rule as God! But the only Person in the universe Who has ever qualified to be any such thing is Yeshuaw, Whom the apostle John saw in Heaven on the throne in the form of "a Lamb as it had been slain"! (Revelation 5:6) Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John, of "the holy city, New Jerusalem" (Revelation 21:2):

There shall in no wise enter into it anything that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination or maketh a lie but they who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life! (Revelation 21:27)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, to His disciples:

**Rejoice; because your names are written in Heaven!** (Luke 10:20)

### Chapter 10 - Spirit of Timing (continued)

#### **The Lake of Fire**

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

Whosoever was not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the Lake of Fire! (Revelation 20:15)

The names of Yeshuaw's "children" (Psalm 89:30) are written in His "Book of Life"! (Revelation 20:15) And the only Person in the universe capable of keeping track of any such awesome record is ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's "Spirit of truth"! (John 16:13) For it is Yehovaw's truth that you and I are either His children or not, with a name written in that book or not!

All persons born on Earth are Yehovaw's children in the sense of His having *created* them; and by default we start out in life being "one of these little ones who believe in Me", Yeshuaw said (Matthew 18:6): for

in Heaven their Angels do always behold the face of My Father Who is in Heaven!  
(Matthew 18:10)

Yehovaw wrote, through His psalmist:

Thou didst make me hope, when I was upon my mother's breasts! (Psalm 22:9)

Thou art my God from my mother's belly! (Psalm 22:10)

## Chapter 11 - Spirit of Allegiance

### Citizenship

One can be born in a Land and by default be a citizen of that land; but he or she can decide to give his or her allegiance to another land, in which case that person's original citizenship ceases to exist! And that is exactly what happens when Yehovaw's children sin!

“Sin is transgression of the law!” (1st John 3:4) It is one's breaking of Yehovaw's commandments and at the same time obeying or giving allegiance to Satan rather than to Yehovaw, for which terrible desertion Yehovaw removes the sinner from His kingdom, by removing his or her name from “the Lamb's Book of Life”! (Revelation 21:27)

There is only one man born upon Earth capable of filling the role of “Israel” or of Him Who “will rule as God”! (Strong: Hebrew: 3478) Being “the Son of man” (Mark 2:10), Yeshuaw will rule “as” God and rightly so: for at the same time He is God, being Yehovaw “the Word” (John 1:1), Who “in the beginning ... was with God and ... was God”. (Verse 1)

### Faith-Driven Cries

Crying out to Yehovaw on the basis of His promises (Psalm 107:2 and 19) is “faith” (Mark 11:22), which Yeshuaw said is a “weightier matter of the law”! (Matthew 23:23) He wrote, through His author:

Without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he who cometh to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of them who diligently seek Him.  
(Hebrews 11:6)

But it helps immensely, if one knows the commandments to which all of Yehovaw's promises are attached!

### Chapter 11 - Spirit of Allegiance (continued)

#### **Refusal for the Refusers**

Yehovaw has promised for those “**who refused to hear My words**” (Jeremiah 11:10):

**I will not hearken unto them!** (Jeremiah 11:11)

Up to this point I have been showing you the condition upon which ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, will “come” or supernaturally manifest for anyone (John 14:15 to 17) and some of the ways in which He does that. (1st Corinthians 12:7 to 11) Now I must give you the reason why He does these amazing things for Yehovaw’s children or what Yehovaw has wanted to accomplish in having Him do it: for, if we miss that truth, Yehovaw will know it and refuse to grant us more of His power! He said, through Yeshuaw:

**Ye shall receive power, after the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me, in Jerusalem, in all Judaea, in Samaria and unto the uttermost part of the Earth!** (Acts 1:8)

After teaching His disciples through the risen Yeshuaw for forty days “**and speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God**” (Acts 1:3), He was about to receive Yeshuaw back with Him on His right hand in glory! But before He did that, Yehovaw repeated His theme of their being His witnesses!

#### **Teach All Nations**

Yehovaw commanded His disciples, through Yeshuaw:

**Go ... and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost and teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you.** (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

No person can do any such thing without the power and truth of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, which is why Yeshuaw Himself came, “**from Galilee, to Jordan, unto John, to be baptized of him**” (Matthew 3:13), saying, to John the Baptist:

**Suffer it to be so now! For thus it becometh us to fulfill all righteousness!**  
(Matthew 3:15)

## The Person of the Holy Spirit ... know Him?

### Chapter 11 - Spirit of Allegiance (continued)

#### **Our Righteousness**

Yehovaw had commanded Yeshuaw to go and be baptized by John in the River Jordan! And Yehovaw had said, through Moses:

*It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)*

The result of Yeshuaw's having been sufficiently obedient to humble Himself before John the Baptist and all of John's followers and all the witnesses in Heaven was for His Father in Heaven to honor Him, saying:

*This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased! (Matthew 3:17)*

Yeshuaw said:

*The Father hath not left Me alone! For I do always those things that please Him. (John 8:29)*

Another important result of Yeshuaw's obedience to Yehovaw was that

*the Heavens were opened, unto Him; and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove lighting upon Him. (John 8:16)*

#### **Sharing the Same Privilege**

We are delighted to observe this sensitive interplay between Yehovaw and His beloved Son Yeshuaw and ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit; because Yehovaw promised, through Yeshuaw, to do exactly the same thing for any person who, coming to love Him, would obey Him; Yeshuaw said:

*If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father; and He shall give you another comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)*

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Spirit of power and truth is part of Yehovaw's mercy, which He shows "to thousands of them who love Me and keep My commandments"! (Exodus 20:6) It is the reason why Yeshuaw laid down "His life for His friends", who are those who do whatever He commands them to do. (John 15:13 and 14) Yehovaw's precious Comforter is the "Power from on High" Whom He sends upon His disciples as His "promise"! (Genesis 22:16 to 18; Luke 24:49)

#### **Comforting Power**

Bestowing that comforting power upon His children is Yehovaw's way of healing the children of Israel and delivering them “**from their destructions**” (Psalm 107:20), whenever, as Yeshuaw does, they speak His word! Ha Kodesh Ruakh is Yehovaw's way of manifesting to His children; Yeshuaw said:

**He who Hath My commandments and keepeth them, he it is who loveth Me; and he who loveth Me shall be loved of My Father! And I will love him and will manifest Myself to him. (John 14:21)**

Yeshuaw said:

**If ye keep My commandments, ye shall abide in My love, even as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love. (John 15:10)**

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul, of Yeshuaw:

**He made Himself of no reputation and took upon Him the form of a servant and was made in the likeness of men! (Philippians 2:7)**

Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle, of Yeshuaw:

**In the beginning was the Word! And the Word was with God; and the Word was God. (John 1:1)**

### The Word Made Flesh

The Word was made flesh and dwelt among us; and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth! (John 1:14)

When Yeshuaw submitted Himself to John for baptism in the Jordan River, Yehovaw most certainly manifested Himself to Yeshuaw at that time! He wrote, through His apostle:

Then was Jesus led up, of the Spirit, into the wilderness, to be tempted of the Devil! (Matthew 4:1)

Yeshuaw overcame Satan, in that encounter, declaring:

Man shall not live by bread alone but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God! (Matthew 4:4)

### Power of the Spirit

So, after Yeshuaw's wilderness experience, Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

<sup>14</sup>Jesus returned, in the power of the Spirit, into Galilee! And there went out a fame of Him through all the region round about! <sup>15</sup>And He taught, in their synagogues, being glorified of all! (Luke 4:14 and 15)

Yehovaw then described, through His apostle, how Yeshuaw

<sup>16</sup>came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up: and, as His custom was, He went into the synagogue, on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read! <sup>17</sup>And there was delivered, unto Him, the book of the prophet Esaias! (Luke 4:16 and 17)

## The Person of the Holy Spirit ... know Him?

### Chapter 12 - Spirit of Guidance (continued)

#### **The Spirit upon Him**

And, when Jesus had opened the book, He found the place where it was written, The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; because He hath anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor! He hath sent Me to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are bruised, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord! (Luke 4:17 ro 19)

That is what ha Kodesh Ruakh's empowering is all about!

The citizens of Nazareth, with most of whom Yeshuaw had grown up, were all amazed, when Yehovaw then said, through Yeshuaw:

This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears! (Luke 4:21)

When He had risen from the dead, Yeshuaw “breathed” on His Disciples, “and saith, unto them,

Receive ye the Holy Ghost! (John 20:22)

By what Yeshuaw said next, one can understand that He was consecrating His disciples to go forth and be priests in His name!

