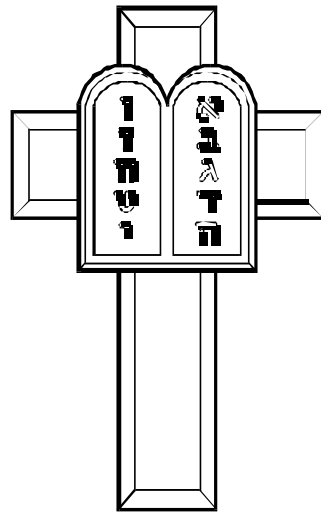

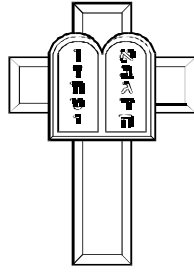

Yehovaw's Perfection

It is hard for people who live in an imperfect world to imagine what perfection might be like! It is really a relative term: for what is perfect for one may well be viewed as imperfect by another, whose idea of perfection is more demanding!

So perfection relates to expectancy! And what anyone expects is affected by what he or she has experienced!

But, since Yehovaw is perfect in being the Lord God over all the universe, His idea of perfection is far above the notions of His children; He wrote, through His prophet:

As the Heavens are higher than the Earth, so are My ways higher than your ways and My thoughts than your thoughts. (Isaiah 55:9)

Being perfect, Yehovaw desires that perfection for His children! He said, through Yeshuaw:

Be ye ... perfect, even as your Father Who is in Heaven is perfect. (Matthew 5:48)

Some teachers of the bible try to downplay that word “perfect” (Matthew 5:48) as meaning “mature” or “well developed”! But since when has Yehovaw ever been immature or in the process of developing?

Yehovaw was, is and ever shall be the perfection of all things; and, although the idea of a child of His being perfect in the same way is unrealistic from the world's point of view, an understanding of how His faith works is the key to seeing how such perfection in a human being can possibly be! Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

With men this is impossible! But with God all things are possible. (Matthew 19:26)

The only way Yehovaw can make such a claim is by His knowing that the dominion He gave Adam and Eve is backed by His Kodesh Ruakh or Holy Spirit and thereby capable of anything that He is capable of; He said, through Yeshuaw:

Yehovaw's Perfection

Whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed; and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt, in his heart, but shall believe that those things that he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith! (Mark 11:23)

Obviously, Yehovaw's children do not go around moving mountains into the sea! So, if this saying is true - and "God is not a man, that He should lie" (Numbers 23:19) - the mountain would have to be moved by His Spirit! He wrote through His prophets:

Truly, I am full of power by the Spirit of the Lord! (Micah 3:8)

Not by might nor by power but by My Spirit, saith the Lord of hosts! (Zechariah 4:6)

So, having believed that Yehovaw's words through Yeshuaw are true, one could well say to the "mountain" that is his or her imperfection, "Be perfect!" And, believing "that those things that he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith"! (Mark 11:23) Yehovaw wrote, through His author:

Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things that are seen were not made of things that do appear! (Hebrews 11:3)

When Yehovaw said through Yeshuaw "Let there be light" (Genesis 1:3), He believed "that those things that he saith shall come to pass"! (Mark 11:23) So "there was light"! (Genesis 1:3) And, when a child of Yehovaw has received His will that the child be perfect (Matthew 5:48) and when the Child says to his or her imperfection "Be perfect", he or she can receive that word as done and begin rejoicing over it; Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them; and ye shall have them. (Mark 11:24)

Does that mean that the child so perfected is never going to make mistakes?

No; but, with that prayer in place and ever working to fulfill the desire it expressed, ha Kodesh Ruakh, Yehovaw's Holy Spirit, will "guide you into all truth" concerning any error that has been committed, which includes Yehovaw's marvelous willingness to forgive and regard the repentant child as being without sin, which is how His faith works!

One cannot always do the perfect thing; but he or she can want to; that is what would be behind his or her prayer to be perfect!

