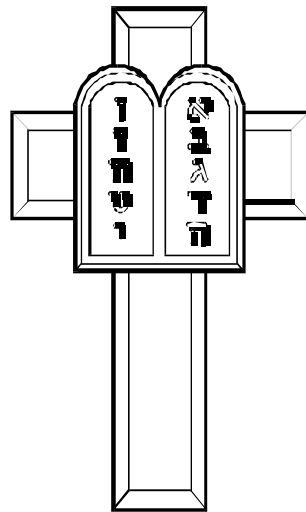

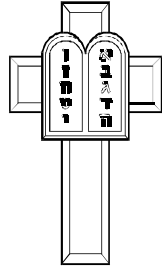

Yehovaw's Commandments

Although Yehovaw's Holy Bible calls them "commandments", what He talks about are what we normally call "commands", which are requirements spoken by a person in authority! Such a person says:

Do this! And do that! If you do, I will be pleased and will bless you. If you do not, I will make you wish that you had!

Do not do this! And do not do that! If you do, you will wish that you had not: for your misbehavior will bring you much pain!

The President of the United States is called "the Commander in Chief" of its armed services! And, as such, he issues commands telling those services what he expects them to do for the protection of the nation!

Parents tell children what they want them to do or not do; and, if they are wise parents, they punish the children for failing to obey them: for their welfare throughout the rest of their lives depends upon how well they respond to the commands of people in authority in their lives, whether of employers, customers or officers of one or another part of government!

In normal families such things are understood as basic to life! But, strangely, when they go to church, like as not they are told that God makes no requirements upon them other than to ask for His forgiveness, which, if done, leaves them free without penalty of any kind to go on without a care in the world about what is pleasing or displeasing to the Lord God Who is keeping their hearts beating and the breath of life in their bodies!

Needless to say, there is something woefully amiss in that presentation of religion, which means that people are being seriously misled and left open to all kinds of mischief by Satan, the opponent of Yehovaw and of all His children in the world, to whom Yehovaw

gives His permission to bring pain into the lives of those among His children who are not paying attention to what He has so carefully explained in His Holy Bible about how to relate favorably with Him. He said, to Satan, in regard to Job:

Behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand!
(Job 1:12)

Behold, he is in thine hand; but save his life! (Job 2:6)

Anyone entering into agreement with Yehovaw's "Covenant with the house of Israel" (Jeremiah 31:31 to 33) must deal with the fact that it contains His commandments, all of which together with His judgments comprise His toraw or law!

The commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law are simply the way He likes things done; and being "good" (Matthew 19:17), He rewards the children of His who do the things He likes, by sharing with them His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power!

One's being in Yehovaw's kingdom brings His awesome blessings, which include His eternal life on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21) and eventually in Heaven (Matthew 4:17; 5:19 and 20), when He has come for His saint, either in death or in His "Resurrection of Life"! (John 5:28 and 29)

The way in which one enters into Yehovaw's "Covenant with the house of Israel" (Jeremiah 31:31) is the simplest thing in the world! His recorder wrote:

⁷Moses came and called for the elders of the people and laid before their faces all these words, which the Lord commanded him; ⁸And all the people answered together and said, All that the Lord hath spoken we will do! (Exodus 19:7 and 8)

That was it! No Notary Public! No order by a judge in some civil court! Simply one's agreement with Yehovaw in his or her heart as witnessed by his or her words! But do not underestimate the seriousness of those words: for Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the Day of Judgment! For by thy words thou shalt be justified! And by thy words thou shalt be condemned! (Matthew 12:37)

Being "justified" (Matthew 12:37) is the condition of having pleased Yehovaw; because, being "good" (Matthew 19:17), He is also just; and so any of His children who treat others justly are welcome in His kingdom!

On the other hand, being "condemned" (Matthew 12:37) simply means being removed from Yehovaw's kingdom and from the life and blessing that He channels through it

(Deuteronomy 30:19) for those children of His who are a part of it; and, when one is removed from His “life” and “blessing”, “death” and “cursing” (Verse 19) are all that remain!

Yehovaw spoke, to the children of Israel, through Moses, to give them the commandments of His toraw or law, by which to know what is pleasing, good or just in His sight, so that they could be assured of the life and blessing of His glorious and eternal kingdom! He wrote, through His prophet:

I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked but that the wicked turn from his way and live! Turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways! For why will ye die, O house of Israel? (Ezekiel 33:11)

Getting back to Yehovaw's judging "every idle word that men shall speak" (Matthew 12:36), it is equally dangerous to suppose with the apostle Paul (Romans 4:6) that one's words divorced from actions consistent with them will assure one's place in Yehovaw's kingdom: for Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw:

Except your righteousness shall exceed the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of Heaven! (Matthew 5:20)

Yehovaw's problem with "the scribes and Pharisees" was that "they say and do not"! (Matthew 23:3) Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle:

Be ye doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves! (James 1:22)

Yehovaw is quite insistent about His commandments yet not so sternly as to forbid some variance from them, if the variant wants to obey Yehovaw's commandments but simply falls short in one way or another, from time to time, according to how well the variant understands what Yehovaw really is wanting by the language in any one of His commandments; He said, through Moses:

