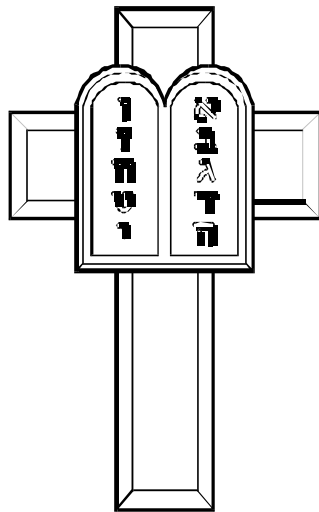

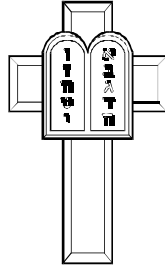

# Yehovaw's Glory

In relation to Yehovaw's glory, scripturally knowledgeable people often think of it as the "Shekinah" or golden glow of ha Kodesh Ruakh's showing Himself in His great power! Yehovaw wrote, through His recorder:

It came to pass, as Aaron spoke unto the whole congregation of the children of Israel, that they looked toward the wilderness! And, behold, the glory of the Lord appeared in the cloud! (Exodus 16:10)

It came to pass, when the priests were come out of the Holy Place, that the cloud filled the house of the Lord! (1st Kings 8:10 and 11)

Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle, of the time of Yehoshua's birth into the world:

There were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night! And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them and the glory of the Lord shone round about them; and they were sore afraid! (Luke 2:8)

Every one of us likes to be well thought of; and we are created "in the image of God" (Genesis 1:27), Who likes exactly the same thing! The idea of having an excellent reputation is also a part of Yehovaw's glory and of His people, through whom He works to be "glorified"; He wrote, through His prophet:

Listen, O isles, unto me; and hearken, ye people, from far; The Lord hath called me from the womb! From the bowels of my mother hath He made mention of my name! (Isaiah 49:1)

<sup>2</sup>He hath made my mouth like a sharp sword! In the shadow of His hand hath He hid me and made me a polished shaft! In His quiver hath He hid me <sup>3</sup>and said, unto me: Thou art My servant, O Israel, in whom I will be glorified! (Isaiah 49:2 and 3)

At times Yehovaw's reputation is that of being "great and terrible" (Nehehiah 1:5), which comes of such things happening when His people have offended Him. One such occasion was when two of Aaron's sons got drunk and, going into the tabernacle,

offered strange fire, before the Lord, which He commanded them not! And there went out fire, from the Lord, and devoured them; and they died before the Lord. (Leviticus 10:2)

Whatever be the occasion, we are fascinated by glorious things; and that is appropriate! For sharing in Yehovaw's glory is part of His children's inheritance! When Yehovaw said comforting words, to Moses (Exodus 33:17), Moses asked Him:

I beseech Thee, show me Thy glory! (Exodus 33:18)

<sup>19</sup>And He said, I will make all My goodness pass, before thee; and I will proclaim the name of the Lord, before thee, and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy! <sup>20</sup>Thou canst not see My Face! For there shall No Man see Me and live! (Exodus 33:19 and 20)

<sup>21</sup>And the Lord said, Behold, there is a place by Me; and thou shalt stand upon a rock! <sup>22</sup>And it shall come to pass, while My glory passeth by, that I will put thee in a cleft of the rock and will cover thee with My hand, while I pass by; <sup>23</sup>and I will take away Mine hand; and thou shalt see My back parts! But My face shall not be seen! (Exodus 33:21 to 23)

Speaking of His forthcoming death and resurrection, Yehoshua prayed, to Yehovaw the Father:5

Father, the hour is come! Glorify Thy Son, that Thy Son also may glorify Thee! (John 17:1)5

<sup>4</sup>I have glorified Thee on the Earth! I have finished the work that Thou gavest Me to do! <sup>5</sup>Now, O Father, glorify Thou Me with Thine own Self with the glory that I had with Thee before the world was! (John 17:4 and 5)

<sup>22</sup>The glory that Thou gavest Me I have given them, that they may be one, even as We are One: <sup>23</sup>I in them and Thou in Me, that they may be made perfect in one and that the world may know that thou hast sent Me and hast loved them as Thou hast loved Me! (John 17:22 and 23)

