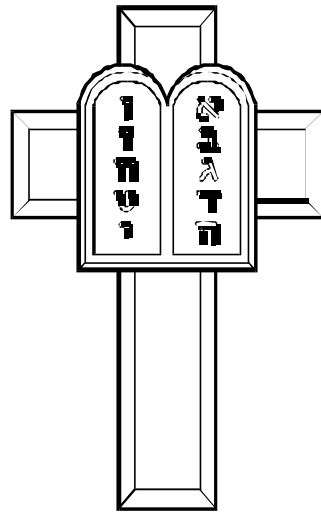

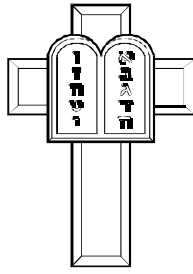

Welcome to Pastor Floyd's eBooklet on **Yehovaw's Creation**

The battle between advocates of Yehovaw's creation, as He has described it in His Holy Bible, and the advocates of Satan's "evolution" is not without good reason! For the theory of evolution denies Yehovaw's existence and function as the Creator of All and is the tool of Satan best used to accommodate people who, by having received his lies into their hearts have become angry with God and either presume to judge Him or to deny that He even exists!

You will notice that I carefully qualified the opposing theory as "Satan's evolution".

I am not denying - and it would be foolish to do so - the careful observations and measurements of hundreds of scientists who have well dated fossils of creatures that no longer exist! The mischief enters via the interpretation of that data as refuting Yehovaw's being the Creator of all that has been observed, arguing instead that all of creation "just happened", spontaneously, without rhyme, reason or a Master Intelligence behind it.

The ironic thing about the Satanically-driven "evolutionist" is that he cannot draw one breath of his or her life or cause his or her own heart to beat one more time without the will and supernatural assistance of Yehovaw, to keep him or her alive long enough to learn the truth about Him.

Yehovaw's Book of Job well illustrates a situation where a well meaning servant of His opened up to Satan's temptation to judge his Lord God, putting upon Him the blame for his losses and affliction, instead of realizing that a problem within his own heart was behind that chastening, with which Yehovaw was dealing, to bring him into an attitude of worship and gratitude, which permits Yehovaw to save and bless anyone who has come into that state of humility before Him.

To bring Job into that attitude, Yehovaw recited, to Job, many awesome details of the wonder of His creation! Appearing to Job in the midst of His Shekinah glory cloud, which the writer of Job called "**the whirlwind**" (Job 38:1), Yehovaw said:

Who *is* this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge? (Job 38:2)

³Gird up now thy loins, like a man! For I will demand of thee; and answer thou Me: ⁴Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the Earth? Declare, if thou hast understanding. (Job 38:3 and 4)

Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? Or who hath stretched the line upon it? (Job 38:5)

⁶Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? Or who laid the corner stone thereof? ⁷When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy? (Job 38:6 and 7)

⁸Or who shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, as if it had issued out of the womb? ⁹When I made the cloud the garment thereof and thick darkness a swaddlingband for it ¹⁰and brake up, for it, My decreed place and set bars and doors ¹¹And said, Hitherto shalt thou come but no further: and here shall thy proud waves be stayed? (Job 38:8 to 11)

¹² Hast thou commanded the morning, since thy days, and caused the dayspring to know his place, ¹³that it might take hold of the ends of the Earth, that the wicked might be shaken out of it? (Job 38:12 and 13)

From the wicked their light is withholden! And the high arm shall be broken! (Job 38:15)

Hast thou entered into the springs of the sea? Or hast thou walked in the search of the depth? (Job 38:16)

Have the gates of death been opened unto thee? Or hast thou seen the doors of the shadow of death? (Job 38:17)

Hast thou perceived the breadth of the Earth? Declare, if thou knowest it all. (Job 38:18)

¹⁹Where is the way where light dwelleth? And as for darkness, where is the place thereof, ²⁰that thou shouldest take it to the bound thereof and that thou shouldest know the paths to the house thereof? (Job 38:19 and 20)

Knowest thou it, because thou wast then born or because the number of thy days is great? (Job 38:21)

²²Hast thou entered into the treasures of the snow? Or hast thou seen the treasures of the hail, ²³which I have reserved against the time of trouble, against the day of battle and war? (Job 38:22 and 23)

By what way is the light parted, which scattereth the East wind upon the Earth?
(Job 38:24)

²⁵Who hath divided a watercourse for the overflowing of waters or a way for the lightning of thunder, ²⁶to cause it to rain on the Earth, where no man is; in the wilderness, wherein there is no man, ²⁷to satisfy the desolate and waste ground and to cause the bud of the tender herb to spring forth? (Job 38:25 to 27)

Hath the rain a father? Or who hath begotten the drops of dew? (Job 38:28)

Out of whose womb came the ice and the hoary frost of Heaven? Who hath gendered it? (Job 38:29)

The waters are hid as with a stone, and the face of the deep is frozen! (Job 38:30)

Canst thou bind the sweet influences of Pleiades or loose the bands of Orion? (Job 38:31)