That desire for perfection is exactly the same as that which resides in the heart of Yehovaw Himself! And that is the perfection for which He ever seeks in His children; He said, through David:

Yehovaw's Perfection

Solomon, my son, know thou the God of thy father and serve Him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind! For the Lord searcheth all hearts and understandeth all the imaginations of the thoughts! If thou seek Him, He will be found of thee; but if thou forsake Him, He will cast thee off for ever! (1st Chronicles 28:9)

Being perfect, Yehovaw desires a perfect relationship with His children, one so ideal that He sees it as a marriage! And every marriage is established with a covenant between the parties!

The perfection of Yehovaw's covenant with the house of Israel is akin to its completeness, the emphasis of His perfection being upon His magnificent being and the likeness to that magnificence that He encourages His children to reflect, particularly the glory of Him that they embody in their receiving His seven supernatural rewards for the worthy (Revelation 5:12) and ultimately will embody in His "**Resurrection of Life**"! (John 5:29) Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, to the Pharisees:

I cast out devils and I do cures today and tomorrow! And the third day I shall be perfected! (Luke 13:32)

Yehovaw was reflecting His word through His prophet:

¹Come and let us return unto the Lord! For He hath torn, and He will heal us; he hath smitten, and he will bind us up! ²After two days will He revive us: in the third day He will raise us up; and we shall live in His sight! (Hosea 6:1 and 2)

Yehovaw then gives us, through His apostle Peter, the key to understanding the "days" to which these prophetic passages refer:

Beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is, with the Lord, as a thousand years and a thousand years as one day! (2nd Peter 3:8)

So Yehovaw was talking, through Yeshuaw, of two millennia, when He spoke of "**today and tomorrow**" (Luke 13:32); and, when He said, of the third millennium, that the third day He would "be perfected", He most definitely was speaking of the resurrection of the children of Israel, when

many of them who sleep in the dust of Earth shall awake, some to everlasting life and some to shame and everlasting contempt! (Daniel 12:2)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

The hour is coming in which all who are in the graves shall hear His voice and shall come forth, they who have done good, unto the Resurrection of Life, and they who have done evil, unto the Resurrection of Damnation! (John 5:28 and 29)

Similarly, Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

Yehovaw's Perfection

¹⁶The Lord Himself shall descend, from Heaven, with a shout, with the voice of the archangel and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first! ¹⁷Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together, with them, in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. (1st Thessalonians 4:16 and 17)

It is fascinating to observe that Yehovaw considers that He will have been "perfected" through Yeshuaw at the Resurrection of His children, which will bring them into the kingdom of Heaven, where

the Lamb Who is in the midst of the throne shall feed them and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters! And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes! (Revelation 7:17)

But then, is that not exactly like a loving parent, who lives through the accomplishments of his or her children?

Interestingly, Yehovaw's "**Resurrection of Life**" for the children of Israel (John 5:29) will also be based upon His regarding them as worthy! For Yehovaw made reference, through Yeshuaw, to them

who shall be accounted worthy to obtain that world and the resurrection from the dead! (Luke 20:35)

Yehovaw's regarding His children's worthiness as the basis upon which to resurrect them into the glorious life of His kingdom in Heaven is not surprising, when one considers that His "**Resurrection of Life**" (John 5:29) is for those "**who have done good**"! (Verse 29)

But Yehovaw's requiring that His children be "**worthy**" in His sight (Luke 20:35) or their doing "**good**" (John 5:29) as the basis for His resurrecting them into the glorious life of His kingdom in heaven poses a serious problem! For who always does good?

Is not occasionally doing evil the worst impediment to one's fulfilling Yehovaw's expectancy for him or her? Still, Yeshuaw commanded:

Be ye ... perfect, even as your Father Who is in Heaven is Perfect. (Matthew 5:48)

In our own strength

we are all as an unclean thing! And all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags! (Isaiah 64:6)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul:

All have sinned and come short of the glory of God! (Romans 3:23)

But there is a remedy for that uncleanness or sinfulness, indeed a way that Yehovaw has provided by which He will regard His child as "perfect", "clean", "righteous" or "worthy"! And to understand that way, one needs to go clear back, in Yehovaw's Holy Bible, to where He deals with Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden!

Amen! Alleluia!

The remedy I have shown for what ails a spiritually imperfect world invariably takes one back to the fundamental message of Yehovaw's ministry through Faith Harvest Israel! And that message indeed begins with Yehovaw's experience with Adam and Eve!