The apostle Paul wrote of Israel's glory in Mawshiyakh (Strong: Hebrew: 4899), the "Messiah" (Daniel 9:25) or "the Christ" (Matthew 16:20), although he chose to call that people "the Church"! But we of Faith Harvest Israel feel comfortable with insisting that

the children of Israel are Yehovaw's people: for Yehovaw said, through Yehoshua, to "a woman of Canaan" (Matthew 15:22):

I am not sent but unto the lost sheep of the house of Israel! (Matthew 15:24)

And it was "with the house of Israel" (Jeremiah 31:31) that Yehovaw said, through His Prophet, that He was going to make His New Covenant! Anyway, here is what Yehovaw wrote, through His apostle Paul, about the children of Israel:

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the Church and gave Himself for it, that He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, that He might present it to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing but that it should be holy and without blemish! (Ephesians 5:25 to 27)

"Washing of water by the word" entails hearing and receiving Yehovaw's "gospel" or "good message" (Strong: Greek: 2098) concerning the atonement of His toraw or law, which Yehoshua made of His own body and blood on the cross, "for many for the remission of sins" (Matthew 26:28), whereby the children of Israel can be made righteous (Deuteronomy 6:25; 1st John 1:9) and enter into His glorious and eternal kingdom of life, blessing, liberty, joy and power! (Deuteronomy 30:19)

Through Yehovaw's word His children learn how He will forgive them of turning from their righteousness (Ezekiel 3:20; Luke 5:20; 7:48; 1st John 1:9; 2:12), upon which restoration He gives them His Spirit (John 14:15 to 17 and 21), by Whom they enter into His kingdom on Earth! (Luke 17:21; John 3:5)

Through Yehovaw's word His children learn of His "eternal redemption" (Hebrews 9:12) for them, by which He brings them to "Paradise" (Luke 23:43; John 14:2 and 3) when they die and ultimately into His "Resurrection of Life"! (John 5:29) As resurrected saints the children of Israel will be brought to see Yehovaw's

great city, the Holy Jerusalem, descending out of Heaven from God, having the glory of God! And her light was like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal! (Revelation 21:10)

The resurrected saints will be brought before Yehovaw's throne and that of His Lamb! Yehovaw wrote, through Yehoshua, through His Apostle John:

<sup>2</sup>Immediately I was in the Spirit! And, behold, a throne was set, in Heaven; and One sat on the throne; <sup>3</sup>and He Who sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald! (Revelation 4:2 and 3)

<sup>5</sup>Out of the throne proceeded lightnings, thunderings and voices! And there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven spirits of God!

<sup>6</sup>And before the throne there was a sea of glass like unto crystal! And in the midst of the throne and round about the throne were four beasts full of eyes before and behind! (Revelation 4:5 and 6)

The resurrected saints will rule, with Yehoshua, over the nations (Revelation 2:26 and 27), having become worthy of a place with Him on His throne (Revelation 3:21), where after a thousand years they will experience joy unspeakable! He wrote, through Yehoshua, through His apostle John:

God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes! And there shall be no more death, neither sorrow nor crying! Neither shall there be any more pain! For the former things are passed away! And He Who sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new! (Revelation 21:4)

Prophetically anticipating His "**Resurrection of Life**" (John 5:29), Yehovaw spoke, through Yehoshua, of His children's being "**born again**"! (John 3:3) And He wrote, through His apostle Paul, how they will be "**a new creature**" (2nd Corinthians 5:17), for whom "**old things are passed away! Behold, all things are become new**" (Verse 17), which seems to relate to the day ending all sorrow! (Revelation 21:4)

"Righteousness" implies one's best effort to show right conduct in relation to the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law! He said, through Moses:

It shall be our Righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the Lord our God, as He hath commanded us. (Deuteronomy 6:25)

Yehoshua said,

**The Father hath not left Me alone! For I do always those things that please Him.**  
(John 8:29)

That faithfulness to please "**the Father**" (John 8:29) always is why Yehoshua was worthy "**to receive power, riches, wisdom, strength, honor, glory and blessing**"! (John 10:18; Revelation 5:12) And, when an Israelite is walking in that same righteousness, by his or her keeping or putting the highest possible value on the commandments of Yehovaw's toraw or law (Deuteronomy 6:25) and being forgiven for breaking them (1st John 1:9), the Israelite becomes worthy to receive that same glory! (Romans 8:16 and 17)