Canst thou bring forth Mazzaroth in his season? Or canst thou guide Arcturus with his sons? (Job 38:32)

³³Knowest thou the ordinances of Heaven? Canst thou set the dominion thereof in the Earth? ³⁴Canst thou lift up thy voice to the clouds, that abundance of waters may cover thee? (Job 38:33 and 34)

Canst thou send lightnings, that they may go, and say unto thee, Here we are? (Job 38:35)

Who hath put wisdom in the inward parts? Or who hath given understanding to the heart? (Job 38:36)

³⁷Who can number the clouds in wisdom? Or who can stay the bottles of Heaven, ³⁸when the dust groweth into hardness and the clods cleave fast together? (Job 38:37 and 38)

³⁹Wilt thou hunt the prey for the lion or fill the appetite of the young lions, ⁴⁰when they couch in their dens and abide in the covert to lie in wait? (Job 38:39 and 40)

Who provideth for the raven his food? When his young ones cry unto God, they wander for lack of meat! (Job 38:41)

Knowest thou the time when the wild goats of the rock bring forth? Or canst thou mark when the hinds do calve? (Job 39:1)

Canst thou number the months that they fulfill? Or knowest thou the time when they bring forth? (Job 39:2)

They bow themselves; they bring forth their young ones; they cast out their sorrows! (Job 39:3)

Their young ones are in good liking; they grow up with corn; they go forth, and return not unto them. (Job 39:4)

⁵Who hath sent out the wild ass free? Or who hath loosed the bands of the wild ass, ⁶whose house I have made the wilderness and the barren land his dwellings? (Job 39:5 and 6)

⁷He scorneth the multitude of the city, neither regardeth he the crying of the driver ⁸The range of the mountains is his pasture, and he searcheth after every green thing! (Job 39:7 and 8)

Will the unicorn be willing to serve thee or abide by thy crib? (Job 39:9)

Canst thou bind the unicorn with his band in the furrow? Or will he harrow the valleys after thee? (Job 39:10)

Wilt thou trust him, because his strength is great? Or wilt thou leave thy labor to him? (Job 39:11)

Wilt thou believe him, that he will bring home thy seed and gather it into thy barn? (Job 39:12)

¹³Gavest thou the goodly wings unto the peacocks or wings and feathers unto the ostrich, ¹⁴which leaveth her eggs in the Earth and warmeth them in dust ¹⁵and forgetteth that the foot may crush them or that the wild beast may break them? (Job 39:13 to 15)

¹⁶She is hardened against her young ones, as though they were not hers: her labor is in vain without fear; ¹⁷because God hath deprived her of wisdom, neither hath He imparted to her understanding! (Job 39:16 and 17)

What time she lifteth up herself on high, she scorneth the horse and his rider! (Job 39:18)

Hast thou given the horse strength? Hast thou clothed his neck with thunder? (Job 39:19)

Canst thou make him afraid as a grasshopper? (Job 39:20)

²⁰The glory of his nostrils is terrible! ²¹He paweth in the valley and rejoiceth in his strength: he goeth on to meet the armed men! ²²He mocketh at fear and is not affrighted; neither turneth he back from the sword! (Job 39:20 to 22)

²³The quiver rattleth against him, the glittering spear and the shield! ²⁴He swalloweth the ground, with fierceness and rage: neither believeth he that it is the sound of the trumpet! (Job 39:23 and 24)

He saith, among the trumpets, Ha, ha! And he smelleth the battle afar off, the thunder of the captains and the shouting! (Job 39:25)

Doth the hawk fly by thy wisdom and stretch her wings toward the south? (Job 39:26)

Doth the eagle mount up at thy command and make her nest on high? (Job 39:27)

She dwelleth and abideth on the rock, upon the crag of the rock and the strong place. (Job 39:28)

²⁹From thence she seeketh the prey, and her eyes behold afar off! ³⁰Her young ones also suck up blood: and where the slain are, there is she! (Job 39:29 and 30)

¹Moreover the Lord answered Job and said, ²Shall he who contendeth with the Almighty instruct Him? (Job 40:1 and 2)

He who reproveth God, let him answer it. (Job 40:2)

³Then Job answered the Lord and said, ⁴Behold, I am vile! What shall I answer thee? (Job 40:3 and 4)

I will lay mine hand upon my mouth! (Job 40:4)

Once have I spoken; but I will not answer: yea, twice; but I will proceed no further! (Job 40:5)

⁶Then answered the Lord, unto Job, out of the whirlwind, and said, ⁷Gird up thy loins now, like a man: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto Me: ⁸Wilt thou also disannul My judgment? (Job 40:6 to 8)

Wilt thou condemn Me, that thou mayest be righteous? (Job 40:8)

Hast thou an arm like God? Or canst thou thunder with a voice like Him? (Job 40:9)

¹⁰Deck thyself now with majesty and excellency; and array thyself with glory and beauty! ¹¹Cast abroad the rage of thy wrath! Behold everyone who is proud and abase him. (Job 40:10 and 11)