#### **Remitting Sins**

Yeshuaw said, to His disciples:

Whose soever sins ye remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained! (John 20:23)

Yeshuaw's praying that Yehovaw the Father forgive “all the congregation of Israel” (Leviticus 16:17; Luke 23:34) fulfilled His role as Yehovaw's High Priest! (Hebrews 2:17) His disciples' praying that He forgive their enemies would possibly, by the reproof of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, bring to the enemies the same perfection of conscience (Hebrews 9:9 and 14) that Yeshuaw's atonement had brought to the disciples! Yeshuaw said:

It is expedient for you that I go away! For, if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but, if I depart, I will send Him unto you. (John 16:7)

And, when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, of righteousness and of judgment! (John 16:8)

## The Person of the Holy Spirit ... know Him?

### Chapter 12 - Spirit of Guidance (continued)

#### **Reproving the World**

Yeshuaw then explained each of those things that He said “**the Comforter**” (John 16:7) would do! He would

**reprove the world of sin, because they believe not on Me** (John 16:8 and 9);

**of righteousness, because I go to My Father, and ye see Me no more** (John 16:10);

**of judgment; because the prince of this world is judged!** (John 16:11)

Possibly the atoning forgiveness of the disciples would make friends of the enemies (John 15:14), who would then go forth and find new enemies to forgive; and Yehovaw’s word through His apostle Paul would be fulfilled:

**Hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad, in our hearts, by the Holy Ghost, Who is given unto us.** (Romans 5:5)

Yeshuaw consecrated His disciples to forgive sins (John 20:21 to 23), which He did by ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit! Fifty days later, they “**were all with one accord in one place**” (Acts 2:1), when Yehovaw’s promised empowerment for that mission of mercy came!

#### **They were All Filled**

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

**<sup>2</sup>Suddenly there came a sound from Heaven as of a rushing mighty wind! And it filled all the house where they were sitting! <sup>3</sup>And there appeared, unto them, cloven tongues like as of fire; and it sat upon each of them. <sup>4</sup>And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance!** (Acts 2:2 to 4)

The manifestation of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw’s Holy Spirit, on the Day of Pentecost had nothing to do with His presence with or absence from the disciples! Without His keeping our hearts beating, none of us would even be alive! It had to be Yehovaw’s timing of things in relation to His feasts that determined the occasion for that particular manifestation!

#### **Joel's Prophecy**

To explain ha Kodesh Ruakh's manifestation on Pentecost, the apostle Peter told the people of Jerusalem:

<sup>16</sup>This is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel: <sup>17</sup>It shall come to pass, in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of My Spirit upon all flesh! And your sons and your daughters shall prophesy; your young men shall see visions; and your old men shall dream dreams! <sup>18</sup>And on My servants and on My handmaidens I will pour out, in those days of My Spirit; and they shall prophesy! (Acts 2:16 to 18)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw that ha Kodesh Ruakh is “**the Spirit of truth**” (John 14:17); and He said, through His psalmist:

Thy law is the truth (Psalm 119:142); and

all Thy commandments are the truth. (Psalm 119:151)

## Chapter 13 - Spirit of Power

### Empowered by the Spirit

When Yeshuaw was given His empowerment by Yehovaw's wonderful Spirit of truth about the heart of His desire for His children (Matthew 3:16; 18:14), He obeyed the toraw or law of His Father in Heaven! He magnified it and made it honorable! Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet:

The Lord is well pleased, for His righteousness' sake; He will magnify the law and make it honorable! (Isaiah 42:21)

Before He brought Yeshuaw back up to sit on His Throne, Yehovaw commanded His Disciples through Yeshuaw:

Go ... and teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

### Short Lived Devotion

When Yeshuaw's apostles received their baptism with Yehovaw's marvelous Spirit of truth (John 16:13) concerning Yehovaw's law and commandments (Psalm 119:142 and 151), their devotion to sharing it with "all nations" (Matthew 28:19) lasted only a few years, until the apostle Paul's ministry had got underway, when under his heavy persuasion they wrote, to "the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23):

We have heard that certain who went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised and keep the law, to whom we gave no such commandment! (Acts 15:24)

Then they proceeded to reduce, for the Gentiles, all six hundred thirteen of Yehovaw's commandments through Moses to four rules abstracted from Yehovaw's toraw or law! (Acts 15:28 and 29)

Chapter 13 - Spirit of Power (continued)

**Apostles in Defiance**

So the apostles in Jerusalem were in defiance both of Yehovaw's last commandment through Yeshuaw (Matthew 28:19 and 20) and of His commandment wherein He said through Moses:

Ye shall not add unto the word that I command you; neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you. (Deuteronomy 4:2)

It is an amazing thing that the apostles in Jerusalem did, in their conference with Paul and Barnabas, concerning the Gentile household of Cornelius! Peter declared:

<sup>8</sup>God, Who knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as He did unto us, <sup>9</sup>and put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith! (Acts 15:8 and 9)

Yet the apostles in Jerusalem immediately proceeded to put a vast difference "between us and them" (Acts 15:9), by stripping from "the brethren who are among the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23) the everlasting life Yehovaw promised those who keep His commandments!

**It is your Life!**

Yehovaw said, through Moses:

<sup>46</sup>Set your hearts unto all the words that I testify among you this day, which ye shall command your children to observe to do, all the words of this law! <sup>47</sup>For it is not a vain thing for you; because it is your life! (Deuteronomy 32:46 and 47)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments!** (Matthew 19:17)

**The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat; all therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do!** (Matthew 23:2 and 3)

Yehovaw had made keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law His requirement for receiving ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit (John 14:15 to 17), Who is the Creator and Sustainer of His Life (Matthew 19:17) as well as the Communicator of His truth! (John 16:13)

### Chapter 13 - Spirit of Power (continued)

#### **Infamous Letter**

So, in their infamous letter to the Gentiles (Acts 15:24), the apostles in Jerusalem effectively robbed them of ever having ha Kodesh Ruakh manifest powerfully and truthfully in their behalf! And one wonders why the Gentile church has been in spiritual confusion, poverty and affliction ever since!

If the apostles themselves had abandoned Yehovaw's toraw or law as useless under the New Covenant, which would have been an apostasy (Jeremiah 31:31 to 33), at least they would have been consistent in their handling of the Gentiles: for, when Peter had his head screwed on right, Yehovaw said, through him:

<sup>34</sup>God is no respecter of persons! <sup>35</sup>But in every nation he who feareth Him and worketh righteousness is accepted with Him. (Acts 10:34 and 35)

No prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation! (2nd Peter 1:20)

As it is, the apostle James told the apostle Paul:

Thou seest, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are who believe! And they are all zealous of the law! (Acts 21:20)

#### **Paul's Forsaking Moses**

And they are informed of thee, that thou teachest all the Jews who are among the Gentiles to forsake Moses, saying that they ought not to circumcise their children, neither to walk after the customs! (Acts 21:21)

What is it therefore? The multitude must needs come together: for they will hear that thou art come! (Acts 21:22)

<sup>23</sup>Do therefore this that we say to thee: We have four men who have a vow on them. <sup>24</sup>Them take and purify thyself with them and be at charges with them, that they may shave their heads: and all may know that those things, whereof they were informed concerning thee are nothing but that thou thyself also walkest orderly and keepest the law! (Acts 21:23 and 24)

As touching the Gentiles who believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, from blood, from strangled and from fornication! (Acts 21:25)

Having abandoned the remainder of Yehovaw's toraw or law, why bother with any of that?

### Chapter 13 - Spirit of Power (continued)

#### **By What Authority?**

The four rules that the apostles imposed upon the Gentile believers they got from Yehovaw's toraw or law! By what authority did they pick and choose from among Yehovaw's six hundred thirteen commandments for them, to come up with this simplistic and false approach to the Gentile believer's welfare under Yehovaw?

Was Yehovaw to be one Lord God for the Jews and another for the Gentiles? He said, through Moses:

One law shall be to him who is homeborn and unto the stranger who sojourneth among you. (Exodus 12:49)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Other sheep I have, who are not of this fold! Them also I must bring! And they shall hear My voice! And there shall be one fold and one Shepherd! (John 10:16)

Paul had no vow on him that Yehovaw's scripture records. If he did, why did the apostle James have to tell Paul to "be at charges" (Acts 21:23 and 24) with those who did?

### Mocking the Toraw

If Paul did not have a vow on him, what sense was there in the apostle James telling Paul to misrepresent himself before the Jews, in the service of their Lord God of truth? (John 14:6)

In effect, James was telling Paul to make a mockery of Yehovaw's commandment concerning the sacred vow of the Nazarite! (Numbers 6:2) And the purpose of that exercise in futility was to make a mockery of what Paul had chosen to teach the Jews among the Gentiles! For at no time did Paul ever deny James's accusation of his dishonoring Yehovaw's toraw or law among them.

The astounding thing is, that with all the fuss being made to preserve Paul's spiritual integrity before his Jewish brethren, it seemed nothing to James that in regard to the Gentiles the apostles had "written and concluded that they observe no such thing"! (Acts 21:25)

### No Greater Burden

What reason did the apostles ever give for denying the Gentiles the blessings of keeping Yehovaw's toraw or law?