Let us now see how accurately these truths are reflected in other scriptures concerning Yehovaw's gift of glory to the children of Israel:

**Genesis 26:1 to 3, 13 and 14 Glory in Becoming Great and Being Envied**

The man waxed great and went forward and grew until he became very great ... and the Philistines envied him (Genesis 26:13 and 14); because

There was a famine, in the land ... and the Lord appeared, unto him, and said, Go not down into Egypt! Dwell in the land of which I shall tell thee. Sojourn in this land; and I will be with thee and will bless thee ... Then Isaac sowed in that land! (Genesis 26:1 to 3)

### **Exodus 40:33 and 34 Yehovaw's Glory Filling the Tabernacle**

The glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34); because

Moses finished the work! (Exodus 40:33)

### **Leviticus 9:6 and 7 Yehovaw's Glory Appearing to Israel**

The glory of the Lord shall appear unto you (Leviticus 9:6); so

<sup>6</sup>This is the thing that the Lord commanded that ye should do! <sup>7</sup>And Moses said, unto Aaron, Go, unto the altar, and offer thy sin offering and thy burnt offering and make an atonement for thyself and for the people! Offer the offering of the people! And make an atonement for them, as the Lord commanded! (Leviticus 9:6 and 7)

### **Leviticus 22:31 to 33 Glory in Being Hallowed**

<sup>32</sup>I am the Lord, Who hallows you, <sup>33</sup>Who brought you out of the land of Egypt to be your God! I am the Lord! (Leviticus 22:32 and 33)

<sup>31</sup>Therefore shall ye keep My commandments and do them: I am the Lord!

<sup>32</sup>Neither shall ye profane My holy name! But I will be hallowed, among the children of Israel! (Leviticus 22:31 and 32)

### **Deuteronomy 4:5 to 8 Glory in Being a Great Nation**

<sup>7</sup>What nation is there so great, who hath God so nigh unto them, as the Lord our God is in all things that we call upon Him for? <sup>8</sup>And what nation is there so great, that hath statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day? (Deuteronomy 4:7 and 8)

<sup>5</sup>I have taught you statutes and Judgments, even as the Lord commanded me;

<sup>6</sup>keep, therefore, and do them. (Deuteronomy 4:5 and 6)

### **Deuteronomy 26:17 to 19 Glory in Being Above All**

To make thee high above all nations that He hath made, in praise, in name and in honor (Deuteronomy 26:19),

Thou hast avouched the Lord, this day, to be thy God, to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, His commandments and His judgments and to hearken unto His voice! (Deuteronomy 26:17)

### **Deuteronomy 28:1, 14 and 29:1 Glory in Being Set On High**

The Lord thy God will set thee on high above all nations of the Earth (Deuteronomy 28:1),

If thou shalt hearken diligently, unto the voice of the Lord thy God, to observe and to do all His commandments, which I command thee this day! (Deuteronomy 28:1)

And thou shalt not go aside from any of the words that I command thee this day, to the right hand or to the left, to go after other gods to serve them! (Deuteronomy 28:14)

These are the words of the covenant that the Lord commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel! (Deuteronomy 29:1)

### **Deuteronomy 28:9 Glory in Being Holy People**

The Lord shall establish thee an holy people unto Himself, as He hath sworn unto thee (Deuteronomy 28:9),

If thou shalt keep the commandments of the Lord thy God and walk in His ways! (Deuteronomy 28:9)

### **Deuteronomy 28:13 and 29:1 Glory in Being Made the Head and Above**

The Lord shall make thee the head and not the tail! And thou shalt be above only! And thou shalt not be beneath (Deuteronomy 28:13),

if thou hearken unto the commandments of the Lord thy God, which I command thee this day, to observe and to do them. (Deuteronomy 28:13)

These are the words of the covenant that the Lord commanded Moses to make with the children of Israel! (Deuteronomy 29:1)

### **1st Samuel 12:24 Glory in Yehovaw Doing Great Things for One**

Consider how great things He hath done, for you (1st Samuel 12:24); so

Fear the Lord and serve Him, in truth, with all your heart! (1st Samuel 12:24)