¹²Look on everyone who is proud and bring him low; and tread down the wicked in their place! ¹³Hide them in the dust together; and bind their faces in secret! ¹⁴Then

will I also confess, unto thee, that thine own right hand can save thee. (Job 40:12 to 14)

¹⁵Behold now behemoth, which I made with thee! He eateth grass as an ox! ¹⁶Lo now, his strength is in his loins, and his force is in the navel of his belly! ¹⁷He moveth his tail like a cedar: the sinews of his stones are wrapped together! (Job 40:15 to 17)

¹⁸His bones are as strong pieces of brass! His bones are like bars of iron! ¹⁹He is the chief of the ways of God! He Who made him can make His sword to approach unto him. (Job 40:18 and 19)

²⁰Surely the mountains bring him forth food, where all the beasts of the field play. ²¹He lieth under the shady trees, in the covert of the reed and fens! ²²The shady trees cover him with their shadow; the willows of the brook compass him about! (Job 40:20 to 22)

²³Behold, he drinketh up a river and hasteth not! He trusteth that he can draw up Jordan into his mouth! ²⁴He taketh it with his eyes! His nose pierceth through snares! (Job 40:23 and 24)

Canst thou draw out leviathan with an hook or his tongue with a cord that thou lettest down? (Job 41:1)

Canst thou put an hook into his nose or bore his jaw through with a thorn? (Job 41:2)

Will he make many supplications, unto thee? Will he speak soft words, unto thee? (Job 41:3)

Will he make a covenant with thee? Wilt thou take him for a servant for ever? (Job 41:4)

Wilt thou play with him as with a bird? Or wilt thou bind him for thy maidens? (Job 41:5)

Shall the companions make a banquet of him? Shall they part him among the merchants? (Job 41:6)

Canst thou fill his skin with barbed irons or his head with fish spears? (Job 41:7)

Lay thine hand upon him; remember the battle; do no more! (Job 41:8)

Behold, the hope of him is in vain! Shall not one be cast down even at the sight of him? (Job 41:9)

None is so fierce who dare stir him up: who then is able to stand before Me? (Job 41:10)

Who hath prevented Me, that I should repay him? (Job 41:11)

¹¹Whatsoever is under the whole heaven is Mine! ¹²I will not conceal his parts nor his power nor his comely proportion! (Job 41:11 and 12)

Who can discover the face of his garment? Or who can come to him with his double bridle? (Job 41:13)

Who can open the doors of his face? (Job 41:14)

¹⁴His teeth are terrible round about! ¹⁵His scales are his pride, shut up together as with a close seal! ¹⁶One is so near to another, that no air can come between them; ¹⁷they are joined one to another; they stick together, that they cannot be sundered! (Job 41:14 to 17)

¹⁸By his neesings a light doth shine, and his eyes *are* like the eyelids of the morning! ¹⁹Out of his mouth go burning lamps, and sparks of fire leap out. (Job 41:18 and 19)

²⁰Out of his nostrils goeth smoke, as out of a seething pot or caldron! ²¹His breath kindleth coals, and a flame goeth out of his mouth! (Job 41:20 and 21)

In his neck remaineth strength, and sorrow is turned into joy before him. (Job 41:22)

The flakes of his flesh are joined together: they are firm in themselves; they cannot be moved! (Job 41:23)

His heart is as firm as a stone; yea, as hard as a piece of the nether millstone! (Job 41:24)

When he raiseth up himself, the mighty are afraid! By reason of breakings they purify themselves. (Job 41:25)

The sword of him who layeth at him cannot hold - the spear, the dart nor the habergeon! (Job 41:26)

²⁷He esteemeth iron as straw and brass as rotten wood! ²⁸The arrow cannot make him flee: slingstones are turned with him into stubble! ²⁹Darts are counted as stubble: he laugheth at the shaking of a spear! (Job 41:27 to 29)

Sharp stones are under him: he spreadeth sharp pointed things upon the mire! (Job 41:30)

He maketh the deep to boil like a pot! He maketh the sea like a pot of ointment!
(Job 41:31)

He maketh a path to shine after him; one would think the deep to be hoary! (Job
41:32)

Upon Earth there is not his like, who is made without fear! (Job 41:33)

He beholdeth all high things! He is a king over all the children of pride! (Job
41:34)

Job's response to Yehovaw's overwhelming account of His creation was appropriate:

¹Then Job answered the Lord and said, ²I know that Thou canst do everything and
that no thought can be withholden from Thee. (Job 42:1 and 2)

Who *is* he that hideth counsel without knowledge? (Job 42:3)

Therefore have I uttered that I understood not - things too wonderful for me, which
I knew not. (Job 42:3)

Hear, I beseech thee; and I will speak! I will demand of thee; and declare Thou
unto me. (Job 42:4)

I have heard of thee by the hearing of the ear; but now mine eye seeth thee. (Job
42:5)

Wherefore I abhor myself and repent, in dust and ashes! (Job 42:6)

Amen! Alleluia!