The apostles in Jerusalem wrote, "to the brethren who are of the Gentiles" (Acts 15:23):

*It seemed good to the Holy Ghost and to us to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things! (Acts 15:28)*

Astoundingly, that statement implied that by the Word of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's "Holy Ghost" (Acts 15:28), all the other commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law were not necessary! Have you ever had someone tell you "God told me to do this" and then violate you within an inch of your Life? The apostle Paul wrote:

*Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light! (2nd Corinthians 11:14)*

## The Person of the Holy Spirit ... know Him?

### Chapter 14 - Spirit of Judgment (continued)

#### **Paul was on his Own**

Would Yehovaw back Paul up, in his despicable charade?

Yehovaw would not; and He did not: Paul's attempt to enter the temple under the pretense of being a Nazarite turned out to be a fiasco! (Acts 21:27 to 33) It led into years of captivity under the Romans, for Paul, and ultimately to a violent death, along with Peter and the other apostles who had dared to raise their voices in contempt for Yehovaw's law of truth! (Psalm 119:142 and 151)

In the meanwhile, the entire Roman empire could not kill Yehovaw's faithful apostle John, who participated in none of the other apostles' mischief with the Gentiles, John's writings having consistently honored Yehovaw's law and commandments! Yehovaw commanded, through His recorder:

<sup>15</sup>Be ye mindful always of His covenant, the word that He commanded to a thousand generations, <sup>16</sup>even of the covenant that He made with Abraham and of His oath unto Isaac <sup>17</sup>and hath confirmed the same to Jacob, for a law, and to Israel, for an everlasting covenant! (1st Chronicles 16:15 to 17)

#### **One of the Curses**

What happened to the apostle Paul and his associates in rebellion is one of Yehovaw's curses on those who do not

hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all His commandments! (Deuteronomy 28:15)

<sup>25</sup>The Lord shall cause thee to be smitten before thine enemies! Thou shalt go out one way, against them, and flee seven ways before them and shalt be removed into all the kingdoms of the Earth! <sup>26</sup>And thy carcass shall be meat unto all fowls of the air and unto the beasts of the Earth! And no man shall fray them away! (Deuteronomy 28:25 and 26)

The Apostles wrote, to the Gentiles:

It seemed good to the Holy Ghost and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things! (Acts 15:28)

Oh?

#### **Spirit of Truth**

Ha Kodesh Ruakh is Yehovaw's "**Spirit of truth**"! (John 14:17; 15:26; 16:13) Yehovaw said, through His psalmist:

Thy law is the truth (Psalm 119:142); and

all Thy commandments are truth! (Psalm 119:151)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**It is the Spirit Who quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing! The words that I speak unto you, they are Spirit and they are life!** (John 6:63)

Would ha Kodesh Ruakh, the Communicator of Yehovaw's word of life, violate His own word and law? (Acts 15:28) Yehovaw said, through His apostle:

The prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost! (2nd Peter 1:21)

Yehovaw said, through His apostle Paul:

Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other judge! (1st Corinthians 14:29)

#### **Contrary to the Law**

The apostles in Jerusalem wrote that they "**gave no such commandment**" that the Gentiles should be circumcised and keep the law! (Acts 15:24) Yehovaw said, through Moses:

<sup>10</sup>Moses commanded them, saying, At the end of every seven years, in the solemnity of the year of release, in the Feast of Tabernacles, <sup>11</sup>when all Israel is come to appear before the Lord thy God in the place that He shall choose, thou shalt read this law before all Israel in their hearing! (Deuteronomy 31:10 and 11)

<sup>12</sup>Gather the people together - men, women, children and the stranger who is within thy gates, that they may hear and that they may learn and fear the Lord your God and observe to do all the words of this law, <sup>13</sup>that their children, who have not known any thing, may hear and learn to fear the Lord your God, as long as ye live in the land whither ye go over Jordan to possess it. (Deuteronomy 31:12 and 13)

Chapter 14 - Spirit of Judgment (continued)

**Missing the Point**

Were Yehovaw's apostles indeed keeping His law, in their zeal to be right themselves while caring not what the Gentiles were, who by All Yehovaw's commandments should have been circumcised and no longer considered to be "Gentiles"? Having invited the stranger to do exactly that in His law (Exodus 12:48), Yehovaw said, through Moses:

One law shall be to him who is homeborn and unto the stranger who sojourneth among you. (Exodus 12:49)

Consider what Yehovaw's final commandment to them through Yeshuaw said about their treatment of Gentiles:

Go ... and teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

The word "nations" is a King James translation of the Greek word "eth'-nos", which means "a race", "a tribe, specifically a foreign (non-Jewish) one (usually by implication pagan), which was translated "Gentile", "heathen", "nation" and "people", throughout the New Testament! (Strong: Greek: 1484)

### Strangers Welcome

Yehovaw said, through Moses:

When a stranger shall sojourn with thee and will keep the passover to the Lord, let all his males be circumcised! And then let him come near and keep it; and he shall be as one who is born in the land! For no uncircumcised person shall eat thereof!  
(Exodus 12:48)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed Me! For he wrote of Me! But, if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe My words? (John 5:46 and 47)

It was Yehovaw's Passover Feast that Yeshuaw was celebrating with His circumcised Jewish disciples, when He instituted His "New Covenant with the house of Israel"! (Jeremiah 31:31; Matthew 26:17 to 19)

### His New Covenant

It was the unleavened bread and the cup of wine from the Passover table that Yeshuaw used for the elements of His communion with the disciples, by which to bring them into His "New Covenant with the house of Israel"! (Jeremiah 31:31; Matthew 26:26 to 28)

It was while they were celebrating Yehovaw's Passover Feast that Yeshuaw said, to His disciples:

**This do in remembrance of Me!** (Luke 22:19; 1<sup>st</sup> Corinthians 11:24)

Those who insist under the apostles' error that such things are "Old Testament Stuff" with no relevance to present day considerations, need to do their homework!

### Chapter 15 - Spirit of Inclusion (continued)

#### **A New Temple**

Yehovaw wrote, through His prophet, concerning a new temple of His that we have not yet seen:

Declare all that thou seest to the house of Israel! (Ezekiel 40:4)

<sup>1</sup>Afterward he brought me to the gate, even the gate that looketh toward the East!

<sup>2</sup>And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel came from the way of the East! And His voice was like a noise of many waters! And the Earth shined with His glory! (Ezekiel 43:1 and 2)

And the glory of the Lord came into the house by the way of the gate whose prospect is toward the East! (Ezekiel 43:4)

<sup>5</sup>So the spirit took me up and brought me into the inner court; and, behold, the glory of the Lord filled the house! <sup>6</sup>And I heard Him speaking unto me out of the house! (Ezekiel 43:5 and 6)

And He said, unto me, Son of man, the place of My throne and the place of the soles of My feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever! And My holy name shall the house of Israel no more defile! (Ezekiel 43:7)

#### **If they be Ashamed**

If they be ashamed of all that they have done, show them the form of the house and the fashion thereof, the goings out thereof, the comings in thereof, all the forms thereof, all the ordinances thereof ... and all the laws thereof: and write it in their sight, that they may keep the whole form thereof and all the ordinances thereof and do them. (Ezekiel 43:11)

<sup>6</sup>Thou shalt say to the rebellious, even to the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord God; O ye house of Israel, let it suffice you of all your abominations <sup>7</sup>In that ye have brought into My sanctuary strangers, uncircumcised in heart and uncircumcised in flesh, to be in My sanctuary, to pollute it, even My house, when ye offer My bread, the fat and the blood! And they have broken My covenant because of all your abominations! (Ezekiel 44:6 and 7)

Thus saith the Lord God: No stranger, uncircumcised in heart nor uncircumcised in flesh, shall enter into My sanctuary, of any stranger who is among the children of Israel! (Ezekiel 44:9)

Chapter 15 - Spirit of Inclusion (continued)

**Offering Blood**

But the priests the Levites, the sons of Zadok, who kept the charge of My sanctuary when the children of Israel went astray from Me, they shall come near to Me, to minister unto Me; and they shall stand before Me, to offer unto me the fat and the blood, saith the Lord God! (Ezekiel 44:15)

<sup>23</sup>They shall teach My people the difference between the holy and profane and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean! <sup>24</sup>And in controversy they shall stand in judgment; and they shall judge it according to My judgments: and they shall keep My laws and My statutes in all Mine assemblies; and they shall hallow My Sabbaths! (Ezekiel 44:23 and 24)

<sup>29</sup>They shall eat the meat offering, the sin offering and the trespass offering; and every dedicated thing in Israel shall be theirs! <sup>30</sup>And the first of all the firstfruits of all things and every oblation of all, of every sort of your oblations, shall be the priest's! Ye shall also give, unto the priest, the first of your dough, that he may cause the blessing to rest in thine house! (Ezekiel 44:29 and 30)