### **1st Chronicles 16:10 and 15 to 17 Glorifying in Yehovaw's Holy Name**

Glory ye in His holy name! (1st Chronicles 16:10) And

<sup>15</sup>be ye mindful always of His covenant, the word that He commanded to a thousand generations, <sup>16</sup>even of the covenant that He made with Abraham and of His oath unto Isaac, <sup>17</sup>and hath confirmed the same, to Jacob, for a law, and to Israel, for an everlasting covenant! (1st Chronicles 16:15 to 17)

### **1st Chronicles 16:15 to 17 and 27 Glory in Yehovaw's Presence**

Glory and honor are in His presence! (1st Chronicles 16:27) So

<sup>15</sup>Be ye mindful always of His covenant, the word that He commanded to a thousand generations, <sup>16</sup>even of the covenant that He made with Abraham and of His oath unto Isaac, <sup>17</sup>and hath confirmed the same, to Jacob, for a law, and to Israel, for an everlasting covenant! (1st Chronicles 16:15 to 17)

### **2nd Chronicles 17:9, 11 to 13 Glory in Waxing Great**

Some of the Philistines brought Jehoshaphat presents and tribute silver! And the Arabians brought him flocks, seven thousand and seven hundred rams and seven thousand and seven hundred he goats; and Jehoshaphat waxed great, exceedingly (2nd Chronicles 17:11 to 13); because

they had the book of the law of the Lord with them and went about throughout all the cities of Judah and taught the people! (2nd Chronicles 17:9)

### **Job 36:5 to 7 Glory in Being Exalted For Ever**

<sup>5</sup>Behold, God is mighty and despiseth not any! He is mighty in strength and wisdom! <sup>6</sup>He preserveth not the life of the wicked but giveth right to the poor! <sup>7</sup>He withdraweth not His eyes from the righteous! But with kings are they, on the throne! Yea, He doth establish them for ever! And they are exalted! (Job 36:5 to 7)

### **Psalms 16:8 and 9 My Glory Rejoicing**

<sup>8</sup>I have set the Lord always before me; because He is at my right hand; I shall not be moved! <sup>9</sup>Therefore my heart is glad and my glory rejoiceth! (Psalms 16:8 and 9)

### **Psalms 89:15 to 17 Glory of Israel's Strength**

<sup>15</sup>Blessed are the people who know the joyful sound! They shall walk, O Lord, in the light of Thy countenance! <sup>16</sup>In Thy name shall they rejoice all the day! And in Thy righteousness shall they be exalted! <sup>17</sup>For Thou art the glory of their strength! (Psalm 89:15 to 17)

### **Psalm 105:3 and 8 to 10 Glorifying in Yehovaw's Holy Name**

Glory ye in His holy name! (Psalm 105:3) For

<sup>8</sup>He hath remembered His covenant for ever, the word that He commanded to a thousand generations, <sup>9</sup>which Covenant He made with Abraham and His oath unto Isaac <sup>10</sup>and confirmed the same unto Jacob, for a law, and to Israel, for an everlasting covenant! (Psalm 105:8 to 10)

### **Psalm 119:4 and 6 Glory in Not Being Ashamed**

Then shall I not be ashamed (Psalm 119:6),

when I have respect unto all Thy commandments! (Psalm 119:6)

Thou hast commanded us to keep Thy precepts diligently! (Psalm 119:4)

### **Matthew 5:19 Glory in Being Called Great**

Whosoever shall break one of these least commandments and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of Heaven! But whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of Heaven. (Matthew 5:19)

### **Ephesians 3:14 to 17 Riches of Yehovaw's Glory**

<sup>14</sup>For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>15</sup>of Whom the whole family in Heaven and Earth is named, <sup>16</sup>that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might by His Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup>that Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith! (Ephesians 3:14 to 17)

### **Revelations 2:10 Glory in Being Given a Crown of Life**

I will give thee a crown of life! (Revelations 2:10) So

Be thou faithful unto death! (Revelations 2:10)

### **Revelation 3:8 and 9 Glory in Being Worshiped by One's Enemies**

Behold, I will make them of the Synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews and are not but do lie ... Behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy Feet! (Revelation 3:9)

For thou hast a Little Strength and hast kept My Word and hast not denied My Name! (Revelation 3:8)

### **Revelation 3:21 Glory of Sitting on Yehoshua's Throne**

To him who overcometh will I grant to sit with Me in My Throne, even as I also overcame and am set down with My Father in His Throne. (Revelation 3:21)

**Amen! Alleluia!**