²⁷If any soul sin through ignorance, then he shall bring a she goat of the first year for a sin offering ²⁸And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly ... and it shall be forgiven him. (Numbers 15:27 and 28)

It is Yeshuaw "by Whom we have now received the atonement" (Romans 5:11), His having offered up Himself as the "sin offering" (Numbers 15:27); and to help His children avail themselves of His atonement through Yeshuaw, Yehovaw wrote, through His faithful apostle:

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness! (1st John 1:9)

But do not think, for one moment, that this merciful forgiveness by Yehovaw through Yeshuaw has set aside His Old Covenant rule that there is no atonement for the one who, not being ignorant of His commandment, breaks it anyway! Yehovaw said, through Moses:

³⁰But the soul who doeth ought presumptuously, whether he be born in the land or a stranger, the same reproacheth the Lord; and that soul shall be cut off from among his people! ³¹Because he hath despised the word of the Lord and hath broken His commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; his iniquity shall be upon him. (Numbers 15:30 and 31)

Consider what Yehovaw wrote through His author:

²⁶If we sin willfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins ²⁷but a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries! (Hebrews 10:26 and 27)

²⁸He who despised Moses' law died, without mercy, under two or three witnesses!

²⁹Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith He was sanctified, an unholy thing and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? (Hebrews 10:28 and 29)

Whether one keeps or puts the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's law or not makes a tremendous difference in where Yehovaw puts him or her after he or she has died! Those who died in their sin prior to Yeshuaw's death and resurrection went to "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40), where they found themselves "in torments"! (Luke 16:23)

It was even to these rebellious ones that Yeshuaw went (Psalm 68:18; 1st Peter 3:19), as the resurrected "Mawshiyakh" (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or "Christ" (Matthew 16:20), and gave them an opportunity, in the light of what He had done on the cross (Luke 23:34), to repent, confess, be forgiven and therefore be restored to their places in Yehovaw's glorious and eternal kingdom of life and blessing, on Earth (Matthew 6:10; 12:28; 13:41 to 43; Luke 17:21) and then in Heaven! (Matthew 4:17; 5:19 and 20)

With Yeshuaw's having submitted to the hands of wicked men and suffered their crucifying Him, He satisfied Yehovaw's desire that His children be shown His own suffering and death for their sinning, one against another! So He permitted Yeshuaw to

bring His righteous dead from "the heart of the Earth" (Matthew 12:40) to "Paradise"! (Luke 23:43) Yehovaw wrote, through His author:

By His own blood He entered in once into the Holy Place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. (Hebrews 9:12)

Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

They sung as it were a new song before the throne and before the four beasts and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, who were redeemed from the Earth! (Revelation 14:3)

But those who have died in their sin or will die in that state since Yeshuaw completed His personal ministry on Earth, "have no cloak for their sin" (John 15:22); they go to the present-day Hell with no reprieve for them, until the Great White Throne Judgment, where, as Yehovaw wrote, through Yeshuaw, through His faithful apostle John:

¹³Death and Hell delivered up the dead who were in them: and they were judged, every man according to his works! ¹⁴And death and hell were cast into the Lake of Fire! (Revelation 20:13 and 14)

So Yehovaw's will, word, covenant and commandments relate to two frameworks of operation, the one relating to those who are in Covenant with Him and the other involving those who are not, both of which frameworks include His Judgment of Reward or Punishment upon every man, woman and child born on Earth!

Those who are in covenant with Yehovaw but simply are missing His will now and then in their keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of His toraw or law, find Him getting their attention, by one unpleasant means or another, which in His Holy Bible He calls His chastening of them; but He does not destroy them.

On the other hand, for those who have refused His covenant, Yehovaw has an agenda of indulgence for them, long enough to use their labors for the benefit of His righteous children; but the eventual judgment that comes of their rebellion is not only tragic and painful but ultimately devastating! For it leaves them with no reward for their misdirected lifelong labors but an eternity in His Lake of Fire! He said, through His psalmist:

¹Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity! ²For they shall soon be cut down, like the grass, and wither, as the green herb! (Psalm 37:1 and 2)

⁷Rest in the Lord and wait patiently for Him! Fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass;

⁸Cease from anger and forsake wrath! Fret not thyself in any wise to do evil! ⁹For evildoers shall be cut off! But those who wait upon the Lord, they shall inherit the Earth! (Psalm 37:7 to 9)

The most well known of Yehovaw's commandments are the ten that He spoke to Moses and His children from Mount Sinai and wrote on two tablets! (Exodus 20) But those commandments did not include, except indirectly, what Yeshuaw eventually stated was Yehovaw's "**First and Great Commandment**" (Matthew 22:38), that His child love Him (Deuteronomy 6:5; Matthew 22:37) and "**the second ... like unto it**", that His children love one another! (Leviticus 19:18; Matthew 22:39)

Yehovaw said, through Yeshuaw, that His entire toraw or law, all six hundred thirteen commandments of it, hangs on those two great commandments (Matthew 22:40); and the longer I live and continue meditating upon Yehovaw's toraw, I am ever more convinced of that truth!

Amen! Alleluia!