**The Sin Offering**

<sup>21</sup>In the first month, in the fourteenth day of the month, ye shall have the Passover, a feast of seven days; unleavened bread shall be eaten. <sup>22</sup>And upon that day shall the prince prepare for himself and for all the people of the land a bullock for a sin offering. <sup>23</sup>And seven days of the feast he shall prepare a burnt offering to the Lord. (Ezekiel 45:21 to 23)

In the seventh month, in the fifteenth day of the month, shall he do the like in the Feast of the Seven Days, according to the sin offering, according to the burnt offering, according to the meat offering and according to the oil! (Ezekiel 45:25)

Afterward he brought me again unto the door of the house; and, behold, waters issued out from under the threshold of the house eastward: for the forefront of the house stood toward the east, and the waters came down from under, from the right side of the house, at the south side of the altar! (Ezekiel 47:1)

Then brought he me, out of the way of the gate northward, and led me about the way without, unto the utter gate, by the way that looketh eastward; and, behold, there ran out waters on the right side! (Ezekiel 47:2)

Afterward he measured a thousand; and it was a river that I could not pass over: for the waters were risen, waters to swim in. (Ezekiel 47:5)

Chapter 15 - Spirit of Inclusion (continued)

**Very Many Trees**

<sup>6</sup>And he said, unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen this? Then he brought me and caused me to return to the brink of the river. <sup>7</sup>Now when I had returned, behold, at the bank of the river *were* very many trees on the one side and on the other! <sup>8</sup>Then said he unto me, These waters issue out, toward the East country, and go down, into the desert, and go into the sea, which being brought forth into the sea, the waters shall be healed! (Ezekiel 47:6 to 8)

And it shall come to pass, that everything that liveth, which moveth, whithersoever the rivers shall come, shall live! And there shall be a very great multitude of fish; because these waters shall come thither! (Ezekiel 47:9)

By the river, upon the bank thereof, on this side and on that side, shall grow all trees for meat, whose leaf shall not fade, neither shall the fruit thereof be consumed! It shall bring forth new fruit according to his months; because their waters they issued out of the sanctuary! And the fruit thereof shall be for meat and the leaf thereof for medicine! (Ezekiel 47:12)

## Chapter 16 - Spirit of Teaching

### Observe All Things

Yehovaw commanded His disciples, through Yeshuaw:

**Go ... and teach all nations to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you.** (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

It was all that Yehovaw had commanded the disciples through Yeshuaw that they were to “**teach all nations**” (Verse 19); and having taught them to where they had decided to love Him and keep His commandments, the Gentiles of those nations would have qualified to receive ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit! (John 14:15 to 17)

So is it not fascinating to see that Yehovaw included that baptism in the same breath He used to command the teaching? He said:

**Go ye ... and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost!** (Matthew 28:19)

### All Things Commanded

But, since that teaching was “**to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you**” (Matthew 28:20), one is obliged to look carefully at what Yehovaw did teach His disciples through Yeshuaw! All Yehovaw's disciples were circumcised, law-abiding Jewish Israelites well taught in Yehovaw's law through Moses! Yeshuaw had told Satan:

**Man shall not live by bread alone but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God!** (Matthew 4:4)

For that saying Yeshuaw had quoted directly out of Yehovaw's toraw or law through Moses! (Deuteronomy 8:3) And in that toraw, He had told Moses:

**Lo, I come unto thee in a thick cloud, that the people may hear, when I speak with thee, and believe thee for ever!** (Exodus 19:9)

### Chapter 16 - Spirit of Teaching (continued)

#### To Enter into Life

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments!** (Matthew 19:17)

**The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat; all therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do!** (Matthew 23:2 and 3)

And to preserve the integrity of His word, Yehovaw commanded the children of Israel, through Moses:

**Ye shall not add unto the word that I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you.** (Deuteronomy 4:2)

And in case there still is any doubt as to how Yehovaw's toraw or law through Moses related to what He was teaching through Yeshuaw, consider His words through His apostle Paul:

**<sup>1</sup>I would not that ye should be ignorant, how that all our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea <sup>2</sup>and were all baptized, unto Moses, in the cloud and in the sea; <sup>3</sup>and did all eat the same spiritual meat <sup>4</sup>and did all drink the same spiritual drink! For they drank of that spiritual Rock Who followed them: and that Rock was Christ! (1st Corinthians 10:1 to 4)**

#### Before Abraham Was

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Before Abraham was I AM!** (John 8:58)

Yet, astoundingly, the apostles in Jerusalem listened, instead, to the apostle Paul! (Acts 15:2) And in their instruction to the Gentiles, they wrote to them:

**We have heard that certain who went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment!** (Acts 15:24)

The same apostles then diminished six hundred and thirteen commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law, as not applying to the Gentiles, except four of them. (Acts 15:28 and 29)

Chapter 16 - Spirit of Teaching (continued)

**Outrageous Apostles**

To reduce Yehovaw's toraw or law to four rules, the outrageous apostles necessarily had to dismiss as inapplicable to the Gentiles the two commandments Yeshuaw had said were Yehovaw's "**First and Great Commandment**" (Matthew 22:38), to love Him (Verse 37) and their Neighbor (Verse 39), upon which "**hang all the law and the prophets**"! (Matthew 22:35 to 40)

The "**First and Great Commandment**" was that Yehovaw's children love Him "**with all thy heart, with all thy soul and with all thy might**"! (Deuteronomy 6:5; Matthew 22:37) According to the apostles in Jerusalem, that commandment was irrelevant to "**the brethren who are of the Gentiles**"! (Acts 15:23)

"**The second is like unto**" the First and Great Commandment, which is to "**love thy neighbor as thyself**"! (Matthew 22:39) Presumably, that, too, had no bearing upon the Gentiles' relationship to Yehovaw! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**By this shall all men know that ye are My disciples, if ye have love one to another!**  
(John 13:35)

**Keeping His Sabbath**

Equally critical to knowing what God belongs to whom is Yehovaw's commandment concerning the keeping of His Sabbath! He said, through Moses:

**<sup>16</sup>The children of Israel shall keep the Sabbath, to observe the sabbath throughout their generations, for a perpetual covenant! <sup>17</sup>It is a sign between Me and the children of Israel for ever!** (Exodus 31:16 and 17)

Yehovaw clarified, through His Prophet, what that sign would show:

**Hallow My Sabbaths! And they shall be a sign between Me and you, that ye may know that I am the Lord your God!** (Ezekiel 20:20)

According to Paul and the apostles in Jerusalem, that sign was not to apply to the Gentile believers; they were not to know that Yehovaw is "**the Lord your God**"! (Ezekiel 20:20)

By the same doctrinal insanity, the Gentile believers "**cannot enter into the Kingdom of God**"! (John 3:5) For that is only done by those who have been "**born of water and of the Spirit**" (Verse 5), both references of which relate directly to ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit!

### Chapter 16 - Spirit of Teaching (continued)

#### **No Law and No Spirit**

But Yehovaw will not give the supernatural manifestations of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, to anyone who has not loved Him and kept or put the highest possible value on the commandments His toraw or law (John 14:15 to 17), which the Gentile believers were forbidden to do, by Paul and the apostles in Jerusalem! (Acts 15:24)

Gone, for the Gentile believers, was the opportunity for them to enter into Yehovaw's life! For that is attainable only by those who "keep the commandments" (Matthew 19:17), which Paul and the apostles in Jerusalem said they "gave no such commandment" for them to do! (Acts 15:24)

Gone was the Gentiles' belief in Yehovaw's words through Yeshuaw, according to Paul and the apostles in Jerusalem: for they declared believing in Yehovaw's toraw or law through Moses to be irrelevant to them, while Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed Me; for he wrote of Me! But, if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe My words? (John 5:46 and 47)**

## Chapter 17 - Spirit of Zeal

### **Zealous of the Law**

In the meanwhile, the apostle James explained to the apostle Paul how “**how many thousands of Jews there are who believe; and they are all zealous of the law**”! (Acts 21:20) So there was, certainly, in Yehovaw’s toraw, nothing disruptive to believing Yehovaw’s words through Yeshuaw!

Without one’s believing in Yeshuaw, he or she will not hearken to Yehovaw’s words through Him; and Yehovaw “**will require it of him**”. (Deuteronomy 18:19)

Likewise, without believing Yeshuaw, One will “**perish**” and forfeit “**everlasting life**”! (John 3:16)

That madness has plagued Yehovaw’s Gentile church for two thousand years! Deprived of Yehovaw’s knowledge, they were destroyed (Hosea 4:6) and became “**the Great Whore**”! (Revelation 17:1)

### **Mother of Harlots**

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

Upon her forehead was a name written, **MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH!**  
(Revelation 17:5)

<sup>1</sup>After these things I saw another angel come down from Heaven, having great power! And the Earth was lightened with his glory! <sup>2</sup>And he cried, mightily, with a strong voice, saying (Revelation 18:1 and 2):

Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils,  
the hold of every foul spirit and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird!  
(Revelation 18:2)

### Chapter 17 - Spirit of Zeal (continued)

#### Wrath of Fornication

For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication! And the kings of the Earth have committed fornication with her; and the merchants of the Earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies! (Revelation 18:3)

And in her was found the blood of prophets, of saints and of all who were slain upon the Earth! (Revelation 18:24)

The unbelieving Jews became the Israelites occupying the present land of Israel, fulfilling to the fullest Yehovaw's prophecy:

Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all the people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem! (Zechariah 12:2)

Failing to love their enemies (Matthew 5:44 and 45), the Jewish apostles in Jerusalem refused to “**teach all nations ... to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you**”. (Matthew 28:19 and 20)

#### Cup of Trembling

That teaching and the empowerment and truth of ha Kodesh Ruakh that it would have brought the Gentiles would have caused them to love their enemies (Matthew 5:44 and 45); they would not be “**in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem**” (Zechariah 12:2) today; and the cauldron of hate that has built up a tremendous heat of passion to kill one another would not now be the rage of terror that has become Yehovaw's prophesied “**cup of trembling**” for the entire world! (Zechariah 12:2)

So, perhaps, you can see why this fellowship has developed a passion to love their enemies, which standard of conduct Yehovaw knew, from Day One of the human race, was the only one that would keep them from destroying one another!

### Chapter 17 - Spirit of Zeal (continued)

#### **Gathered from All Nations**

By the authority of Yehovaw's words of prophecy through Moses, I see another narrowing of His focus for the ministry of Faith Harvest Israel:

<sup>1</sup>It shall come to pass, when all these things are come upon thee, the blessing and the cursing, which I have set before thee, and thou shalt call them to mind among all the nations whither the Lord thy God hath driven thee <sup>2</sup>and shalt return unto the Lord thy God and shalt obey His voice according to all that I command thee this day, thou and thy children, with all thine heart and with all thy soul, <sup>3</sup>that then the Lord thy God will turn thy captivity and have compassion upon thee and will return and gather thee from all the nations, whither the Lord thy God hath scattered thee. (Deuteronomy 30:1 to 3)

If any of thine be driven out unto the outmost parts of Heaven, from thence will the Lord thy God gather thee, and from thence will He fetch thee. (Deuteronomy 30:4)

“The blessing and the cursing” or any other part of Yehovaw's truth cannot be called to the mind of “all the nations” (Deuteronomy 30:1) without ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit of truth! (John 14:17; 16:13)

#### **Receiving Power**

In fact, when the time of His supernatural manifestations was approaching, Yehovaw explained, through Yeshuaw:

**Ye shall receive power, after the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me, in Jerusalem, in All Judaea, in Samaria and unto the uttermost part of the Earth!** (Acts 1:8)

But ha Kodesh Ruakh will only manifest supernaturally in behalf of those who love Yehovaw and keep His commandments! (John 14:15 to 17) So the destiny of “all the nations” (Deuteronomy 30:1) is in the hands of those who do love Yehovaw and keep His commandments; and what ministry, pray tell, is doing that other than this one and that of the Messianic Jews, if they have not fallen prey to the apostolic doctrines of the New Testament?

Yehovaw proclaimed Yeshuaw to be “a Light of the Gentiles” (Isaiah 42:6), not to leave them as Gentiles but

to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison and them who sit in darkness out of the prison house! (Isaiah 42:7)

### Chapter 17 - Spirit of Zeal (continued)

#### **Suffer No Longer**

Anyone having suffered confusion concerning why Yehovaw sent Yeshuaw into the world and what He then sent His disciples to do should no longer suffer: for Yehovaw's prophecy tells it all!

Yehovaw spoke, through His prophet, of Yeshuaw, as “**Mine Elect, in Whom My soul delighteth**”! (Isaiah 42:1) Notice the parallel between that language and what He said at Yeshuaw's baptism:

**This is My beloved Son, in Whom I am well pleased!** (Matthew 3:17)

Yehovaw knew the critical part that ha Kodesh Ruakh would play in the mission He had given Yeshuaw; so He said, through His prophet:

**I have put My Spirit upon Him.** (Isaiah 42:1)

Then Yehovaw made a curious statement, through His prophet: He said, of Yeshuaw:

**He shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles!** (Isaiah 42:1)

It isn't that the Gentiles were without any of Yehovaw's judgments; they were simply of the wrong kind! Yehovaw's judgment and justice include His salvation and redemption for the children of Israel! So Yeshuaw would be bringing forth those amazing and wonderful judgments to the Gentiles!

## Chapter 18 - Spirit of Dominion

### Adam's Dominion

Yehovaw gave, to Adam and Eve, a dominion “over every living thing that moveth upon the Earth”! (Genesis 1:28) So, when Yeshuaw would come to Earth, he would not enter the world with the boisterous public demands of a tyrant; He would come with plaintive pleas, in the homes or out in the wilderness of those who would hear! For

He shall not cry nor lift up nor cause His voice to be heard in the street! (Isaiah 42:1)

Yehovaw's amazing love for His children would show in Yeshuaw's gentleness toward them, whose frailty would compare to a “bruised reed” (Isaiah 42:3) or whose spirit would be so overwhelmed that it would suggest the meager spark that makes flax smoke without the spark being visible!

### Waiting for His Law

When Yeshuaw would go “about doing good and healing all who were oppressed of the Devil” (Acts 10:38), He would “bring forth judgment”! (Isaiah 42:3) But He would do that “unto truth” (Verse 3) or to show the marvelous results of keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law, which are His truth. (Psalm 119:142 and 151) Yehovaw said, through His prophet:

He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till He have set judgment in the Earth: and the isles shall wait for His law! (Isaiah 42:4)

Any keen scholar of Yehovaw's Holy Bible cannot have failed to notice the corruption of Yehovaw's toraw or law as Men have mirrored it in their own legal systems, however dimly, and the equally grievous miscarriage of justice that prevails in the courts needed to administer any law; and one cries out for Yehovaw to “set judgment in the Earth” (Isaiah 42:4) through Yeshuaw!

Chapter 18 - Spirit of Dominion (continued)(Isaiah 42:4)

### The Atoning Truth

With our knowing after the fact how Yeshuaw was crucified, that is quite a statement! But the impact of the atoning truth He revealed on the cross did indeed cause a few of the children of Israel to love Him and keep His commandments - particularly, to love and forgive their Enemies - which then released Yehovaw's "judgment in the Earth" (Isaiah 42:4) to Some Degree! And we praise Him for that degree.

In the geography known to Yehovaw's children of Israel "the isles" were lands across seas from them, which "shall wait for His law"! (Isaiah 42: 4) Within that frame of reference, the American continent would be one of those "isles"; and we are indeed waiting for Yehovaw's toraw!

For the churches established on the American continent were mostly Gentile, suffering their terrible misunderstanding concerning Yehovaw's toraw or law, to which they were subjected by the mistaken Paul and the apostles in Jerusalem, whom he so easily confused! (Acts 15:24)

### His Role as Creator

Whenever Yehovaw wants to get His people's attention, He reminds them of His role as their Creator! He said, through His prophet, concerning Yeshuaw:

<sup>5</sup>Thus saith God the Lord, He Who created the Heavens and stretched them out; He Who spread forth the Earth and that which cometh out of it; He Who giveth breath unto the people upon it and spirit to them who walk therein, <sup>6</sup>I, the Lord, have called Thee in righteousness and will hold Thine hand and will keep Thee and give thee for a Covenant of the people, for a Light of the Gentiles, <sup>7</sup>to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison and them who sit in darkness out of the prison house. (Isaiah 42:5 to 7)

From before the foundation of Earth Yehovaw had called Yeshuaw "in righteousness"! (Isaiah 42:6) Yehovaw gave His children only one definition of righteousness in His entire Holy Bible! He said, through Moses:

It shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

#### Keeping Yeshuaw

Yehovaw said, through His prophet, that He would hold Yeshuaw's hand and keep Him! And, when He had sent Yeshuaw to Earth, Yeshuaw said:

**He Who sent Me is with Me: the Father hath not left Me alone: for I do always those things that please Him.** (John 8:29)

Yehovaw said, through His prophet, that He would give Yeshuaw “for a Covenant of the people”! (Isaiah 42:6) And, when Yeshuaw knew that wicked men would be coming to kill Him,

**He took the cup and gave thanks and gave it to them, saying, All of you drink of it: for this is My blood of the New Testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins!** (Matthew 26:27 and 28)

“Testament” is another word for “Covenant” (Strong: Greek: 1242); and Yehovaw was speaking, there, through Yeshuaw of His “New Covenant with the house of Israel” (Jeremiah 31:31), in which He would write His law “in their hearts”! (Verse 33)

Yehovaw's reference to Yeshuaw's being “a Light of the Gentiles” (Isaiah 42:6) was repeated again, when Simeon prophesied over the child Yeshuaw! (Luke 2:32)

#### A Lamp and a Light

Yehovaw said, through His psalmist:

**Thy word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path!** (Psalm 119:105)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**I am the Light of the world! He who followeth Me shall not walk in darkness but shall have the Light of Life!** (John 8:12)

Since Yehovaw's life is given to them who keep His commandments (Matthew 19:17), the prophecy remains true to Yehovaw's central concern, which is that His children conduct themselves according to His good nature, which He has expressed through His commandments!

Yeshuaw being “a Light of the Gentiles” or the Bringer of Yehovaw's life to them, Yehovaw then addressed, through His prophet, how that light would accomplish their salvation!

### Chapter 18 - Spirit of Dominion (continued)

#### Opening Blind Eyes

Yeshuaw's Mission would be

to open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison and them who sit in darkness out of the prison house! (Isaiah 42:5 to 7)

There is a perfectly logical sequence: opening blind eyes to the truth of Yehovaw's toraw or law would "bring out the prisoners from the prison"! (Isaiah 42:7)

This is an important thing to consider! By these words from Yehovaw, One can know that the Gentile is in the "prison" (Isaiah 42:7), which is the confinement of any person not keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law and therefore suffering His death and cursing! His light of truth concerning His judgments of life and blessing brings out the prisoners out of their prison!

In other words, upon seeing and embracing Yehovaw's truth, the Gentile stops being a Gentile, which by Yehovaw's definition is one in darkness! He becomes a child of Israel, which by Yehovaw's definition is a child of Him Who "will rule as God"! (Strong: Hebrew: 3478)

### **An Holy People**

Yehovaw said, through Moses:

The Lord shall establish thee an holy people unto Himself, as He hath sworn unto thee, if thou shalt keep the commandments of the Lord thy God and walk in His ways! (Deuteronomy 28:9)

So “the brethren who are of the Gentiles” (Acts 15:23), to whom Paul and the apostles in Jerusalem wrote their infamous letter dismissing them from keeping the commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law, should not even have been considered as being “of the Gentiles”.

“The brethren who are of the Gentiles” (Acts 15:23) should have been taught “to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you” (Matthew 28:20) and thereby been brought out “from the prison” (Isaiah 42:5 to 7)! They should no longer have been Gentiles needing Yehovaw’s light as a means of their deliverance!

### **Constantly Improving**

Children of Israel continue to need Yehovaw’s light, truth and the commandments of His toraw or law that such references reflect; but only in the sense of constantly improving the standing they have achieved as citizens in Yehovaw’s glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

I am the True Vine! And My Father is the Husbandman! Every branch in Me that beareth not fruit He taketh away! And every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more Fruit. (John 15:1 and 2)

While telling the story of Lazarus and the rich man, Yeshuaw had Abraham tell the rich man, concerning the rich man's five brothers:

They have Moses and the Prophets! Let them hear them! (Luke 16:29)

### Chapter 19 - Spirit of Holiness (continued)

#### In Torments

The rich man was “**in torments**”! (Luke 16:23) So his concern was that his five brothers be saved from that living Hell! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed Me! For he wrote of Me! But, if ye believe not his writings, how shall ye believe My words?** (John 5:46 and 47)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle, that Yeshuaw is “**the Word**” (John 1:1) Who was “**with God**” (Verse 1) and Who “**was God**” (Verse 1); and Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**I am the Way, the Truth and the Life!** (John 14:6)

So Yeshuaw spoke the word of Yehovaw’s truth! And He said, of ha Kodesh Ruakh:

**He shall take of Mine and shall show it unto you!** (John 16:15)

So ha Kodesh Ruakh is the Spirit of Yehovaw's way, truth and life! (John 16:16 and 17) Yehovaw thinks of these awesome attributes; Yeshuaw speaks them; and ha Kodesh Ruakh reveals them or shows them to whomever one is trying to enlighten concerning them.

Indeed, without ha Kodesh Ruakh there is no understanding Yehovaw! And without that understanding we perish!

#### Get Understanding

Yehovaw said, through Solomon:

**<sup>5</sup>Get wisdom! Get understanding! Forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth! <sup>6</sup>Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee.** (Proverbs 4:5 and 6)

**Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and, with all thy getting, get understanding!** (Proverbs 4:7)

One cannot believe what one does not understand! In explaining His Parable of the Soils to His disciples, Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**When anyone heareth the word of the Kingdom and understandeth it not, then cometh the Wicked One and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart!** (Matthew 13:19)

### Chapter 19 - Spirit of Holiness (continued)

#### **Motivating Belief**

Believing is why one does what he or she does! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**Out of the heart proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies!** (Matthew 15:19)

What one does, either in obedience or disobedience to Yehovaw, is the basis upon which He blesses or curses His children! (Leviticus 26; Deuteronomy 28) Yehovaw said, through Moses:

<sup>1</sup>It shall come to pass, if thou shalt hearken diligently unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all His commandments, which I command thee this day, that the Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the Earth! <sup>2</sup>And all these blessings shall come on thee and overtake thee. (Deuteronomy 28:1 and 2)

Ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, reveals, to us, His word, which is His truth (John 17:17), which is His law (Psalm 119:142), which contains His commandments (Verse 151), which to keep brings one His life and blessing! (Deuteronomy 28:1 and 2)

#### **No Hidden Commandment**

Yehovaw said, through Moses:

<sup>11</sup>This commandment, which I command thee this day, it is not hidden from thee, neither is it far off! <sup>12</sup>It is not in Heaven, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go up for us, to Heaven, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it and do it? <sup>13</sup>Neither is it beyond the sea, that thou shouldest say, Who shall go over the sea, for us, and bring it unto us, that we may hear it, and do it? <sup>14</sup>But the word is very nigh, unto thee, in thy mouth and in thy heart, that thou mayest do it. (Deuteronomy 30:11 to 14)

That is a reference to ha Kodesh Ruakh's communication of Yehovaw's law of truth to the heart of every man, woman and child on Earth! Yehovaw spoke, through Yeshuaw, of **“these little ones who believe in Me”**! (Matthew 18:6) Yehovaw wrote, through His psalmist:

<sup>9</sup>Thou art He Who took me out of the womb! Thou didst make me hope when I was upon my mother's breasts! <sup>10</sup>I was cast, upon thee, from the womb! Thou art my God from my mother's belly! (Psalm 22:9)

How would any of that be possible were it not for the amazing communication of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit?

### Chapter 19 - Spirit of Holiness (continued)

#### **His New Covenant**

Of His “**New Covenant with the house of Israel**” (Jeremiah 31:31) Yehovaw said, through His prophet:

**This shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel: After those days, saith the Lord, I will put My law in their inward parts and write it in their hearts! And I will be their God! And they shall be My people! (Jeremiah 31:33)**

We just got through reading, from Yehovaw’s toraw or law, that His “**word is very nigh, unto thee, in thy mouth and in thy heart**”! (Deuteronomy 30:14) So why did He say, through His prophet, that He will put His law “**in their inward parts and write it in their hearts**”? (Deuteronomy 30:14)

I believe it is for the same reason that He spoke of Yehovaw’s promise, saying, through Yeshuaw, “**ye shall receive power, after the Holy Ghost is come upon you**”. (Acts 1:8) Ha Kodesh Ruakh's coming upon the disciples would be His supernaturally manifesting in them; how can Yehovaw's Holy Spirit “**come upon**” (Verse 8) a person, when He is already in that person, keeping his or her heart beating, not to mention every atom in his or her body spinning? Yehovaw's psalmist wrote:

**I will praise Thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made! (Psalm 139:14)**

## Chapter 20 - Spirit of Profit

### **The Spirit to Profit**

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

The manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal. (1st Corinthians 12:7)

In the same way ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, has been in the mouths and hearts of Yehovaw's Children since Day One of their being conceived! Yehovaw wrote, through His psalmist:

Thou art my God from my mother's belly! (Psalm 22:10)

So “rightly dividing the word of truth” (2nd Timothy 2:15), I must conclude that Yehovaw's putting His toraw or law in the hearts of His children to where He will be their God and they shall be His People (Jeremiah 31:33) is a matter of His causing their awareness of ha Kodesh Ruakh and their openness to His voice to be such that the law of Yehovaw's truth, which He always communicates to those who listen, will begin to be effective for them!

### **Some Fine Tuning**

Right now my radio is off; and my favorite classical music station is not serenading me, as it usually is; I am simply so excited about what I am writing now, to where even the sweetest sounds become an intrusion, if you can feature that!

Does my radio being off mean that the station has stopped broadcasting?

I'm sure that in this electronically enlightened age you can see what I'm getting at; Yehovaw's children have been in desperate need of some “fine tuning” spiritually!

#### **Weak Tuner**

Before I could enjoy the fine radio I presently am using, via the kindness of my precious daughter-in-law, I only had a little clock radio in the corner of my room, the tuner of which could barely pick up my station's signal from its somewhat distant broadcasting tower.

As a result of that weakness, every now and then the signal would be crowded out by other stronger signals; and I could barely discern the incredible sounds that have been created in concert halls for decades by groups of an hundred or so marvelous musicians all playing at once or in various delightful combinations, struggling valiantly to emulate their Lord God's music of Heaven and of course barely getting started!

Once you get hooked on that stuff, nothing else quite does it; and the same holds true of Yehovaw's word! My heart is full! As Yehovaw wrote, through His psalmist:

*My cup runneth over!* (Psalm 23:5)

What Yehovaw commands His children to do is His will for them.

#### **Doing the Father's Will**

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

*Not every one who saith unto Me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of Heaven but he who doeth the will of My Father Who is in Heaven!* (Matthew 7:21)

One cannot even know Yehovaw's will, much less do it, if he or she is not hearkening to His voice whenever His word is heard, whenever it is read or whenever He speaks directly to one's heart! He said, through Yeshuaw:

*My doctrine is not Mine but His Who sent Me; if any man will do His will, he shall know of the doctrine, whether it be of God or whether I speak of Myself!* (John 7:16 and 17)

Doing Yehovaw's will is loving Him and keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law, which qualifies His child to receive ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit (John 14:15 to 17), Who is "**the Spirit of truth**" (John 16:13), Who will tell His beneficiary exactly how true any doctrine is!

### Chapter 20 - Spirit of Profit (continued)

#### **Abiding in Love**

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If ye keep My commandments, ye shall abide in My love; even as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.** (John 15:10)

Does anyone wish to abide in Yehovaw's Hate? He wrote, through His psalmist:

**Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, and ye perish from the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little! Blessed are all they who put their trust in Him!** (Psalm 2:12)

That was written a thousand years before Gabriel told Mary she would bear, into the world, **"the Son of God"**! (Luke 1:35) It was that long before Yehovaw said, through John the Baptist:

<sup>11</sup>I indeed baptize you, with water unto repentance! But He Who cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear! He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire, <sup>12</sup>Whose fan is in His hand; and He will thoroughly purge His floor and gather His wheat into the garner; but He will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire! (Matthew 3:11 and 12)

#### **Extremely High Priority**

So what I am trying to show you, in all of this urgent pleading, is of the utmost importance, both now and in one's life to come! In the time of Israel's exodus from Egypt, Yehovaw said, through Moses:

**My servant Caleb, because he had another Spirit with him and hath followed Me fully, him will I bring into the land whereinto he went; and his seed shall possess it.** (Numbers 14:24)

**"Faith"** is a **"manifestation of the Spirit"**! (1st Corinthians 12:7 and 9) Caleb had the wonderful faith by which to believe that

<sup>7</sup>The land, which we passed through to search it, *is* an exceeding good land. <sup>8</sup>If the Lord delight in us, then He will bring us into this land and give it us, a land that floweth with milk and honey! (Numbers 14:7 and 8)

Yehovaw said, through Moses, that Caleb had **"another Spirit"** (Numbers 14:24); because he **"followed Me fully"**! (Verse 24) And, when He sent Yeshuaw into the world, He said basically the same thing, through Him!

### Chapter 20 - Spirit of Profit (continued)

#### **Another Comforter**

If ye love Me, keep My commandments! And I will pray the Father! And He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever, even the Spirit of truth! (John 14:15 to 17)

He who hath My commandments and keepeth them, he it is who loveth Me; and he who loveth Me shall be loved of My Father! And I will love him and will manifest Myself to him. (John 14:21)

It is “the manifestation of the Spirit” that would be “given to every man to profit withal” (1st Corinthians 12:7); so, basically, Yeshuaw was talking about the manner in which He was going to respond to the loving obedience of His children in keeping the Yehovaw’s Commandments of Yehovaw’s toraw or law, which this fellowship knows is no more nor less than “to guard’ or put the highest possible value on them. (Deuteronomy 6:5; Strong: Hebrew: 8104; Greek: 5083)

### **Yehovaw's Faithfulness**

If a person loved Yehovaw, the holy, almighty, eternal and self-existent Creator and Lord God over all the universe before the Day of Pentecost, for which day the releasing of His power as a baptism upon His children was planned (Acts 1:5), that person would be given ha Kodesh Ruakh according to the faithfulness of Yeshuaw to do exactly what He ever promises His people! (John 14:15 to 17) Yehovaw wrote, through His Author:

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and for ever! (Hebrews 13:8)

But that lovingly obedient follower would have to wait, for the fulfillment of Joel's prophecy concerning the Holy Spirit's pouring Himself out "upon all flesh" in a particular way! (Joel 2:28)

After the Feast of Weeks was fulfilled on "the Day of Pentecost" (Acts 2:1), when "the promise of the Father" (Acts 1:4; 2:2 to 4) was Fulfilled, the lovingly obedient follower of Yehovaw could expect not only His blessing in the Person of ha Kodesh Ruakh, His Holy Spirit, but also His supernatural manifestations, which by then would have become timely for all believers in Yehovaw from His celebration of Pentecost until now!

### **Marvelous Event**

Since that marvelous event, that precious manifestation has been Available! There is no more waiting for its release!

Pentecost is the Greek name for Yehovaw's Feast of Weeks and the basis for many references in our own time to people who are "Pentecostal" or walking in the power of ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit!

Ha Kodesh Ruakh's supernatural manifestations of power and truth are based upon Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power for the children of Israel!

### Chapter 21 - Spirit of Miracles (continued)

#### The Spirit and the Kingdom

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**If I cast out devils by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God is come unto you. (Matthew 12:28)**

To qualify for receiving ha Kodesh Ruakh's supernatural manifestations, the children of Israel have to love Yehovaw and keep His commandments (John 14:15 to 17), which causes them to walk in His righteousness (Deuteronomy 6:25), which gives them their place in His kingdom; He said, through Yeshuaw:

**Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)**

**The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat; all therefore whatsoever they bid you observe, that observe and do! But do not ye after their works! For they say and do not! (Matthew 23:2 and 3)**

Ha Kodesh Ruakh will do miraculous things for people who know and believe in the dominion of Adam (Genesis 1:28; Mark 11:23), even though they do not believe in Yehovaw, which is the basis of “psychic healings” and various powers enjoyed through evil occult practices!

#### Energy to the Bullet

It is ha Kodesh Ruakh Who, by the necessity of honoring Yehovaw's word concerning that dominion, gives energy to the bullet of the killer, as grievous as that evil is to Him!

But that is not the glorious and saving “**manifestation**” (John 14:21) of Yehovaw by ha Kodesh Ruakh that the child of Israel seeks; and Yehovaw sternly warned His People, through Yeshuaw:

**Many will say, to Me, in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied, in Thy name? And in Thy name have cast out devils? And in Thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess, unto them, I never knew you; depart, from Me, ye who work Iniquity! (Matthew 7:22 and 23)**

Chapter 21 - Spirit of Miracles (continued)

**Love of the Truth**

Yehovaw wrote, through His Apostle Paul:

<sup>8</sup>Then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume, with the Spirit of His mouth, and shall destroy, with the brightness of His coming <sup>9</sup>even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan, with all power and signs and lying wonders, <sup>10</sup>and with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them who perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved! (2nd Thessalonians 2:8 to 10)

<sup>11</sup>And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie, <sup>12</sup>that they all might be damned who believed not the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness! (2nd Thessalonians 2:11 and 12)

Then how does that manifestation become the precious experience of any believer?

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them; and ye shall have them.** (Mark 11:24)

But there are highly critical factors involved in that kind of thing:

**Spiritual Priorities**

If you have prayed first, above all, that Yehovaw be your Lord and Savior, which is an obedience to His “**First and Great Commandment**” (Matthew 22:38), He will respond to your prayer according to His wisdom for your ultimate good, which means that not everything you ask for as you walk with Him will be given as or when you may expect it.

Instead, Yeshuaw will be responding to your basic prayer to Him for His saving, protecting and highly blessing guidance!

But, if, in your approach to Yehovaw, your heart is that of the Pharisees, who were noted for their being “**hypocrites**” (Matthew 23:13), your prayer for Yehovaw's lordship will not qualify to be answered, in which case you may get what you are foolishly believing for, if you know the power of the human dominion! But you may go to Hell, in the midst of enjoying ha Kodesh Ruakh's obligation to accommodate you.

If you have sincerely submitted to Yehovaw's lordship in your life, by loving Him and keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law (John 14:15 to 17) and you pray for His baptism with ha Kodesh Ruakh and nothing happens, you have one of two possibilities to consider:

#### **Thy Will be Done**

Either you are not loving Yehovaw and keeping His commandments with the right understanding of what He really wants from you or else you have the mere fact that His manifestations or the various things “**given by the Spirit**” (1st Corinthians 12:8 to 10), are worked by “**that one and selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as He will**”, not as you will. (Verse 11) Praying to Yehovaw the Father, Yeshuaw Himself said:

**Not My will but Thine be done!** (Luke 22:42)

Your will has its perfect part to play, which is to decide whether or not you love Yehovaw and choose to keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law! With that use of your will Yehovaw will never tamper, not even lean on it; it is strictly up to you, which is not to say that He will not with all due respect as a fellow sovereign plead with you to consider His way!

Whether or not you have decided in favor of righteousness, the results of that decision are in Yehovaw's sovereign hands! We are far more vessels at the command of spiritual forces than most of us have any idea!

## Chapter 22 - Spirit of Blessing

### **Insurmountable Truth**

Being subject to the wills of others is a bitter pill to swallow, for most stiff-willed people; they like to believe they are “masters of their own ship”, kings or queens of their own kingdom or at least of their own palace! But their arrogance is betrayed by one insurmountable truth! Yehovaw said, through Moses:

All these blessings shall come on thee and overtake thee, if thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God! (Deuteronomy 28:2)

But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe to do all His commandments and His statutes, which I command thee this day, that all these curses shall come upon thee and overtake thee.  
(Deuteronomy 28:15)

How can that be, if Yehovaw is not able to control anything or anybody?

I'll give you an example:

### **It shall be Given**

One of Yehovaw's assurances through Yeshuaw is to this effect:

Give! And it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over shall Men give into your Bosom! (Luke 6:38)

Now, you tell me how Yehovaw can make that promise, unless He can determine what “men give into your bosom”? (Luke 6:38) You give and obligate Him to give back! And He causes men to give to you. What happens to their “will” in that situation?

A man leased an house in behalf of our family in his own name, got into his car, hit himself in the head and remarked, to one of my sons: “I wouldn't do this for my own nephew!”

#### **A Willing Servant**

You might say, “Yehovaw keeps looking until He finds a servant willing to give to you”; and you may well be right!

But the willing servant is obeying Yehovaw’s commandment for him or her; it is the servant’s will only because he or she has brought his or her will in alignment with Yehovaw’s will; so that is the will that is determining your abundant compensation!

Here’s another example that does not yield to that argument so handily: “**If thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the Lord thy God**” (Deuteronomy 28:2), Yehovaw said, through Moses:

**The Lord shall cause thine enemies who rise up against thee to be smitten before thy face! They shall come out against thee one way and flee before thee seven ways. (Deuteronomy 28:7)**

All men on a battlefield know that either they fight well or they die! So what is going to make one side seven times stronger or more valiant than the other, except for Yehovaw's supernatural intervention?

#### **Mighty Protection**

Yehovaw said, through His psalmist:

**A thousand shall fall at thy side and ten thousand at thy right hand! But it shall not come nigh thee! (Psalm 91:7)**

Don't tell me that Yehovaw's rebellious apostles, who dared to lift their voices in contempt of His toraw or law (Acts 15) were “suffering for Jesus”, when they met their violent deaths! What happened to their “**shield and exceedingly great reward**”? (Genesis 15:1)

Is Yehovaw's New Testament inferior, in its provisions, to His Old?

Yehovaw wrote, through His Author, of Yeshuaw:

**He is the Mediator of a better covenant, which was established upon better promises! (Hebrews 8:6)**

The lawless apostles were, deservedly, under Yehovaw’s cursing, for that presumptuousness, having wreaked havoc with the doctrinal integrity of His entire Gentile church!

Chapter 22 - Spirit of Blessing (continued)

**The Presumptuous Soul**

Yehovaw wrote, through Moses:

<sup>30</sup>The soul who doeth ought presumptuously, whether he be born in the land or a stranger, the same reproacheth the Lord; and that soul shall be cut off from among his people! 31Because he hath despised the word of the Lord and hath broken His commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; his iniquity shall be upon him. (Numbers 15:30 and 31)

In the meanwhile, Yehovaw's faithful apostle John, who had consistently honored His law and commandments, could not be killed by the entire Roman empire! They finally gave up on him and exiled him on the Isle of Patmos, where Yehovaw gave him the amazing vision by which He wrote, through Yeshuaw, through John, His Book of the Revelation!

There is no getting around it; in His readings of blessings and cursings (Leviticus 26; Deuteronomy 28), Yehovaw continually said, through Moses:

The Lord shall cause thine enemies ... (Deuteronomy 28:7)

The Lord shall command the blessing ... (Deuteronomy 28:8)

**The Work of God**

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**This is the work of God, that ye believe on Him Whom He hath sent!** (John 6:29)

Have you been working?

That's the Bottom Line of this whole exercise! Either you are receiving the truth that is being conveyed to you through all this Holy Scripture or you are not! If you are, I am rejoicing, with you; but if you are not, I cannot say that I have given my all; for I have not died for you, as Yeshuaw did. Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

**God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life!** (John 3:16)

But, if that would help and save you from an eternity in Yehovaw's Lake of Fire, perhaps ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, might give me the strength and the courage to do that for you.

#### **Accursed for my Brethren**

However mistaken the apostle Paul may have been at other times, he valiantly wrote:

I could wish that myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my kinsmen according to the flesh! (Romans 9:3)

Paul knew he was safe enough in making a boast like that: for Yehovaw doesn't want His children “accursed” (Romans 9:3) for anyone! But Yehovaw most certainly wants His children forgiving their enemies, where the occasion calls for it (Matthew 5:44 and 45), even while dying at their hands! (Luke 23:34)

Both Paul and I have lived for you; he wrote everything he could think of to help you make a good choice for your life; and now, so have I!

I don't agree with everything that Paul wrote, as I continue to show throughout my studies on this website! But he tried the best he knew how to save Yehovaw's children; and at least one witness I heard saw him in Heaven, teaching a group of saints something new to consider! Another witness was shown Paul's footprints on the golden streets of “the holy city, New Jerusalem”! (Revelation 21:2)

## Chapter 23 - Spirit of Patience

### Patience of the Saints

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

Here is the patience of the saints! Here are they who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus! (Revelation 14:12)

My patience is to have to wait on what you are going to do about all this: for that is what I wrote all of this for, adding to what Yehovaw has written my own recommendations based upon what I believe His writings mean through all His prophets and apostles, as confirmed by my own experiences over eighty years (as of January 3, 2009)!

In all honesty and respect for your integrity as a thinking person, I have told you where I believe Yehovaw's apostles missed Him, now and then, according to everything else that He wrote; what I think outside of that precious framework of reference doesn't amount to a thimbleful of foolishness!

### Have you loved Him?

Have you loved Yehovaw and put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law?

If so, you now are enjoying His supernatural manifestations through ha Kodesh Ruakh "as He will"! (1st Corinthians 12:11) He will decide exactly how and when He will use you to witness miraculously for Him. (Acts 1:8)

There is one exception to that rule: On the Day of Pentecost, the disciples "began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance"! (Acts 2:4) And that was an act of their will.

#### **Tongues and Prophecy**

The Apostle Paul said:

I thank my God, I speak with tongues more than ye all (1st Corinthians 14:18); and

I would that ye all spake with tongues but rather that ye prophesied! (1st Corinthians 14: 5)

Paul is speaking, there, of the speaker's will and Paul's will that the members of his church speak "as the Spirit gave them utterance"! (Acts 2:4)

The sounds of ha Kodesh Ruakh's prayer language are with a believer from the time he or she asks for them. "What is it, then?" the apostle Paul asked:

I will pray with the Spirit; and I will pray with the understanding also! I will sing with the Spirit; and I will sing with the understanding also! (1st Corinthians 14:15)

Paul said, "I" will do those things; they were acts of his will!

#### **The Word of Liberty**

Remember these things, as you study into what the "baptism with the Holy Spirit" is all about! Yehovaw's word brings liberty, while the word of man brings bondage, through the blindness of Satan's confusion and disruptive ideas!

Yes, the apostles Peter and John went to the city of Samaria; and they

prayed for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost! ... Then laid they their hands on them; and they received the Holy Ghost. (Acts 8:17)

And thank you, Yehovaw, for the loving intercession of those apostles for the empowering from on High of those precious people! Yes, in Ephesus,

when Paul laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them; and they spake with tongues and prophesied! (Acts 19:6)

And praise Yehovaw for that loving act of ministry for the obtaining of His power and truth!

But, the Household of Cornelius behaved in exactly the same way; and Peter never touched them with his Hands.

### **The Spirit while Speaking**

Still, Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Luke:

While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all those who heard the word! (Acts 10:44)

For they heard them speak with tongues and magnify God! (Acts 10:46)

We dare not get hung up on how or when or under what conditions Yehovaw will choose to manifest through any believer! And the more you hear the testimonies of members of Yehovaw's church, the more you are convinced that there are as many different situations in which this blessed visitation can occur as there are people in His church!

But that is not your concern! Your concern is only to do that one thing that Yehovaw said for you to do, through Yeshuaw, which is to love Him and to keep or put the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law! (John 14:15 to 17 and 21)

Those things having been done, wait on Yehovaw! And trust Him to use you well in His own good time according to His wisdom "for our good always"! (Deuteronomy 6:24)
